TO THE "VICTOR" BELONGS WHITNEY

SPOILS Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance) drove past Behrens (Pleasant Colony) in the final sixteenth and held on as the five-year-old came back at him to win yesterday's GI Whitney H. at Saratoga by the bob of a head. It could have gone either way. "I didn't think I got beat," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "I thought maybe it was a dead-heat or maybe I got the nod. But when Behrens saw my horse, he dug in. It was so close, I couldn't be sure." Behrens now leads the "NTRA Champions on FOX" with 46 points, but trainer Jim Bond said yesterday that the colt will not go to California for the final race in the series, the \$1 million GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 29, instead waiting for the Oct. 10 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont. Victory Gallop, second in the standings with 26 points, is possible for the Pacific Classic, which would set up a rematch with archenemy Real Quiet (Quiet American). Real Quiet is now third in the NTRA series with 22 points. The two rivals have not met since Victory Gallop spoiled Real Quiet's Triple Crown bid with a nose win in the '98 GI Belmont S. "(The Pacific Classic) is something we have thought about," Victory Gallop's trainer Elliott Walden said. "We've intended to do it. We'll sure take a look at the race. If he runs in the next four to six weeks, it will be in the Pacific Classic."

GARY STEVENS HEADED HOME Jockey Gary Stevens vesterday confirmed that he has signed to ride for The Thoroughbred Corporation and will leave his job as Sir Michael Stoute's stable rider in Britain late this month. "He is going and it is very disappointing," Sir Michael said. "I understand the situation and it has been a pleasure to be associated with him." Stevens added, "It was only for somebody like Prince Ahmed [Salman] that I would consider leaving England so soon. Prince Ahmed has set up a highly successful organization. He is a very knowledgable horseman and is one of the emerging major players in world racing." Salman, who has most of his horses in training in the U.S., although he also has significant interests in Britain, said, "It is very exciting news that Gary has agreed to join us. I am sure the experience he has gained from riding in Britain through the summer will add an extra ingredient to his overall ability." Stoute has yet to decide what to do about a jockey, but a link-up with Kieren Fallon does look likely.

Victory Gallop, winner of last year's GI Belmont S. by a nose, had won two of his three starts this season, taking an allowance race at Gulfstream Mar. 3 before traveling halfway across the world to run third in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 28. He showed no ill effects from that long journey when he came back for the GII Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs June 12, putting in an explosive move to win by five in track-record time. The odds-on choice to do it again, the four-yearold was last after a half, but came with a three-wide sweep on the final turn as second choice Behrens rallied even wider in front of him. Behrens took a short lead as they straightened for home; jockey Jerry Bailey kept Victory Gallop out in the middle of the track for his late run and they took over in the final yards, but Behrens battled back and just missed in a tight photo. "It was just a fantastic race," winning trainer Elliott Walden said. "The two champions showed up. Victory Gallop is a real professional with a lot of confidence right now. When he makes that run, it's scintillating to watch."

Joe Who was the best miler in his native Brazil in both 1997 and 1998, and his only stakes victories in the U.S. had all come at that distance, including his last start, the June 27 GIII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill Downs. Trainer Bob Baffert had only sent his South American charge nine furlongs twice and he was fourth both times, in the 1998 GII Citation H. on the turf and the GIII Native Diver H. on the dirt. Returning to the West Coast from his three-race Churchill junket while looking for two in a row and his second graded win north of the equator, the chestnut was angled in quickly from his outside post position to challenge longshot Bouccaneer on the front end. He dropped back slightly turning for home, then led a charge through the stretch to take the photo. "When we turned for home, he was running," said jockey Chris Antley. "He just wasn't running as fast as the others. But when that horse [Ladies Din] came up next to me, my horse dug in." Baffert wasn't concerned when his horse lost ground. "I told Chris Antley that when they seem to get away from you, you might think you're out of horse, but you're not out of horse," he said. "He will fight. He will kick in."


