IT'S ALL IN THE FAMILY FOR MENIFEE, FASLIYEV It was a family affair on Sunday, as Menifee took the GI Haskell while Fasliyev, out of a half sister to the Haskell winner, scored in Ireland's G1 Heinz 57 S. Menifee fulfilled the high expectations held for him when he was a rallying winner of the GI Blue Grass at Keeneland Apr. 11. The big bay bulled his way down the Churchill stretch in the Kentucky Derby, just failing to catch Charismatic, and came back two weeks later to run second again to that rival in the Preakness. In his last appearance, Menifee was in contention to the quarter pole of the Belmont S. June 5, ultimately fading to a disappointing eighth. As Forestry and a three-wide Cat Thief disputed the early pace, jockey Pat Day positioned Menifee in a pocket just behind the frontrunners. Rounding into the stretch, Forestry was still in front, with Cat Thief breathing down his neck and Menifee ranging up three wide. Menifee continued a steady advance into the final sixteenth and finally wore down his two rivals to report home a narrow winner. Cat Thief just bested Forestry at the line, while Unbridled Jet (Unbridled), snatched up off heels at the furlong marker, finished full of run to be fourth. Said winning trainer Elliott Walden, "This was the true Menifee who showed up today. It's great to see him back in great form after the disappointing Belmont. If he comes back well, we'll go to Saratoga for the (Aug. 28 Gl) Travers."

four in Sunday's Heinz 57 Phoenix S., but not without causing his supporters great concern in the closing stages. Taking the lead from the start, Fasliyev did not find it easy on the very soft ground, but began to quicken away from his rivals over a furlong out, then

veered sharply towards the stands rail. His rider, Michael Kinane, managed to straighten him eventually

inside the final 100 yards and he plugged on, with the filly Yara finishing well to grab second, her seventh

runner-up spot in seven lifetime starts. Winning trainer Aidan O'Brien said, "He wants racing now and could

possibly go for the [G1] Prix Morny at Deauville [Aug. 22] or the [G2] Champagne S. at Doncaster [Sept. 10].

He had got very relaxed at home since winning at Ascot and probably wasn't concentrating today."

Maintaining his perfect record for the season, Diktat took his first Group 1 race when coming from last to first to win in good style. He had previously been successful in the Shergar Cup Seven at Goodwood May 8, and in the G3 Van Geest Criterion S. at Newmarket June 26. Diktat struggled to go with the unforgiving pace as Special Discount (Nureyev) headed Bertolini for the early lead. Vision Of Night (GB) (Night Shift) was surprisingly close to the front, along with Orpen (Lure), who raced freely to post, and Bianconi (Danzig), as Keos (Riverman), Gold Away and Diktat trailed. Bertolini went to the front at halfway and maintained the fast tempo, while Diktat was switched to the wide outside to deliver his challenge entering the final quarter, where he came under pressure from Frankie Dettori. Running on strongly, Diktat got to the front just over half a furlong from the line and, despite drifting slightly left, kept on well for a comfortable success. Gold Away ran on well from the rear and wrested second from Bertolini in the last 50 yards. Dettori said, "They went very, very quick and, as he has been running over seven furlongs, he had trouble in staying close at the beginning. As they had gone so quick, the field came back to me and he won well in the end. He had no problems with the ground and it was just about perfect for him."

After finishing 12th as part of the mutuel field in the May 1 Kentucky Derby, Ecton Park returned for an easy win in a Churchill Downs allowance June 23, followed by a close second-place effort in his most recent start, the GII Ohio Derby July 24. Sent off the fifth choice in the seven-horse Jim Dandy field, Ecton Park raced close to the pace early, advanced three wide on the second turn, took command approaching the stretch and drew away in the drive under a hand ride to win his first graded stakes as much the best. "We had been hoping to win a graded stakes with him," said Ecton Park's 41-year-old owner Mark Stanley, from Lexington, Kentucky. "I had no idea how he would run over the mud. He had never run over it. It seems like he kind of liked it." When asked what's next for the Jim Dandy winner, Stanley said, "I think he might go next in the (GIII, \$300,000) Pennsylvania Derby (at Philadelphia Park Sept. 6) and then in the (GI, \$500,000) Super Derby (at Louisiana Downs Oct. 2). But of course, (trainer) Elliott (Walden) is the manager and I trust his judgment. (Ecton Park) has already established himself for a solid stud career." Runner-up Lemon Drop Kid, unraced since his score in the GI Belmont S. June 5, is slated to run next in the \$1 million Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 28. Bill Mott, trainer of Vision and Verse (Storm Cat), who finished sixth as the 2-1 favorite, said, "(Jockey) Shane (Sellers) said he didn't handle the track at all...We're going to run in the Travers only if it's a fast track."

A Lady From Dixie broke her maiden Feb. 24 and had won three of her four starts since, with her only defeat coming in the GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood May 31. Winner of an optional claimer over the Hollywood turf in her last start June 24, A Lady From Dixie tracked pacesetter Yolo Lady through the early stages, gained a short lead at the top of the stretch and held on gamely to hold off heavily-favored Manistique for her first stakes win. "She ran good," said winning jockey Chris Antley. "No, she ran dynamite. This is about as good as she gets." Manistique, winner of the GI Vanity H. in her last start June 26, rallied from off the pace for the place spot. "I just don't understand," said her jockey Chris McCarron. "She seemed to handle the track okay. She just wasn't there this afternoon."

Belenus was having his first start since his victory in the German Derby at Hamburg July 4, and was made the favorite. He was quick out of the stalls, as was the English contender Peshtigo (Kris S.). Both colts fought for the lead and Belenus eventually settled in second in the closely bunched field, with Ituango third, Bedford Forrest (Law Society) fourth with the Polish Derby winner Country Club the backmarker. Into the straight Peshtigo was soon tackled by Belenus, who ran on well to dispute the lead with just under two furlongs to run, and he went clear very easily, winning in the style of a good horse. Ituango just held on for second from the fast-finishing Country Club. In winning this race, Belenus became only the second Derby winner to win this race as well, emulating All My Dreams (Ire) in 1995. Belenus is a member of Lomitas' first crop.

The winner of the GIII Grey Breeders' Cup at two, Black Cash was put onto the Triple Crown trail after finishing third in the GIII Derby Trial last year. After fifth-place finishes in the Preakness and Leonard Richards S., the homebred went to the sidelines, resurfacing to win an Aqueduct allowance Apr. 3 by 10 lengths. Sixth in the GI Carter off that effort, the bay was most recently third to Frisk Me Now in the July 4 GII Iselin at Monmouth Park. Heavily favored in this spot, the gelding was content to sit in second off sensible fractions to the stretch, took over at will and was eased down in the final 100 yards. GSW City By Night (Slew City Slew) was with the pace early but dropped out of it soon thereafter and was eased through the stretch.

Marquette (Spectacular Bid) won the Budweiser Challenger S. in only his third start on the green, was second in the GIII Palm Beach S. at Gulfstream Feb. 15 and was a powerful five-length victor of Keeneland's Forerunner S. Apr. 16 in his most recent racetrack appearance with Lasix added. Three outstanding recent turf breezes, including a local six furlongs in 1:12 3/5, should have the bay ready for the comebacker. One look at the running lines of Monkey Puzzle (Country Pine) shows that the bay can be relied upon to come running late. He was a fast-closing fourth in the GIII Hill Prince at this trip two back and finished well to be second by 1 3/4 lengths in the GIII Lexington July 18 at Belmont Park. Phi Beta Doc (Doc's Leader) won the Nick Shuk Memorial at Delaware Park and Monmouth Park's Lamplighter S. back to back, before coming home fourth by 1 1/4 lengths to North East Bound (D'Accord) in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup July 25. He wheels back on short rest, but zipped a bullet five furlongs Aug. 4 over the local green.

COUNTESS VICTORIOUS IN RETURN Countess

Diana (Deerhound), winless since her victory in the 1997 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, made an overdue return to the winner's circle with a 5 3/4-length victory in vesterday's sixth race at Saratoga. In her last racetrack appearance, the Champion two-year-old filly was sixth in the GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Sept. 12. Showing the good early speed which was her trademark as a two-year-old, the bay sped to the early lead and never looked back. The winner was making her first start for trainer Mary Jo Lohmeier. "She was training great, it was just a question of whether mentally she was going to be back in the game or not," the trainer said. "It was extremely rewarding. I think it was the first time I cried watching a horse cross the wire." Although Countess Diana is nominated to the seven-furlong GI Ballerina Aug. 21, the goal is to stretch her out, according to Lohmeier, who was registering her first-ever win at the Spa.
