Odds-on favorite Ramruma gave her trainer Henry Cecil and rider Kieren Fallon their fourth European Classic success of the year while becoming the eighth filly to complete the English and Irish Oaks double with this impressive success. It was Fallon's first Classic winner in his native country. Always handily placed in second behind the leader Blend Of Pace (Sadler's Wells), Ramruma closed quickly coming into the straight, quickened clear of the field with a quarter mile to run and went further and further clear with every stride. She could have won by a dozen lengths if Fallon had not begun to ease her with 100 yards to run. "She was stronger than at Epsom, mentally and physically," said Fallon. "We were always going to win." Sunspangled ran her best race of the season to grab the second spot in the final strides from Sister Bella, while G2 Pretty Polly S. winner Polaire (Polish Patriot), in the rear from the start, failed to stay the trip and beat only one home. Cecil, training his third Irish Oaks winner, confirmed, "It will be York [G1 Yorkshire Oaks, Aug. 18] then the [G1] St. Leger [at Doncaster, Sept. 11]. She is a very good filly and is improving all the time. She had some soreness in her back after winning at Lingfield and she is better now than when she won at Epsom. We will get the Yorkshire Oaks and St. Leger over first before we look any further."

After breaking his maiden in his second trip to the post, Forestry finished third in an entry-level allowance, two lengths behind second-place finisher Charismatic. That effort in February at Santa Anita marks the last loss for the expensive bay, as he scored a victory in the San Pedro S. in his next start and took three straight events at Churchill Downs this spring, culminating with a 1 3/4-length victory in an overnight handicap last out June 12. Doneraile Court blasted from the gate and guided the field through a lightning-quick half mile in :44 4/5, with Forestry just two lengths in arrears. After six furlongs in 1:08 2/5, jockey Jerry Bailey sent his colt for the lead and he overtook Doneraile Court with ease, drew clear and was kept to the task en route to the victory, the first in 10 tries in New York for Bob Baffert. "I guess I picked the right day to do it," he quipped and added, "(Forestry) is getting better and learning how to run. When we bought him, he was medium sized and got big quick. That's why I didn't want to push him too early." The Aaron and Marie Jones colorbearer will return to Churchill Downs with stablemate Silverbulletday before a decision is made on his next start, but the \$1 million GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park Aug. 8 is possible.



#### Manistique Bound for Turf?

Manistique (Unbridled), the winner of eight of 10 starts, including six graded stakes, on the main track, breezed five furlongs on the turf Sunday, going the distance in 1:02. The four-year-old filly, who is out of a Nureyev mare, posted a 4 1/2-length score in the GI Vanity H. going 1 1/8 miles on the dirt June 26. She has yet to race on the turf.

Last week, the provincial jockey became the first in Australia to sign a five-year AUS\$100,000 (\$65,681) corporate sponsorship deal with property developers Homecorp Australia.
