FAIRY KING DEAD Fairy King (Northern Dancer), sire of 1999 Vodafone Derby winner Oath (Ire) was humanely destroyed yesterday due to severe laminitis in his right fore foot. Fairy King, a full brother to Sadler's Wells, raced only once before embarking on an illustrious stud career. With G1 Heinz 57 S. winner Pharaoh's Delight (Ire) at the vanguard, Fairy King was champion first-crop sire in 1989. The 17-year-old stallion sired 51 stakes winners and 13 Group 1 winners, including European champion and Arc de Triomphe victor Helissio (Fr), Irish 2000 Guineas winner Turtle Island (Ire) (who sired this year's English 2000 Guineas victor Island Sands {Ire}), French 2000 Guineas winner Victory Note and Grand Criterium winner Second Empire (Ire). Fairy King was retired from stud duty last year due to infertility. "We are very sad to have lost such a great servant as Fairy King, who was one of the best sires ever to stand here," said Coolmore Manager Christy Grassick. "Our only consolation is that we have three of his best sons, Turtle Island, Victory Note and Second Empire here at Coolmore who we hope will follow in his footsteps in the years to come." Fairy King was buried in the stallion's graveyard at Coolmore, alongside Caerleon and Golden Fleece.

VALHOL WINS AT LONE STAR The controversial Valhol (Diazo) broke his maiden again Wednesday night at Lone Star Park. The three-year-old gelding finished first for the first time in his career in the GII Arkansas Derby, but that decision was put into question when allegations surfaced that jockey Billy Patin had carried an illegal electrical device during the race. With the official outcome of the Arkansas Derby still in doubt, Valhol raced to a 15th-place finish in the Kentucky Derby. He followed that effort with a ninth-place effort in the Preakness S. Off since then, Valhol made his second trip to the winner's circle with an easy 6 3/4-length score in a \$26,000 1 1/16-mile allowance Wednesday.

Canada's 1996 Horse of the Year, Mt. SassafRAS was seeking his first win since taking a Woodbine allowance last July. Coming off a ninth-place showing in the May 16 GIII Eclipse H., the gelding stalked the pacesetters, took over with a two-wide move turning for home and finished as much the best under a hand ride. The seven-year-old veteran won this race during his championship 1996 season. "I asked him to go through the hole and he went on through and just galloped down the lane," said winning rider Richard Dos Ramos. "I was really happy to have the chance to ride him." Favored Gold Star Deputy (Silver Deputy) vied with defending Dominion Day champ Stephanotis (Regal Classic), but tired down the stretch to finish fourth.

Clark Earns 2,000th Win:

David Clark rode the 2,000th winner of his career yesterday at Woodbine. "It hasn't really sunk in yet," Clark said after guiding Lady on Top to victory in the fourth race. "I still have to ride three more today, but it's a good feeling; just wonderful." The 45-year-old Sovereign Award winner wasted no time earning number 2,001--he captured the fifth race with Spider Wire.
