More Than Ready came into this effort off victories in three consecutive stakes, the May 1 WHAS S. at Churchill, the Flash S. at Belmont June 4 and his first graded stakes victory in his last, a 4 1/2-length success in the July 4 GIII Tremont. In that win, the colt broke the 5 1/2-furlong track record held by, among others, Ruffian. More Than Ready, in receipt of first-time Lasix, and second choice Dance Master (Gone West) raced as a team through the opening stages, though jockey John Velazguez was content to rate off the latter to the far turn. Velazquez cut his mount loose nearing the top of the stretch and the response was immediate, as More Than Ready put daylight between himself and the rest of the field to lead by seven at the stretch call and was ridden out the balance to another impressive score. Mighty, third for much of the race, finished with good energy to be second. Winning trainer Todd Pletcher said, "I don't know what he could have done to be any more impressive than that. He rated off the faster horse in the early part of it. When it came time to take control of the race, he did it impressively." Velazquez was equally impressed. "This horse placed himself. It is easy when you have a good horse underneath you. In all my years of riding, I have never seen a two-year-old respond so quickly," he said. Pletcher has mapped out a tentative campaign for the rest of the year to include the GI Hopeful Sept. 4, the GI Champagne Oct. 9 and the Breeders' Cup Juvenile.

Seignorial (Kingmambo) set a tidy pace. Entering the straight, Three Cheers took over from the fading pacesetter, but he was simply blown away at the three-furlong pole as Kayf Tara produced a stunning burst of acceleration. quickly putting daylight between himself and his rivals. Kayf Tara, already the 1998 G1 Irish St. Leger and G1 Ascot Gold Cup winner, is now a possibility for the Nov. 2 G1 Melbourne Cup at Flemington Park. Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "It was good to see him win like that on this ground. We would not have run him if we had been worried about the ground, but he has shown in the past that he likes it when it's a bit softer. Before he goes to Australia, there are any number of races he could run in. There is the [G2] Prix Kergolay at Deauville [Aug. 22], the [G3] Doncaster Cup [Sept. 9] or the [G1] Irish St. Leger [at The Curragh Sept. 18], which he won last year."
