Approximately 20,000 people turned up to witness one of the highlights of German racing this season, billed as a showdown between Sumitas and Ungaro, second by a nose in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano June 20 in his latest start. The pair provided a battling display, with the latter just prevailing in a tight finish. Only five contenders assembled at the start, but a lack of quantity did not mean a lack of quality. Andrasch Starke sent last year's winner Ungaro straight to the lead as Sumitas raced in second. Both traveled well within themselves and, once into the straight, Ungaro quickened from the front, but Sumitas was still there to challenge. Both hooked up for a duel, with the topweight Ungaro going slightly better than his unrelenting rival. The effort went some way toward the redemption of Sumitas' reputation, and he regained his position as the the leader of the Classic generation with this performance.

Christmas Boy took a Santa Anita optional claimer by 5 1/2 lengths last October, but didn't resurface again before running second in the June 27 GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park. The dark bay gelding, third choice of the California bettors, sprinted out to set the pace and widened his advantage at every call for an easy victory. "He was really running," admitted winning rider Corey Nakatani. "I'd ridden him one time before in a route race and he ran great. I knew he was a better horse sprinting. I knew I could make the lead out of there, so I just helped him get started. He was running all the way." Winning trainer John Sadler added, "I've had a lot of great sprinters. This horse is turning into a great sprinter. We wanted to be in front in this race. We thought that the favorites were stalkers. We wanted to take advantage of any pace scenario that might be favorable for us. And it worked out. Those splits were really realistic for these kinds of horses (:22.36, :44.66, :56.14)." As for what's next for Christmas Boy, Sadler said, "The (Aug. 14 GII) Pat O'Brien is possible. When they run this big a race you want to make sure the spacing is right for the next race. We don't want to run him back too quick." Son of a Pistol chased the pacesetting winner but could never mount a serious challenge, while favored Big Jag (Kleven), winner of three straight, including the Apr. 3 GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H., lacked a late rally and finished fourth.

BELMONT NUMBERS UP Belmont Park concluded its 55-day spring meeting yesterday, with figures for total handle shooting up 20.9 percent from last year and on-track handle increasing 2.2 percent. Total handle reached \$621,924,775 compared to the 1998 figure of \$514,519,158. On-track handle was \$112,297,380--up from \$109,860,598 in 1998. Ontrack attendance was 493,155--up slightly from last year's 491,604. "We're extremely pleased with the results of this meeting," said New York Racing Association President and COO Terry Meyocks. "Wagering from all sources reached almost \$12 million per day, much higher than any other Belmont meeting. And all our numbers were up." Racing begins Wednesday at Saratoga.

THE GROOM IS RED SIDELINED A condylar fracture has sidelined last year's GI Champagne S. winner The Groom is Red (Runaway Groom), according to Daily Racing Form. The injury was discovered after the three-year-old colt worked five furlongs at Belmont Monday. The Groom is Red was operated on at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Kentucky and trainer Nick Zito told the Form his charge could return to training in 60-90 days. Winless in five starts this year, most recently finishing eighth in the May 23 GIII Peter Pan S., The Groom is Red has won three of 12 starts for earnings of \$329,220.

Daylami Points to Arc:

Saturday's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) is now being aimed towards the Oct. 3 G1 Prix de I'Arc de Triomphe, with the G1 Esat Digifone Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 11 likely to be his warm-up race. Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said yesterday, "Obviously, those two races are under serious consideration by (owner) Sheikh Maktoum, because timing-wise, they fit into Daylami's schedule very well. The Arc is a big target for any of the top older horses and that's the race I think we'll be aiming him at." 

Dismissed as the third-longest shot in this eight-horse field after three straight stakes losses on the grass, including a tiring third in the Lamplighter H. at Monthmouth July 3 at a sixteenth of a mile shorter than this event, North East Bound entered this race with just one stakes win to his credit. Swamp, never far back, was brushed by the winner at the top of the stretch and continued willingly through the lane, but couldn't get past the top two. "He is a natural speed horse and they let him go in :25 and :49," commented winning rider Jose Velez, Jr. "When he gets those fractions, it is going to take a good hrose to beat him. When they came to me, I had a lot of horse left. He just did not want to get beat."
