#### **DUBAI MILLENNIUM WINS AT DEAUVILLE**

Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold), adding to Godolphin's already stellar season, left a high-class field in his wake with a pillar-to-post win in yesterday's G1 Prix du Haras De Fresnay-le-Buffard-Jacques Le Marois in Deauville, France. It was the 11th time this year a Godolphin colorbearer had come home first in a Group 1 race. Dubai Millennium suffered the first loss of his career when he finished ninth in the Vodafone Derby, but he quickly rebounded to take his first group race with an easy win in the July 18 G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte. The colt set a good pace and, as the field reached the quarter-mile marker, Dubai Millennium had his rivals off the bridle and, with minimum encouragment from Frankie Dettori, he ran on well all the way to the wire. "I was not worried about the ground as he likes it soft," said Dettori. "The distance was perfect, but 2000 meters will also be good for him. This horse is a champion. By the time we got to the two-furlong marker, everybody else was dead." Owner Sheikh Mohammed added, "This has been a very good season for us, we have many good horses. He is one of the best we have although he is still a baby. We have enough good horses for the Arc, so we will be aiming him for the Dubai World Cup (next March)."

#### TWO IN A ROW FOR UNGARO

German champion Ungaro (Ger) (Goofalik) earned his second Group 1 in a row with a well-measured half-length triumph over Wins Fiction (Ger) (Platini {Ger}) in yesterday's G1 E.L.E.Pokal-Grosser Erdaas-Preis in Germany. The five-year-old will now head to Australia where he will contest either the G1 Caulfield Cup over 1 1/2 miles at Caulfield Oct. 16 or the G1 W.S. Cox Plate over 1 1/4 miles at Moonee Valley Oct. 23. Coming off a win over the highly regarded three-year-old Sumitas (Ger) in the July 25 G1 WGZ Bank Deutschland-Preis at Düsseldorf, Ungaro went straight to the lead here, but was quickly joined by the fillies Win For Us (Ger) (Surumu {Ger}) and Flamingo Road (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) while Wins Fiction trailed several lengths behind. ROUND TABLE FOCUS ON TVG TVG was among the central topics of discussion yesterday at the 47th annual Jockey Club Round Table on Matters Pertaining to Racing, with key figures in the racing and television industries throwing their support behind the network. TV Guide President and COO Peter Boylan III was particularly enthusiastic about TVG, saying that he fully backs the network and the way it has been presenting racing. TVG has come under criticism for its offbeat approach to the sport and how it has attempted to attract new fans. Boylan said that testing conducted among potential and existing racing fans shows that TVG is a big hit. "Preliminary results are very encouraging," Boylan said. "Among all fans tested, 76 percent rated TVG's programming good or excellent overall. Sixty-one percent said it increased their interest in racing and 58 percent said it increased their desire to go to the racetrack. And these positive responses came from watching just a few minutes of TVG. So we believe we're on the right track." Boylan added that TVG can only help expose horse racing to the masses. "Horse racing is a diamond in the rough," he said. "Historically underexposed on television, horse racing can prosper like other sports leagues by increasing consumer demand through TVG." National Thoroughbred Racing Association Commissioner Tim Smith also pledged his full sport to TVG and also spoke about the momentum horse racing appears to be building. "Handle, purse levels and even on-track attendance in many markets are up," Smith said. "Public sales have been healthy and encouraging, reflecting not only the strong economy and stock market, but also a sense of renewed optimism about the industry's future potential, both internally within our sport and also in the eyes of the general public and mass media. Whatever the combination of reasons, it is clear that there are some very positive current trends for horse racing and the Thoroughbred industry, which obviously we all want to sustain and build on." Donald Dizney, a Jockey Club steward, and Jim Gallagher, the executive director of the NTRA's task force on racing integrity and drug testing, both spoke about racing's efforts to combat illegal drug use and to come up with uniform drug regulations. Gallagher said the NTRA is not interested in infringing on state racing commissions, but would like to see a set rule whereby no information concerning drug positives is made public until confirmed by a second referee lab.
