
In this corner, Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance), third in the Dubai World Cup two starts back and an eye-popping, five-length winner in his last start in the GII Stephen Foster at Churchill Downs. The bay ran well over this surface when second in last year's GI Travers S. and has trained well since the Foster. In the opposite corner comes Behrens (Pleasant Colony), virtually unstoppable since this winter with four consecutive victories, two of those of the Grade I variety, and most recently hero of the GII Suburban H. at Belmont Park July 5. He too has demonstrated his affinity for these environs when second in the 1997 Travers. Three works over the deep Oklahoma training track should have him ready for this tilt. Sir Bear (Sir Leon), winner of the GI Met Mile, and Nite Dreamer (El Prado {Ire}), the GIII Cornhusker Breeders' Cup victor, seem most likely to fill out the trifecta.

Marley Vale was given some time away from the races following her juvenile swan song, a third-place finish in the GI Matron, but came back none the worse for wear, as she started 1999 with an allowance victory and a three-length score in the Feb. 24 Jeano S. at Gulfstream Park. The bay made her next three starts going two turns, the highlight of which was a clear second-place finish to Silverbulletday in the GI Ashland, but it was decided that routing was not her game, thus the return to sprinting. Well supported off her neck loss in the GII Prioress, Marley Vale broke well and secured a cozy spot for herself in behind the front runners. As the field reached the top of the stretch, jockey John Velazquez had his filly in gear in the four path and she closed menacingly, taking over outside the eighth pole and drawing off to the victory. Favored Olympic Charmer (Olympio) was up with the pace early, but was finished after a half. Trainer Todd Pletcher, winning the Test for the second year in a row (Jersey Girl--1998), commented, "Everything worked out beautifully. The Prioress was a terrific prep for her and I thought she would move forward after that race." The conditioner indicated that his charge would not be wheeled back for the 10-furlong GI Alabama, but is under consideration for the GI Ballerina H. at seven furlongs against older fillies and mares Aug. 22.

Conservatively managed throughout his career, but especially this year, Yagli was second to loose-onthe-lead Buck's Boy in the Breeders' Cup Turf and then second to another free-runner in Lazy Lode in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup to close out 1998. Brought back for the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 6, the chestnut was 13 lengths off the lead early on, but rallied through the stretch to score by three-parts-of-a-length and in his last start June 5, exhibited a devastating turn of foot through the final quarter mile to win the GI Manhattan H. by 2½ lengths. Unhurried through the opening six furlongs of this event, Yagli inched closer to front-running Supreme Sound leaving the half-mile pole, collared that rival turning for home and won under a Jerry Bailey hand ride." Said Bailey, "I know there is a race two weeks from now they are looking at, so I didn't want to make it too hard on him." Trainer Bill Mott confirmed that the GI \$400,000 Sword Dancer H. Aug. 14 is under serious consideration for Yagli's next outing.

Zahrat Dubai, winner of the G3 Tattersalls Musidora S. in May and third in the G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom in June, gave the Godolphin team its third Group 1 win in a week and Gary Stevens his first European success at this level with a game victory. Stevens sent Zahrat Dubai into the lead soon after the start. Down the straight, Zahrat Dubai looked set to be swamped by several challengers, but the filly kept finding more and, despite drifting in towards the rail and appearing to impede Kissogram's run well inside the final furlong, she battled on gamely to the line. The winner survived a stewards' inquiry, but Stevens came away from his first Group 1 win with a two-day ban for careless riding. "It was hard to choose between Zahrat Dubai and Cape Verdi (Ire) (Caerleon) before the race," said Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford. "Zahrat Dubai looked a high-class filly when she won the Musidora and we knew she would go on the fast ground here because she had gone very well on it in the trials in Dubai. It looks as thought a mile and a quarter is her best trip, especially as she did not look as though she got home in the Oaks." The 1998 G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas winner Cape Verdi raced in last early and never threatened in a dull performance. While Crisford would not comment on the filly's future, her rider Frankie Dettori said, "It's clear that the injury she had last year has taken its toll. It's very sad but she's only a shadow of what she was."

Brave Act (Persian Bold {Ire}) has run eight consecutive races with triple-digit Beyer Speed Figures, five of which resulted in wins. The dark bay won the GIII Inglewood H. two back before coming home fifth, beaten only two lengths, in the GII Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile June 13. He seems to fire his best shot when fresh and looks primed to score the elusive Grade I. Hawksley Hill (Rahy), third in last year's Read, runs his race every time, but often settles for minor awards. Though winless in his last four efforts, the chestnut's margin of defeat is less than one length combined. Third by 1/2 length in the Shoemaker and third by a neck in the GI Early Times Turf Classic before that, he is one who will appreciate the extra furlong of this event. Ladies Din (Din's Dancer) is a perfect four for four over this turf having accounted for the 1998 GII Del Mar Derby. The gelding showed renewed signs of life when second by a nose in the Shoemaker, that after encountering some traffic at the quarter pole.

#### Sunline to the States?:

The connections of G1 Doncaster H. winning filly Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) have been approached by Breeder's Cup organizers to start the filly in the Breeder's Cup Turf. "They have dangled a bit of bait in front of us," trainer and part-owner Trevor McKee said. "It was a bit surprising, but it shows they are on the ball." The race is only a fortnight after Sunline's main goal, the AUS\$1.8 million (US\$1,184,211) Cox Plate in Melbourne Oct. 23. Sunline, who turns four when the new season begins Aug. 1, has won 11 of her 13 starts.

### Australia's Premiership Winners:

A win by the regally bred colt Commands (Aus) (Danehill) enabled trainer John Hawkes to end the Australian season on a high note. His 97 Sydney wins earned him the trainers premiership. Hawkes runs a four-state training operation for Australia's largest owners, Jack and Bob Ingham. Commands, a full brother to five-time Group 1 winner Danewin, was beaten a nose in the G3 Missile S., but won on protest. He was early favorite for the Golden Slipper before his campaign was aborted by sore shins. Trainer Peter Hayes, son of the late Colin Hayes, won the Melbourne title and jockeys Larry Cassidy (119 wins) and Damien Oliver (89.5 wins) won the Sydney and Melbourne premierships respectively.


