A winner of the G3 Craven S. at Newmarket in April, Compton Admiral didn't fire in the English 2000 Guineas or the Epsom Derby. Racing at a trip more to his liking, he took full advantage of the slow pace to lead inside the last furlong for a shock win. Xaar set a slow pace and led the field into the straight, but at that point there was a jostling for position. Croco Rouge (Rainbow Quest) suffered more than most and his expected burst never materialized. Xaar, meanwhile, was proving difficult to pass and was still in front on the uphill run to the final furlong. But Compton Admiral, last into the straight, moved into a challenging position on the rail approaching the final furlong, was switched off the rail and, despite Darryll Holland momentarily dropping the reins, led inside the last 150 yards. Fantastic Light made a determined bid on the outside and ran a creditable race in third. Winning owner Erik Penser explained, "The ground at Newmarket [for the 2000 Guineas] was very firm, but today we had good, firm ground with a bit of give in it. He has a nice turn of foot, but none of us were confident of winning before the race." Trainer Gerard Butler added, "We felt that he got the mile and a half of the Derby all right, but not as effectively as some of the others. They went a slow pace today and that played into our hands." Holland said, "He did nothing wrong in the Craven, and the Derby was probably too far for him. He has taken on some of the best today and beaten them. He is gutsy and versatile and when I went for a gap, he was through like a rabbit and has won nicely in the end."

But all five are coming into this event off defeats. Dream Well began the season by finishing second in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp May 2; Sagamix lost his unbeaten record in that race, finishing only fourth on his first start this term, and then failed to handle the Epsom track and was unsuited by the slow pace when finishing third in the G1 Coronation Cup June 4. He did not wear blinkers at Epsom, but will sport them again here. Tiger Hill won the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne May 9, but was beaten in the G2 Grosser Preis der Baden-Airpark June 6. On his only previous start in Europe, Japanese champ El Condor Pasa ran well to be second in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 23 over a trip short of his best and should be better suited by this mile and a half. Borgia, on the other hand, who has not won anywhere since 1997, may find the trip too far.
