THREE RING UNINSURED Three Ring (Notebook), fatally injured in a freak accident Saturday at Belmont Park prior to the running of the Mother Goose S., was not insured, owner Barry Schwartz confirmed yesterday. A Grade I winner who had taken six of 10 starts, earning \$773,440, she may have been worth as much as \$2 million. "I don't insure any of my horses," Schwartz said. "But it's not about the money. She was a special kind of horse. She had a phenomenal personality. She loved to ham it up. She loved to have her picture taken. There were a lot of very human qualities to her. She was very special." Three Ring was buried yesterday at Schwartz's Stonewall Farm in Somers, New York. The three-year-old filly, who rebounded from her poor showing in the Kentucky Derby to win the GI Acorn S., the first leg of NYRA's Triple Tiara Series, suffered a fractured skull after she reared and flipped in the paddock before the Mother Goose, and had to be euthanized. "It would be very easy to say I have had it with racing," Schwartz said. "I already knew what a tough business it is. You can't give up. You've got to go on. Time does heal wounds.

RECORD CHURCHILLSPRING MEET The 1999 Spring Meet at Churchill Downs established a new record for total wagering. The total handle from all sources was \$418,034,489, an increase of 7.7 percent over the mark set at the meeting last year. Off-track wagering rose 10.5 percent from 1998, accounting for \$334,803,699 of the total. On-track handle, in competition with a riverboat casino in the Louisville area for the first time, was down 2.1 percent. Attendance for the 47-day season was 684,177, off 1.2 percent from last year. "Whether you're looking at the quality of its racing or its acceptance by growing numbers of racing fans across the country, there is no question that this Spring Meet has been one of the most successful in Churchill Downs history," Churchill Downs Senior Vice President and General Manager Alex Waldrop said.
