

#### **Aussie Steroid Investigation Continues:**

The future of Randwick-based trainer Anthony Cummings, the son of "Cups King" Bart Cummings, is uncertain after his mare Yallah's Star (Aus) was stripped of her victory at Randwick June 12 for testing positive for trenbolone. The New South Wales Thoroughbred Racing Board (TRB) stewards adjourned an inquiry into the case after hearing that up to 45 of his horses had been implanted with the pellet, and will continue the investigation at a later date; they are trying to track down two absent witnesses. A highly emotional Cummings told stewards that he'd been "stupid" but was "not a devious person by nature." Cummings had used the TRB's non-race day elective testing on a mare after she'd been implanted and at the time the result was clear, but the test for trenbolone has only recently been perfected. Stewards have ordered testing of frozen swab samples on other Cummings-trained winners. TRB Chief Executive Jim Murphy and Chief Steward Ray Murrihy denied there was a steroid epidemic, but Murphy conceded the use of trenbolone had been widespread. The drug has been detected in stables in three states.

#### Behrens Tops New York Work Tab:

Behrens (Pleasant Colony) worked five furlongs over Saratoga's Oklahoma Training Track in 1:02 Monday morning. Winner of the GII Suburban H. in his last outing, the four-year-old James Bond trainee starts next in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga Aug. 1.

Suburban runner-up **Catienus** (Storm Cat), also aiming for the Whitney, went five furlongs Sunday in :59 4/5 at Belmont. In his first start after being claimed for \$60,000 in April at Aqueduct, the five-year-old won the Charles Staats Memorial S. just before his Suburban run.

On Monday, Overbrook Farm's Tactical Cat (Storm Cat) had his first breeze since suffering a condylar fracture of his left front cannon bone after winning the GI Hollywood Futurity last December, going three furlongs in :37 at Belmont. "He's just getting into his regular working pattern," said Mike Marlow, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He should be ready for the fall meet here. He's made a full recovery. He's still a little small-framed, but his temperament is a lot better."

Mossflower (Affirmed), who returned from a year's absence to run second in a July 9 allowance, worked five furlongs Monday in :59 4/5 over the Belmont training track. "She breezed great," said trainer Richard Schosberg. "She went easy, just galloping really. She's got a long stride, so she covered a lot of ground. I'm still pointing her towards the (GI) Go for Wand (Aug. 7 at Saratoga.)"

#### Migliore Out of Hospital:

Jockey Richard Migliore, who suffered a broken right forearm and a concussion in a spill Saturday, was released from North Shore University Hospital Tuesday. He faces about eight weeks of recovery and hopes to be back by the end of Belmont's fall meeting.

#### FOREST WILDCAT COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON

**OPENER** A colt by Forest Wildcat out of General's Mistress (General Meeting) brought a final bid of \$525,000 to top the opening session of the Fasig-Tipton July Selected Yearling Sale, held yesterday in Lexington. The bay, who is out of a half sister to MGSW Diablo, was consigned by Oak Ridge, agent, and purchased by Kirkwood Thoroughbreds, owned by Al and Sandee Kirkwood of Washington. The first crop from the stallion Hennessy continued to sell well; he was represented by the second-highest priced colt and the top-selling filly. The colt, consigned by Denali Stud, agent, was purchased for \$300,000 by D. Wayne Lukas for Padua Stables. The filly, out of Beckys Shirt (Cure the Blues), was from the consignment of NoName Ranch, agent, and went for \$255,000 to Michael Elliott. "We had a great opening session," Fasig-Tipton Director of Marketing Terence Collier said. "Every measure you might use to calculate the success of a sale was a very positive measure for us. There was an extremely high clearance rate--the buyback rate was very low. There was a strong market through virtually every price range, and it was equally strong for both fillies and colts. We had a lot of pinhookers and a lot of owner/buyers participating." As last year's sale was a single session, comparisons can't be made until after this year's two-day auction concludes. Today's final session begins at 11 a.m.
