MENIFEE TOPS HASKELL WEIGHTS GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness runner-up Menifee (Harlan) has been assigned top weight of 124 pounds for the Aug. 8 \$1 million Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park. Three three-year-olds are weighted one pound below him at 123: GI Swaps S. winner Cat Thief (Storm Cat), Swaps runner-up General Challenge (General Meeting) and GI Belmont S. hero Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), who is expected to start in the GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga the same afternoon instead. The filly Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy), who gets a five-pound sex allowance, is weighted at 118, which rates her one pound below Menifee on the scale. Her stablemate, Forestry (Storm Cat), received 118 pounds as well. According to Monmouth Director of Racing Mike Dempsey, trainer Bob Baffert could run both Forestry and General Challenge in the Haskell. Vicar (Wild Again), a possible for the Haskell, was assigned 120 pounds.

SALES COMPANIES ASK FOR NTRA SUPPORT

Fasig-Tipton and Keeneland sales companies will begin asking buyers to donate one percent of the price of their purchases to the National Thoroughbred Racing Association. The one-percent buyers program is scheduled to begin with Fasig-Tipton's Saratoga Yearling Sales Aug. 10-12. Last year, buyers, sellers and consignors were asked to support the NTRA through a voluntary one-tenth of one percent contribution, but that program proved difficult to implement. Buyers will be asked to notify the sales companies if they do not wish to contribute through the new program. "The new program will allow us to have a fair, broad-based contribution system that will help fund the national marketing initiatives we have begun," said NTRA Commissioner Tim Smith. Buyers' donations are projected to produce \$4.7 million in revenues for the NTRA. News cont. p3

ANOTHER FATAL ACCIDENT IN BELMONT PADDOCK Lanvinity (Bold Merc) became the second fatality in the Belmont Park paddock this meet when she reared up and flipped over before the fifth race yesterday. Jockey Diane Nelson was about to get a leg up on the four-year-old filly when the accident occurred. "She flipped over and hit her head hard on the ground, right at the base of her skull," said Dr. Neil A. Cleary, chief examining veterinarian for the New York Racing Association. "She died as a direct result of her injuries." Trainer Joseph Pantaleo said, "We turned around and the next thing we knew, she was on the ground. I've never had any trouble with this horse before. Sometimes with blinkers on, when they rear up, they can't see to the sides and they lose their balance. I don't know. This is just awful." GISW Three Ring was killed in a similar incident prior to the June 26 GI Mother Goose S. She was euthanized at the scene.
