STORM CAT BREEDING RIGHTS TO

COOLMORE According to published reports, Coolmore Stud yesterday reached a deal with Overbrook Farm to acquire lifetime breeding rights to the top stallion **Storm Cat** (Storm Bird). The number of breeding rights involved was not disclosed. Ric Waldman, adviser to Overbrook, told the *Blood Horse*, "It eliminates some of the risk of holding onto the entire asset ourselves. And it made good economic sense." Storm Cat stood for a stud fee of \$200,000 this year and his fee will rise to \$250,000 for 2000. The 16-year-old was the second-leading sire in 1998. Through July 20, he topped the 1999 general sire list with progeny earnings of over \$4.27 million. He has sired 44 graded-stakes winners to date.

U.S. HORSES NOMINATED TO AUSSIE RACES A

total of 74 horses from the Northern Hemisphere have been nominated for the Nov. 2 Melbourne Cup, Oct. 23 Cox Plate (the Australian leg of the Emirates World Series Racing Championship) and Oct. 16 Caulfield Cup and for the first time, horses from the U.S. were among them. American trainers Neil Drysdale and Michael Dickinson nominated **Single Empire (Ire)** (Kris {GB}) and **Amerique (St. Jovite)**, respectively, for the Caulfield and Melbourne Cups this year. Single Empire won the G1 San Juan Capistrano H. on his latest start April 18 and took the G1 Italian Derby in 1997. Amerique has won just three of 22 starts, with his most recent victory coming in last year's San Juan Capistrano. He goes today in the G1 United Nations H. at Monmouth. "The main goal for Amerique this year will be the Melbourne Cup," Dickinson said. "That will be a challenge. This will be the first time a horse from America has gone down to Australia to run in...their greatest race." Also nominated to the Melbourne Cup are Godolphin's duo of **Central Park (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) and **Kayf Tara (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). Trainer Dermot Weld, who won the 1993 edition with Vintage Crop (Ire), has G3 Meld S. winner **Make No Mistake (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) on the list for both the Cox Plate and Melbourne Cup. France is represented in the Cox Plate nominations for the first time this year, as Francois Doumen has signed up **Jim And Tonic (Fr)** (Double Bed {Fr}), winner of the '98 Hong Kong International Bowl; Godolphin has **Xaar (GB)** (Zafonic) and trainer Mark Johnston nominated **Fruits of Love (Hansel)** for the race.

The winner of the nine-furlong GII Dixie S. at Pimlico May 15, Middlesex Drive was then third behind division leader Yagli in the June 5 GI Manhattan H. going 1 1/4 miles at Belmont and second, beaten a neck, in the one-mile June 27 GIII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill. Three-for-four at this distance and on the board in every start since blinkers were added to his equipment for his last appearance of 1998, the chestnut was off as the favorite and led every step, holding on gamely at the wire to take the photo. "I was a little surprised he showed speed," winning jockey Shane Sellers said. "If you look at his form, he tends to stay back, but he was just galloping along today. At the quarter pole, I knew I had enough horse to win." Plans call for the winner to go next in Saratoga's GIII Fourstardave H. Aug. 28.

The elevation of this race from Group 2 to Group 1 status has been justified as a truly outstanding bunch of fillies, including three Group 1 winners, will face the starter. **Alborada** took this race last year, with **Kissogram** fourth, and will make her first start since taking the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket last October, where she beat both **Insatiable** (Ire) and **Daylami** (Ire). A wide-open race, with three horses making their U.S. bows. **Sweet Ludy** (Be My Guest), the GII Honey-moon H. winner May 23, is the lukewarm choice. Nick Canani, who won this race last year with European shipper **Sicy d'Alsace** (Fr) at 41-1, has another import in **Markale** (Marmato {GB}), winner of two Listed events in her native France in her last two starts. She has won half of her 14 career races, but has yet to face this kind of company. **Camargo** (Brief Truce), formerly in the hands of Dermot Weld in Ireland, should find something here she has never seen, firm turf. She won last year's G3 Railway S. on heavy going at The Curragh June 28, but was trounced in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. Sept. 6, her last racetrack appearance. **Lady At Peace** (Lord At War {Arg}) has taken three of four on the turf and is perfect in three starts at this distance, all against lesser company.

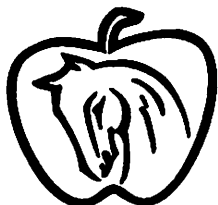
