SLIGHTLY DANGEROUS EUTHANIZED Top European broodmare Slightly Dangerous (Roberto) was euthanized at Banstead Manor Stud near Newmarket, England, Sunday due to progressive weakness in her hind legs and a pituitary gland problem. She was 20 years old. Purchased as a three-year-old by James Delahooke for Khalid Abdullah, Slightly Dangerous went on to finish second in the G1 English Oaks that year. Voted 1997 Kentucky Broodmare of the Year by the Kentucky Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders, Slightly Dangerous was the dam of Warning (GB) (Known Fact), England's champion two-year-old of 1987 who went on to be champion miler and three-year-old in both England and France the following year. She also produced 1993 G1 Epsom and Irish Derby winner and two-time champion Commander in Chief (GB) (Dancing Brave); Yashmak (Danzig ), winner of the GI Flower Bowl H. in the U.S. and the G2 Ribblesdale S. in Great Britain; and multiple Group 2 winner Dushyantor (Sadler's Wells).

#### DUSHYANTOR TO RATHBARRY STUD

Dushyantor (Sadler's Wells--Slightly Dangerous, by Roberto) will be retired to Rathbarry Stud in Ireland at the end of his racing career. The six-year-old has compiled a record of 20-5-5-2, with wins in the GIII Golden Gate H. in the U.S. and in the G? Great Voltigeur S. and G2 Geoffrey Freer S. in England. The Kentuckybred was also the runner-up in the 1996 G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Pertemps St. Leger and the 1997 G1 Coronation Cup. He finished third in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational and GI Breeders' Cup Turf in America last season. In his most recent appearance, the dark bay ran fourth in the Apr. 18 Gl San Juan Capistrano H. He has earned more than \$1.2 million.

Gold Star Deputy (Silver Deputy), a winner of three straight at Aqueduct this past winter and spring, was off the board in a Belmont turf allowance and returned to the main track to run second in a 1 1/2-mile starter handicap last time out at Belmont June 5. The fiveyear-old is a two-time stakes winner at Woodbine. Mt. Sassafras (Mt. Livermore), Canada's Horse of the Year in 1996, has made only two starts this year, finishing second in a May 1 allowance and ninth in the May 16 GIII Eclipse H. Entrymate Stephanotis (Regal Classic) won this race last year. Winless in three 1999 starts, the six-year-old ran sixth in the Eclipse H. last time out. The Fed (Key to the Mint) is the only horse in the field coming off a winning effort. The four-year-old captured a June 12 optional claimer in his only start this year.
