STRONACH SIGNS GULFSTREAM DEAL Frank Stronach's Magna Ventures corporation has signed a contract to purchase Gulfstream Park from the Orient Corporation and the sale will be finalized within days, Stronach said yesterday from Monmouth Park, where he was attending the races. "I hope to close within the next few days, sometime this week," Stronach said. "It's more or less done. The agreement has been signed." Stronach said he expects his ownership team to be in place well before the Nov. 6 Breeders' Cup, adding that he is pleased with the job Gulfstream President Doug Donn is doing and plans to retain him. There may be some major changes at Gulfstream, however. Stronach confirmed that he is interested in expanding the traditional three-month winter meet and hopes that he does not come up against government interference. If Stronach is allowed to expand the Gulfstream meet, he could go head-to-head against arch rival Churchill Downs, which owns Calder. "When a municipality decides it wants to have a racetrack then it should allow the meet to be as long as the racetrack wants," Stronach said. "It's like any other business. Only the ones who do the best job survive and the ones who don't will disppear. I'd like to expand the meet and if anbody else wants to expand theirs, that's fine. Let Calder expand, too." Stronach also confirmed that he is interested in acquiring several other tracks. He said he has initiated talks with management at Monmouth and Hialeah concerning possible purchase and he said there are other tracks on his wish list. He would not reveal the names of any other tracks. Rumored to be interested in buying the Meadowlands, Stronach said that is

Unraced as a juvenile, Belenus broke his maiden on his debut at Bremen on Apr. 2, before stepping up to Listed class to finish third to Derby rival Sumitas (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) in the Preis des Gestuts Wiesenhof at Krefeld Apr. 18. After finishing second to yet another Derby rival, Hibiscus (Ger) (Law Society), in the Grosser Preis der Stadtsparkasse at Dortmund May 13, he then won a National Listed race at Bremen Jun. 20, beating another Derby contender Universus (Ger) (Unfuwain). At the front of the pack chasing runaway leaders Banyumanik (Ire) (Perugino) and Universus (Ger), Belenus moved into a clear third at halfway. Under hard riding from more than a half mile out, he bravely kept finding more, taking the lead a furlong and a half out and staying on well to resist the strong late challenge of Acambaro and the filly Flamingo Road. The win gave trainer Andreas Wohler his second victory in this race, following Pik Konig (Ger) in 1992. It was the first German Derby win for English rider Kevin Darley Stakes results cont. p. 2

Last year's Japanese champion and G1 Japan Cup winner El Condor Pasa made his European debut in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 23 and was impressive enough when finishing second to Croco Rouge (Ire). Ridden here with the utmost confidence by Masayoshi Ebina in a style reminiscent of Lester Piggott, El Condor Pasa became the third Japanesetrained winner of a Group One race in Europe during the course of the past twelve months when displaying an excellent burst of acceleration to win in spectacular fashion. He recorded the fifth fastest time for the race despite racing on rain-softened ground. Saugerties (Trempolino), acting as pacemaker for Tiger Hill, set a furious pace eight lengths clear of the field, with El Condor Pasa in fourth position. As the field rounded the home turn, Saugerties weakened quickly and was tackled and passed by stablemate Tiger Hill at the quartermile marker, but El Condor Pasa was on the scene immediately and quickened clear passing the furlong pole, running on strongly for an easy win. The first five home were all previous Group/Grade One winners. Winning owner Takashi Watanabe said, "At this moment I am very happy and very proud of what El Condor Pasa has done. It is a great team effort by everyone involved with the horse and this is most satisfactory." Tony Clout, El Condor Pasa's landlord, who assists with the training, went on, "It is too early to say where the horse will go next. He is in the (G1) King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot (July 24), but we have to see how he comes out of this race. The (G1) Irish Champion S. in Ireland (at Leopardstown, September 11) or the (G2) Prix Foy at Longchamp (Sept. 12) are other possibilities before the Arc."

Frisk Me Now has become something of an enigma to his trainer Bob Durso, as he has performed alternately well in sprints and routes, but has struggled in putting top efforts back to back. The handsome bay won the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint H. at seven furlongs Feb. 13, but was off the board in three subsequent graded stakes, including a fifthplace finish in the grassy Red Bank H., his turf bow. "Frisky" hinted of a return to his best form with an authoritative victory over Call Me Mr. Vain in the Elkwood S. over this dirt June 12 and those two combatants were back for more. Littlebitlively, as expected, was close to the early pace, but Call Me Mr. Vain made him work and kept him off the rail through an opening half mile in :46 1/5. Fourth down the backstretch, Eddie King aboard Frisk Me Now had the leaders in sight and found his mount's best stride as they rounded the far turn. Into the stretch, Littlebitlively and a very game Call Me Mr. Vain were still slugging it out, Frisk Me Now came to that pair inside the eighth pole, edged by and was widening under the wire. Black Cash loomed boldly at the quarter pole, but faltered late to be third. Said trainer Durso, "In a race like this, everything goes through your mind, is it too hot, what if you don't get the trip, just everything. Finally I have a horse good enough for this race and this is a dream come true. It's really overwhelming." Durso said his charge is "50/50" for the Aug. 1 GI Whitney at Saratoga.

The decision: make the journey to Monmouth Park to run for a larger purse at a longer distance (GII Iselin H.), or stay at home to contest the GII Tom Fool. The choice to remain at Belmont would prove to be a crafty one, as Crafty Friend, the victor of an Aqueduct allowance in April and most recently a close-up second in Sir Bear's GI Met Mile May 29, wired the Tom Fool. Away smartly from the gate, the chestnut was joined immediately from the outside by last year's GI Vosburgh winner Affirmed Success, who was looking for his first victory since that effort last September. GI Carter H. winner Artax also broke well and took up a stalking position just a length off the top two. As the field reached the top of the lane, jockey Richard Migliore aboard Crafty Friend got to work and he began to inch away from Affirmed Success, with Artax, unable to match strides, retreating in third. Crafty Friend dug in gamely in the last 100 yards and was able to hold Affirmed Success at bay for the victory in new stakes record time. Winning trainer John Kimmel explained the decision to run at Belmont as opposed to Monmouth. "The main thing was he likes this track. He runs game when he is here. My intuition said seven-eighths." The disappointed conditioner of the runner up, Richie Schosberg, commented, "He gave a game effort. I thought that he was in perfect positioning after that fast opening quarter. He just didn't get the job done." Kimmel said his charge may be pointed at the GI Forego at Saratoga Sept. 6.
