Behrens began 1999 with runner-up finishes in the GIII Broward H. and the GI Donn H. before going on a three-race tear with wins in the GI Gulfstream Park H., GI Oaklawn H. and GII Massachusetts H., and he continued his dominance of the handicap division with an authoritative victory here. Always near the front end, the prohibitive favorite loomed boldly leaving the backstretch to take charge after six furlongs and was kept to the task late. "He broke good and he was pretty relaxed in the beginning of the race," explained winning rider Jorge Chavez. "At the 5/8ths pole he started pulling and I didn't want to fight him, so I let him move up. I could feel the other horse (Catienus) coming, but at that point my horse was galloping away from them. I had plenty of horse." Trainer H. James Bond said Behrens will now be pointed towards the Aug. 1 GI Whitney H. at Saratoga and a likely showdown with 1998 Belmont S. winner Victory Gallop. "I think we're ready for Victory Gallop," Bond said of the match-up. "He's coming to our home court. Behrens likes Saratoga and he'll be pretty tough up there." The five-year-old now leads the "NTRA Champions on FOX" series with 34 points.

Magicalmysterycat followed a one-length debut win May 21 with a victory in the June 6 Cinderella S. Breaking from the rail and facing only three rivals, the speedy filly veered in at the start, but recovered quickly to duel for the lead. After inching clear approaching the turn, she ducked in again at the sixteenth pole, but won easily. "Her natural speed was good enough to get the lead. She was cruising easy enough and she fired when I asked her for run," said winning rider Chris Antley. "She did duck in at the sixteenth pole and went back to her left lead, so she's still a little bit green." Winning trainer D. Wayne Lukas said Magicalmysterycat would likely stay in Southern California. Lukas also trained Landaluce, who died during her championship two-yearold season in 1982, and reminisced, "She was such a special horse...probably the most brilliant horse we've ever been around. Every once in a while when we're feeling a little down, we plug in that old tape and watch her waltz down through there like she did. I'm glad they've left it the Landaluce." Magicalmysterycat gave Lukas a record six wins in the Landaluce.



When Legal Case was exported from England to Brazil in 1992, he surely ranked as one of the bestqualified stallion prospects imported into South America from Europe in recent decades. As a three-year-old, he had won the G1 Champion S. over 1¼ miles, and the following season he finished a good sixth of 21 in the Arc before recording his second Group 1 success over 1¼ miles, this time in the Premio Roma.

Legal Case was also a well-bred individual. A son of the highly successful Alleged, he was out of Maryinsky, a winning Northern Dancer filly who was inbred to the highly influential broodmare Sister Sarah through close relatives Sybil's Sister (GB) and Nearctic (Ity).

But if he was so good, why was Legal Case not retained in Europe? Well, he failed to reproduce his best form as a five-year-old, after an absence of nearly 12 months, and speed-conscious commercial breeders no doubt objected to the fact that he was a specialist over 1¼ and 1½ miles who never raced at two. This type of prejudice generally made Alleged's stallion sons much more popular with breeders of jumping horses than with their flat counterparts.

It now looks as though Legal Case's move to Brazil was in his best interest. His second crop contains that very good filly Virginie, a champion in her homeland who is now establishing herself as one of the best turf mares in the U.S., as she showed with her victory in the Beverly Hills H. last Saturday.

The links between North and South American racing were also highlighted recently by the excellent run of success enjoyed by Southern Halo. This son of Halo dominated the Carrera de las Estrellas meeting in Argentina July 26, with his daughters Venusberg (Arg), Sun Spring (Arg) and Vacacionada (Arg) adding three more Grade 1 victories to his staggering total.

More relevant to American breeders is the success Southern Halo is enjoying with More Than Ready, a colt from his first Northern Hemisphere crop. This \$187,000 buy at Keeneland last September improved his statistics to four-for-four when he lowered Belmont's 5½-furlong record under top weight in the GIII Tremont S.
