STAR-STUDDED CATALOGUE FOR

KEENELAND JULY The Keeneland July Selected Yearling Sale perennially attracts world-class pedigrees and major buyers from around the world and this year's auction, which kicks off this evening at 7:30 in Lexington, is no exception. The catalogue includes the customary allotment of fashionable sires such as A.P. Indy, Danzig, Deputy Minister, Forty Niner, Gone West, Mr. Prospector, Nureyev, Seattle Slew, Seeking the Gold and Storm Cat. The latter is the sire of hip 195, a colt out of MGSW Weekend Surprise, the dam of A.P. Indy and Summer Squall. This chestnut is part of a formidable Lane's End consignment. The sale also features the first foal from Serena's Song (Rahy). Selling as hip 44, the filly is by the late Mr. Prospector and is consigned by Craig Bandoroff's Denali Stud, acting as agent for Bob and Beverly Lewis. "She is a lovely filly and has a very sweet temperament," said Bandoroff, who also consigns a Gone West filly out of SW Miraloma (hip 167). Deputy Minister is represented by a pair of fillies from the Eaton Sales consignment of Tom Van Meter and Reiley McDonald. Hip 164 is a liver chestnut filly out of Lemon Dove (Forty Niner) and one that Van Meter has very high hopes for. "She sold for \$1 million as a foal and is a powerful and well-balanced filly. She is medium sized and comes from one of the best families in the book," he said. Hip 18 is a half sister to crack sprinters Chaposa Springs and You and I and brought \$750,000 as a weanling. A Gone West colt out of Laguna Seca (Seattle Slew) from the consignment of Three Chimneys Farm (hip 19) should represent his sire well. According to Three Chimneys General Manager Dan Rosenberg, "He is a strong, athletic and well-balanced individual. I just like everything about him." A half-dozen first crop sires of yearlings are represented, including Hennessy (nine yearlings), Grindstone, Smart Strike, and Unbridled's Song (two each), and Honour and Glory and Afternoon Deelites (one each). Grindstone's lone filly in the sale, hip 149, is a half sister to 1997 Horse of the Year Favorite Trick. Also attracting attention is hip 15, a half sister to 1998 Horse of the Year Skip Away by Seeking the Gold. But despite the upper-end nature of the sale, Rogers Beasley, Keeneland's director of sales, says, "There are a number of horses which have sold for \$150,000 to \$200,000 who have become nice racehorses. There is something for everyone."

Cat Thief, with 11 on-the-board finishes but only two victories, had developed a reputation as a consistent, but not particularly driven horse. He erased all doubts about his determination with a hard-fought victory over GI Santa Anita Derby winner General Challenge to earn the first Grade I victory of his career yesterday. Cat Thief, third in the Kentucky Derby, hadn't won a race since taking the GII Breeders Futurity at Keeneland last October and hadn't raced since running sixth in the May 29 GI Metropolitan H. The chestnut homebred dueled with Desert Hero (Sea Hero) in the early going and put that rival away nearing the final turn only to be joined by favored General Challenge. General Challenge put a head in front at midstretch, but Cat Thief battled back gamely to earn a narrow victory. "It was a gutsy performance in the last eighth of a mile, much more so than what I'd gotten from him in the two times I'd ridden him earlier this year," admitted winning rider Pat Day. "Today, he was tenacious. I mean, he was determined and I don't think if we'd have gone around two more times the other horse was going to get by us."

Plicck, a three-time winner in France under the tutelage of Carlos Laffon-Parias, hit the board only once in his first four American starts, winning the restricted San Marino H. in February, but returned from a twomonth freshening to win a May 14 optional claimer and ran third in the GIII Golden Gate H. in his last outing June 19. The Irish-bred bay was never far out of it, rallied between rivals into the stretch and rushed up to take a short lead in the shadow of the wire. Shortly after the finish, Plicck was pulled up lame and vanned off the track. River Bay, who rallied from last and fell just short at the wire, also finished lame and was taken off the track in an ambulance. Dr. Ray Baran reported that injuries to both horses were not life threatening. "Plicck is lame in left front, but I can't tell you exactly what. River Bay ruptured his distal sesamoidean ligament, which is the ligament below the sesamoids.'

He appeared not to handle the unique track on that occasion and also failed to stay the 12furlong trip. Dropping back in class and distance here, however, he fairly trounced his rivals under a fine tactical Frankie Dettori ride to become the second successive British-trained winner of this race, following Dr Fong's win last year. Instructed to lead if there was insufficient pace, Dettori sent Dubai Millennium to the front soon after the start and set a strong gallop. He steadied the pace at halfway but continued to hold the call over his rivals. Soon after turning into the straight, Dettori asked his mount for his main effort and the two quickly scooted clear of his rivals to win easily. Said winning trainer Saeed Bin Suroor: "The drop back in distance really suited him and the track conditions were perfect for him today. We have no definite plans for him at the moment. We'll just take him home and see how he comes out of this race. I'm sure we'll just go for another Group race for his next start...we think his best distance might be a mile now, but he stays 10 furlongs."


