BREEDERS' CUP CHAMPIONS RETURN A pair of Champions make their respective return to the races on opposite sides of the country this afternoon. The 1997 Champion two-year-old filly, Countess Diana (Deerhound), away from the races since a sixth-place finish in the GI Gazelle H. last Sept. 12, returns for new trainer Mary Jo Lohmeier in today's sixth race at Saratoga. The bay worked with renewed interest at Keeneland in July and has posted two local drills since her arrival at the Spa. "Countess" will face six other rivals and breaks from post position six under Jorge Chavez. Elmhurst (Wild Again), victorious in the 1997 Breeders' Cup Sprint, faces nine others in this afternoon's co-featured seventh race at Del Mar. Sent to the farm after a ninth-place finish in the 1998 GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H., the gelding did not take well to retirement and has trained forwardly for his return. Regular rider Corey Nakatani is back aboard from post nine.

Sweeping swept to victory at first asking, taking a June 13 maiden field wire-to-wire and followed that effort with a second-place finish in the July 10 Masao Moriya S. leading past the eighth pole, but getting caught at the wire to lose by a neck. A two-horse race throughout, Sweeping took over from Fast Dispersal after a half, carried that one wide into the stretch, bumping and then outgaming her rival to the wire. The trainer of Fast Dispersal, Manny Tortora, claimed foul against the winner, but it was disallowed by the stewards. Both winner and runner up go in the next leg of the FSS, the Sept. 4 Susan's Girl at seven panels.
