Making his claim to the sprint championship, Yes It's True had won five straight graded-stakes sprints coming into this test. A winner over older horses in the May 15 GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H., he faced fellow three-year-olds in his last two victories, the June 5 GII Riva Ridge S. at Belmont and the June 19 GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S. at Monmouth Park. Back in against his elders, the bay rated in third as Storm Punch set a pressured pace, came four wide into the stretch and wore down Good and Tough to give owner Satish Sanan his first Grade I victory. "He's a great physical specimen and he truly typifies what a great sprinter should be," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said. "He has the ability to adjust to different surfaces every time. We've really been enjoying this ride." Added jockey Jerry Bailey, "This horse didn't get a good start today and that really paid off for us. He had plenty left when we needed it--and we needed it." Final time for the Dash was just three-fifths of a second off the track record. Plans call for the colt to go in the GII A Phenomenon H. at Saratoga Aug. 11, GI King's Bishop S. at the Spa Aug. 28 and the GI Vosburgh at Belmont Sept. 25. The runner-up enjoyed a ground-saving trip, slipping through to briefly take the lead in the stretch, but couldn't hold off the top one.

Making his first start since he fractured his left front sesamoid while finishing second in the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga last August, Val's Prince (Eternal Prince) finished second to MGSW Cryptic Rascal (Cryptoclearance) in Friday's seventh race at Belmont, a 1 1/16-mile turf allowance.
