FASIG-TIPTON SARATOGA FINALE: KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES

The rest of the buyers knew he was serious when Kevin McKathan, acting as agent for Aaron and Marie Jones, opened the bidding at a cool \$2 million for a bay son of Mr. Prospector at last night's final session of the 1999 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Yearling Sales in Saratoga Springs, New York. When the gavel fell, Hip No. 186 belonged to the Joneses. The colt, consigned by Angus Glen Farm (1996) Limited, with Taylor Made Sales Agency as agent, was ultimately purchased for \$3 million. "He was just one of those horses you've got to put in the barn," McKathan said. "We just loved him. We think he is as good a horse as we have seen in a long time." As for his buying strategy, McKathan said, "We were hoping to flush everybody out with \$2 million as the opening bid. We thought he could have brought any number...but \$3 million was about on target with what we had in mind." Coolmore Stud was the underbidder, going to \$2.8 million before dropping out. The half-brother to stakes winner and graded stakes-placed Spire (Topsider) will stay at Taylor Made until October before going to McKathan Farm in Florida to be broken. Bob Baffert will train the colt. The Mr. Prospector was the only seven-figure yearling on the night, but the average at the three-day '99 Saratoga Summer Sales, \$261,456, still showed a 24.7 percent increase over 1998, setting a record for the venue. The previous record average of \$258,980 was set in 1985. The median over the three days of the auction. \$190,000, was up 18.75 percent from last year. "The market is good and we had a number of nice horses." Fasig-Tipton President Walt Robertson said. Added Chairman D. G. Van Clief, Jr., "Saratoga has always been and remains a magical place to sell a yearling. We are deeply indebted to the consignors who supply us our product and to the people who buy them." CORAL TO GO OFF SHORE: WILLIAM HILL NEXT

Coral vesterday became the highest-profile British bookmaking firm to announce that it is setting up an off-shore betting operation that will not be liable to British betting tax and levy. Victor Chandler and Stan James already have similar outlets in Gibraltar which were initially aimed at high-rolling punters but now attract smaller bettors because of their low deductions, three percent in the case of Victor Chandler compared to the general nine percent in Britain. "We just can't afford to sit back and do nothing," said Coral public relations manager Malcolm Palmer. "And it looks like our main competitors will be doing the same thing. We are looking at various sites and will move as soon as logistically possible." Coral is number three in the British market and the number two bookmaker William Hill is also set to go off-shore with telephone betting. "I would say it's inevitable that we will be doing it," said spokesman Graham Sharpe. "It's not something we want to do, but it looks like we will have to do it. We simply can't afford to be left behind and have our business. picked off." Ladbroke, the market leader, will make a statement at an Aug. 26 press conference.

RACEFORM BOUGHT BY RACING POST

Raceform, which had previously provided the only competition to the Racing Post as publishers of weekly racing papers and form books, was bought yesterday by the Post's parent company, the Mirror Group Plc. Raceform will continue to operate from its base in Berkshire, and the company's managing director James de Wesselow said, "The alliance will allow for increased resources in all our titles from our Compton base as well as giving us the umbrella of the *Racing Post* in terms of the logistics of printing, distribution and electronic media." Mirror Group has said that all the existing Raceform titles will continue to be published.
