BULLET BACK ON THE BEAM Having already conquered ports of call from New Orleans to Louisville to Baltimore, Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) marched through Oceanport, New Jersey like Sherman through Atlanta, affirming her superiority over her peers with a workmanlike five-length victory over Boom Town Girl (Unbridled) in yesterday's Gll Monmouth Breeders' Cup Oaks at Monmouth Park. The Champion two-year-old filly came into her last start, the June 5 Belmont S., off eight consecutive wins, including back-to-back Grade Is in Keeneland's Ashland S. and the Kentucky Oaks. In the Belmont, the bay set the pace to the guarter pole, but was not perservered with thereafter, finishing seventh by over 10 lengths. Trainer Bob Baffert knew that Saturday would be a much different story. "I could tell when I got here today that she was ready, her energy level was high. She's so much fun to watch." Baffert indicated that Silverbulletday grabbed a quarter during the race, reopening an injury from earlier in the week, leading the conditioner to hedge on her next start, though he did indicate that the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Aug. 8 is a possibility.

LORD HOWARD DE WALDEN PASSES AWAY Lord Howard de Walden, one of the great owner-breeders of the 20th Century, has died at the age of 86, having been unwell for some time. Among the best horses to carry his apricot silks in over 50 years as an owner were the 1985 Epsom Derby winner Slip Anchor (GB) (Shirley Heights {GB}), the outstanding miler Kris (GB) (Sharpen Up), his full brother Diesis (GB), a topclass two-year-old in 1982, Grand Lodge (Chief's Crown) winner of the 1994 St. James's Palace S. and the 1975 Champion Hurdle winner Lanzarote (GB) (Milesian {GB}). Lord Howard, who inherited valuable property interests in central London, was elected to the Jockey Club in 1952 and served as senior steward three times. He owned Plantation Stud near Newmarket, where Kris and Slip Anchor stand, and also had a smaller farm near his Berkshire home. He sold Thornton Stud in Yorkshire, which he had bought in 1967, five years ago. Henry Cecil, trainer of Slip Anchor, Kris and Diesis, led the tributes yesterday, saying, "I'm very sad to hear the news. He was one of the few remaining great owner/breeders and I trained some great horses for him. He was a great friend and a very loyal and supportive owner, he's irreplaceable to us."

Silverbulletday has been virtually unstoppable since finishing fourth in the GII Del Mar Debutante last August, taking eight consecutive graded stakes events, including the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, a pair of graded stakes in Louisiana, two Grade I events in the Bluegrass and the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico. After trying to work the attractive bay in against the boys in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, the decision was made to test the waters in the Belmont S. June 5, where she established a relatively fast pace and led past the quarter pole, but faltered in the stretch to finish seventh. The Mike Pegram-owned filly bounced right back and worked marvelously for her start in this event. Breaking alertly, Silverbulletday was carried five wide into the clubhouse turn, but Jerry Bailey, aboard the champ for the third time, shrewdly guided his mount to the inside just after the first bend to track Bag Lady Jane from second. Sitting "chilly" into the far turn, Bailey asked the "Bullet" to take up the running, advanced in hand to take over in upper stretch and was ridden out the balance. Said the winning rider, "Today she was content to just sit second unti I called on her. I didn't ask her for too much today and she did it easy.'

Honor Glide won Arlington's Mid-America Triple, including the GI Secretariat S., in 1997, and raced on the turf in graded stakes company for most of the 1998 campaign with very little success. Most recently, the bay ran second to Comic Strip in an allowance effort on the Belmont turf June 5, his only start of the year. Here, the five-year-old raced just off the pace in third position for the first mile, gained on the front-runners while three-wide on the far turn, came clear under a steady, right handed whip to avoid traffic late and withstood the furious late rally of Parade Ground, who was well back down the backstretch. Winning trainer Christophe Clement commented, "I was happy with his first race (this season). Today we had a great trip, good pace and firm turf. We will now go to either the (GI) United Nations (July 31 at Monmouth) or the (GI) Sword Dancer (Aug 14 at Saratoga)."

LUCKY COIN RETIRED The winner of the 1997 GIII Kelso H. at Belmont Park, Lucky Coin (Chas Conerly), has been officially retired from racing, according to a story in today's *Daily Racing Form*. The gelding had been training forwardly recently and was nearing a race, but reinjured the bowed tendon which forced the six-year-old to the sidelines some 20 months ago. Fourth to Spinning World in the 1997 Breeders' Cup Mile, Lucky Coin retires with seven wins in 13 starts and earnings of \$345,409.

Offered up last Dec. 4 for \$100,000, River Keen was claimed from the barn of Bob Hess by trainer Bob Baffert as an established stakes performer, having won the Gll Californian S. in 1997. The Irish-bred had raced four times in 1999 and was back up for sale in three of those events, twice back for \$100,000 and most recently for \$80,000 when he was second by three parts of a length June 4. The chestnut was taken well off the pace by jockey Chris Antley to be sixth after the opening half mile. As the field reached the far turn, Antley shifted River Keen to the five path for clear running and he engaged favored Barter Town just outside the quarter pole. The two were nearly inseparable down the stretch, but it was the former claimer who hit the wire just in front. "That was one great run," said Antley. "He settled off the pace and there was a little bit of a speed duel in front of me. When I asked him to run, he fired really big. It was just a good gutsy effort." Eoin Harty, who saddled the winner in the absence of his boss, commented, "He's had a lot of trouble, he's had quarter cracks. The last two months he has really come around and he's been very sound. He's been getting better and better all the time."

The form of the G1 Vodafone Oaks was upheld in no uncertain terms when Noushkey skated to victory in the G3 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock last weekend and the Oaks winner Ramruma (Diesis {GB}) seeks to continue her run of success at the expense of only six opponents. Although the Henry Cecil stable seems to have hit a bit of a flat spot recently, it will be a surprise if she were unable to add this Irish equivalent to her Epsom success. Sunspangled (Caerleon) was sixth to Ramruma in the Oaks and it would need a major turnaround in form for the placings to be reversed. Polaire (Polish Patriot) had Sister Bella (Sadler's Wells) nearly four lengths in arrears when winning the G2 Pretty Polly Stakes at the Curragh, June 26, and may well prove best of the home defence.
