Third behind champion Silverbulletday in the GIII Davona Dale S. at the Fair Grounds in February, On a Soapbox took four months off after that race, coming back to post a Churchill Downs allowance score at a 1 1/16 miles June 25. Stretching out to 1 1/2 miles as a distant second choice to GI Mother Goose S. winner Dreams Gallore, the bay shadowed pacesetter Strolling Belle to the top of the stretch, turned back a bid from the favorite and drew off with authority. Trainer Niall O'Callaghan revealed he nearly didn't run the filly. "We were 50-50 all week," he said. "I entered her in Delaware and thought she could win the race down there. But I also felt when I bought her last year that she was a mile-and-a-half horse. I shipped her to Delaware (from Churchill Downs), then shipped her here at 4:30 this morning." The filly will likely go next in the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga Aug. 21. Jockey Robby Albarado, aboard Dreams Gallore, said, "I can't make an excuse for her. She gave me 110 percent. I saved ground and cut the corners and still couldn't beat that horse."

It was thought Daylami would not stay this trip in a strongly run race, but that misconception was laid to rest in no uncertain terms as he produced a spectacular burst of acceleration to leave a field of quality rivals in his wake. It was one of the easiest victories ever seen in this race. In winning, Daylami provided jockey Frankie Dettori with his third win in the race and gave Godolphin its fourth win in five years. Daliapour (Sadler's Wells) was sent into an immediate lead ahead of the intended front-runner Nedawi and set a good pace, with Daylami biding his time in fourth. Nedawi headed Daliapour with five furlongs to go and still held the call over Daliapour and Oath as the field swung into the straight. Daylami seemed to struggle briefly at this point, but as Oath and Daliapour began to fade at the two-furlong marker, he came with his challenge on the outside, quickening 1 ½ furlongs out and instantly going clear. He ran on strongly to the line as Nedawi kept on for a memorable Godolphin one-two. "We went a good lick, but I was worried about his inside draw so I had to get out and give him a chance," said Dettori. "When he picked it up in the straight he gave me goose pimples and we went past the rest as if they were standing still. I swear to God, Daylami would have beaten anybody today. He put five lengths between himself and the others in just half a furlong." Sheikh Mohammed added, "Maybe the field was not quite as strong as it has been for the race in some years, but he won really well. He will race again this year, but he is going to retire to the Aga Khan's Gilltown Stud in Ireland at the end of the season."

Stellar Brush almost never runs a bad race. Sixth in the Mar. 14 GII Louisiana Derby in his lone off-theboard showing, the bay had been in the money in four straight stakes since, winning the June 13 Leonard Richard S. at Delaware Park before finishing second in the Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows in his latest July 4. He picked up his first graded win with a six-wide sweep around the final turn, rallying from 10th and just holding off the another late closer, Ecton Park, to take the photo. "(Stellar Brush) really heated up before the race, and I could tell he was anxious to get in the gate and go," jockey Mike McCarthy told the Thoroughbred Times. "We were sitting pretty good, in the second group of horses in the clubhouse turn. He was a little closer than usual, but he felt comfortable the whole way." Added trainer Richard Small, "He was looking around at the eighth pole, but when (Ecton Park) came at us, (Stellar Brush) picked it up and my heart started beating again. The fractions were pretty fast and that helped my confidence as the race went on. We felt pretty confident coming into this race."

The unbeaten winner of the G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 11, Rossini maintained his perfect record in fine style, guickening away from a small field for an easy win. The odds-on favorite broke well and disputed the lead at a good pace from the outside with the German-trained challenger Auenklang. He took a clear advantage with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and quickened away in the last 100 yards despite drifting left toward the rail to record a comfortable success. The runner-up ran greenly once headed and wandered slightly under pressure, but kept on well enough to hold second. Finnan ran on strongly from the rear to snatch third in the dying strides. Said winning trainer Aidan O'Brien, "The timing of this race suited us with regard to the (G1 Phoenix Heinz 57 S. at Leopardstown, Aug. 8) or the (G1 Prix Morny at Deauville, Aug. 22). Outstanding older horse Ungaro (Goofalik), winner of this race last year, went to Italy May 29 to contest the G2 Premio Ellington, but went lame and had to be withdrawn. He returned to Italy June 20 and finished runner-up by only a nose to Dark Moondancer (GB) in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano over this trip. On that form Ungaro should have the measure of the two good three-year-old colts Silvano (Lomitas {GB}) and Sumitas (Lomitas {GB}), both of whom disappointed when finishing fourth and fifth, respectively, in the G1 BMW Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 4. Silvano had previously won the G2 Oppenheim-Colonia Union-Rennen at Cologne June 13, when G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) winner Sumitas was only sixth. Trainer Sir Michael Stoute has a rare runner in Germany in the progressive Dark Shell (Darshaan {GB}), who won the Listed Aston Park S. at Newbury May 15 by seven lengths on only his second start of the year.
