YAGLI DEFEATED IN SWORD DANCER

Just two weeks after he stamped himself the top turf horse in the country with a decisive victory in the GI United Nations H. as the 1-10 favorite, Yagli (Jade Hunter) struggled home last under 125 pounds on a rain-softened turf course in Saratoga's GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. While the 3-5 favorite failed to fire, Honor Glide (Honor Grades), winner of the Gll Bowling Green H. in his last start July 10, earned his first GI win since a score in the GI Secretariat completed his sweep of the mid-America triple at three. Yagli was unhurried early and asked for run by jockey Jerry Bailey down the backstretch, but had nothing to give. Said Bailey, "He handled the turf reasonably well. He bobbled once going into the first turn. I was pretty happy going up the backside; I was ready to start creeping up on them, but he wasn't ready to do that. You've got to give them one bad race, then turn the page." Trainer Bill Mott would not second-guess his decision to run Yagli despite the `good' condition of the course. "We thought about (scratching), but not with the amount of rain we had," said Mott. "I thought the turf was fairly good." Winning trainer Christophe Clement was pleased with his horse's performance and preparation. "He's trained remarkably well here with two good works on the turf," said Clement. "I was pretty sure he would run very well today." The trainer said the five-year-old would either run back in the \$500,000 GI Man o'War Sept. 11 or the \$600,000 GI Turf Classic Oct. 9.

REGAL THUNDER BY A NOSE AT DEL MAR

Though sporting classic dirt breeding, Regal Thunder (Chief's Crown), purchased at the 1995 Keeneland September yearling sale for \$150,000, was sent to Great Britain to try his hand on the grass. Nine starts and zero wins later, the gelding was back in the states, where a win in yesterday's GII Pat O'Brien H. at Del Mar gave him his fifth win in 10 outings. The victory represented a major step up in class for the gelding, whose prior victories had come in allowance and optional claiming company. Second last out July 23 in a Del Mar allowance, he was sent away at 11-1 to earn his first stakes yesterday. Dropping back early, he was steered four wide on the turn and prevailed in a game stretch drive to get the bob for a nose victory. "He was a very nice horse from the beginning on dirt," said trainer Julio Canani. "He is bred for dirt. Good horses get beat a lot of times, but this horse is very honest and he's never (been) worse than third in this country. It looks like he's coming around at the right time." The 6-5 favorite, Christmas Boy (Well Decorated), winner of the GII Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. July 25 at Del Mar, turned for home with the lead, drifted slightly in the stretch, and just missed at the wire.

Having finished a fine fourth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 24, Silver Patriarch, the yardstick of consistency, displayed his battling qualities once more when outgunning Craigsteel to win in tremendous style. The combination of a 1 ½ kilogram weight advantage, an extra furlong and soft underfoot conditions gave Val Royal just enough advantage to reverse the form of the G3 Prix Daphnis at Chantilly July 27 with Alrassaam. The Mask, third in the Prix Daphnis, upheld the form further by once again finishing third. Port Bayou (Ghazi) broke well and set a good pace, but raced alone against the rail as the remainder raced in the center of the track in search of better ground. Alrassaam headed the main body, closely pursued by Val Royal, Commander Collins (Sadler's Wells) and The Mask. As the field entered the straight, Port Bayou's exertions were beginning to tell and he was headed by Alrassaam with 11/2 furlongs to run. Val Royal then gave chase to the new leader, who still led at the distance, but Val Royal was just about on terms. Two steel rods were inserted to realign his damaged spinal column one day after the horrifying spill. "He's a fighter," said agent Mike Szpuk. "If there's anybody who can come out of this strong, with a clear head, to live his life in good mental spirits and be an example for others, it's Rudy."
