The top price during yesterday's session was the 47,000gns (\$79,087) paid by agent Marco Bozzi for the unraced Doowaley (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). The colt was consigned by Alec Stewart.

YAGLI TO STAY HOME Yagli (Jade Hunter) will not ship to England for the July 24 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., as had been previously reported. Instead, the Allen Paulson color bearer could make his next start in the July 31 GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park or in the Aug. 14 GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga. Runner-up in last year's Breeders' Cup Turf, Yagli is undefeated in two 1999 starts, most recently winning the June 5 GI Manhattan H.

In one of the finest displays ever seen in this historic race, Stravinsky produced an electrifying burst of speed in the final furlong to defeat a field of high-class opponents. Having disappointed connections on his seasonal debut when second in a conditions event at The Curragh Mar. 28, Stravinsky attempted to redeem his reputation in the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot June 16. He finished a creditable fourth in that race, but still did not match his connection's expectations. With the utmost confidence, Stravinsky was patiently settled in midfield by Michael Kinane, as Tipsy Creek (Dayjur), Bold Edge, Bertolini and Bianconi (Danzig) disputed an early, exacting pace. As the field swept past the twofurlong marker, Kinane edged Stravinsky onto the heels of Bold Edge and Bertolini and asked his mount for his effort in the final furlong. The reaction was immediate as Stravinsky quickened in superb style, putting daylight between himself and his toiling rivals and running on strongly up the hill to be in splendid isolation at the line, shaving 0.21 seconds off the track record. Trainer Aidan O'Brien hailed his hero, saying, "He is explosive and he is totally unbelievable. I haven't found him frustrating, if anything he's been frustrated by me. I haven't done the right things with him. I tried to stretch him to a mile, but he is just pure speed."
