REAL QUIET INJURED

Real Quiet (Quiet American), coming off a victory in the \$1 million GI Hollywood Gold Cup, suffered a fractured splint bone in his right front leg and will be sidelined for at least three months. The four-year-old, prepping for the Aug. 29 GI Pacific Classic, worked seven furlongs in 1:23 2/5 at Santa Anita Sunday. "(The injury) probably happened in the work," trainer Bob Baffert said. "He was fine until then." The fracture will not require surgery, but could prove careerending if it does not heal perfectly. "We need 90 days to see how it heals up," owner Mike Pegram said. "The big thing would be to bring him back at the top of his game. If that can be done, he will definitely be back. If not, he's going to go to that good life we all wish we could have." Real Quiet, last year's champion three-year-old after winning the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness and missing the Triple Crown by a nose, is scheduled to stand stud at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky at the end of his racing career, but Pegram hopes that end is not imminent. "We are all hopeful he will come back," he said. "It's Bobby's decision, but we hope he will be able to run in the year 2000."

STRAVINSKY STAKES CLAIM ON SPRINT TITLE

Stravinsky (Nureyev), who put in a spectacular performance to win the G1 July Cup, has surely set the seal on this year's European sprint championship with his victory in yesterday's G1 Nunthorpe S. The colt's connections had attempted to make him into a 2000 Guineas horse, but after he finished off the board in a pair of seven-furlong starts, he was dropped back to six furlongs for the July Cup. That proved something of a master stroke as he fairly pulverized the opposition at Newmarket, and he proved much the best once again in this test, flying past pacesetter Sainte Marine (Ire) (Kenmare {Fr}) in the final furlong to win going away. Jockey Mick Kinane said, "I was about six or seven lengths down at halfway, but he picked them up in two strides. He is an exceptionally fast horse." Next stop is the Breeders' Cup Sprint at Gulfstream Park. The Nunthorpe was marred by a spill. Tipsy Creek (Dayjur), who stopped badly at the halfway point, hampered Rambling Bear (Sharrood), causing him to fall; his jockey, Ray Cochrane, was unhurt.

In something of a shock, with Rowaasi (Green Desert), Warrior Queen (Quiet American) and Journalist (Night Shift) all disappointing, Jemima came from the back of the pack with a determined run to overhaul Seraphina in the dying strides for a deserved win. Having disappointed in her debut when only sixth to Hammer And Sickle (Ire) and Connect (GB) at Ripon Apr. 15, Jemima then showed her true ability on her next four starts, winning twice with two seconds. She was settled at the rear as Rowaasi went to the lead from the outset. Asturian Lady (Zieten) raced close up in second, followed by Warrior Queen, Crimplene (Lion Cavern), Tabheej and Journalist. Seraphina and Red Letter (Sri Pekan) kept company with Jemima at the back. As the field passed the guarter-mile marker, the expected battle between Rowaasi, Warrior Queen and Journalist didn't develop and the unconsidered 66-1 shot Seraphina, who had obviously not read the script, swept into the lead. Jemima, racing wider, came under pressure, but responded to Lindsay Charnock's questions with positive answers. The two drew away from the others in the final furlong, but it was only with 25 yards to go that Jemima got her nose in front. Seraphina proved game in second and was clear of Tabheej in third, who proved best in the battle for the minor

LYCIUS TO STAND IN FLORIDA Lycius (Mr. Prospector--Lypatia {Fr}, by Lyphard) will stand the 2000 breeding season at Mr. and Mrs. Robert Slack's Stoneriggs Farm in Ocala, Florida. The nine-year-old stallion was purchased by the Slacks and B. E. Stables. A Group 1 winner in England and second in the 1991 English 2000 Guineas, Lycius has already sired six graded-stakes winners. Among his progeny are Hello (Ire), winner of the 1996 G1 Gran Criterium and GIII Generous S.; Ivan Luis (Fr), a group winner in Italy this year; and Media Nox (GB), winner of the 1997 GII Buena Vista H. Previously at Sheikh Mohammed's Kildangan Stud in Ireland, Lycius will stand in Florida for a stud fee of \$10,000 live foal.

The Lucien Barriere Group, a French luxury hotel, restaurant and casino group, will back the Arc for four years beginning with this year's running Oct. 3. The prize money for the first running of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp will rise 25 percent to FF8.75 million (£900,000), In 2000, prize money will rise to FF10.5 million (£1.080 million), which would be more than the current level of the Vodafone Derby, which this year came to £1.065 million. France Galop president Jean-Luc Lagardere said, "Since its creation, the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe has been an outstanding test of performance. The Lucien Barriere Group's confidence and its commitment to this event represents an exciting new page in its history. France Galop is delighted to associate such a prestigious name with this exceptional race." The race has been without a sponsor for the last two years, and the new arrangements will enable the race to enter the Emirates World Series Racing Championship next year.
