DEAUVILLE AUGUST YEARLING PREVIEW

The six-day Deauville August Yearling sale, now firmly established as one of the world's best, begins Saturday evening. The auction has produced Group winners in Europe, North America and Japan. Three Arc winners have come out of Deauville in the last 10 vears--Urban Sea, Subotica (Fr) and Helissio (Fr) (bought as a foal at the December sale). The demand for well-bred and well-conformed yearlings is stronger than ever, as was shown at the recent Keeneland and Saratoga sales. The Deauville catalogue offers 565 yearlings and it is regarded the best ever, even if it doesn't contain such a choice filly as the yearling by Lammtarra out of Urban Sea that attracted a record FF10 million bid last year from Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid al Maktoum. Most of the leading stallions from around the world will be represented in the sale, and the percentage of mares who are stakes performers or stakes producers is higher than ever. The opening session features several well-bred fillies, including a fullsister to MGSW Golden Arches (Fr) (Common Grounds {GB}--Echoes of Eternity, by *Cougar 2nd) and a halfsister to Group 1 winner Seattle Rhyme (Seattle Dancer--Golden Rhyme {Ire}, by Dom Racine {Fr}) by Red Ransom, as well as a Woodman colt out of Group 1 winner Lemon Souffle (GB) (Salse).

TREMPOLINO TO FRANCE

Trempolino (Sharpen Up {GB}--Trephine {Fr}, by Viceregal), French champion three-year-old in 1987, will be relocated from Gainesway in Kentucky to stand the 2000 breeding season at Haras du Mezeray in France. Haras du Mezeray bred the 15-year-old stallion, raced him in France and hold several shares in the syndicate. Trempolino won the '87 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and ran second in that year's Breeders' Cup Turf. He has sired 29 stakes winners, including graded winners Dernier Empereur, Talloires, Juvenia and Arkadian Hero. "Trempolino's progeny have been most successful in Europe and demand for him will be very strong when he is relocated and exposed to the European market," said Michael Hernon of Gainesway. Trempolino stood at Gainesway in 1999 for a fee of \$15,000 live foal. He will stand at Haras du Mezeray for a fee of FF80,000 (\$12,500), Oct. 1 terms for the 2000 season.

"BULLET" TAKES AIM AT ALABAMA

Nearly unbeatable when competing against her own sex, Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) rebounded from a seventh-place finish against the colts in the Belmont S. in June to capture the GII Monmouth Breeders' Cup Oaks in her last start July 10. She will try to make it two in a row, and a perfect six-for-six against fillies this year, in today's GI Alabama S. going a mile and a quarter. The champion had her eight-race win streak snapped by her loss in the 1 1/2-mile Belmont and she has never won beyond 1 1/8 miles. On A Soapbox (Mi Cielo) ran third behind Silverbulletday in the Feb. 20 GIII Davona Dale S. Injured in that effort, she returned to win a June 25 Churchill allowance before a dominant 4 1/4-length triumph in the July 24 GI Coaching Club American Oaks. Brushed Halory (Broad Brush) was also beaten by Silverbulletday this past winter in New Orleans. The filly ran second in the Davona Dale and third in the Mar. 13 GIII Fair Grounds Oaks, both at 1 1/16 miles. After a three-month freshening, she returned to capture the July 24 GIII Delaware Oaks in her last start.

Being the only maiden in the field, Best Of The Bests conjured a shock result when coming with a welltimed run to win in comprehensive fashion. The David Loder-trained 5-4 favorite Consonant (Barathea {Ire}) disputed the running with II Capitano (Be My Chief) as Sarafan stalked the leaders in third, followed by Autonomy (Doyoun {Ire}) and Best Of The Bests. Fairy Gem (Fairy King) and Kingsclere were ridden patiently at the rear. As the field moved to the quarter-mile marker, Consonant and II Capitano faded tamely and Sarafan took up the running. No sooner had he taken over than Best Of The Bests made a challenge on the outside, producing a telling turn of foot in the last half furlong to win going away. Kingsclere finished to great effect and would have stolen second in a few extra strides. Winning trainer Clive Brittain said, "I think he is a Group 1 horse in the making. He was still a little green and lazy in front, but it was only his second race."

Aussie Trainers Banned:

Australian trainer Darren Smith has been suspended for two years for administering 15 of his horses with banned steroid implants, despite pleading to Thoroughbred Racing Board stewards that a lengthy ban would mean financial ruin. Smith, who has up to 80 horses in training, was charged with having administered trenbolon, a steroid registered only for use in domestic beef cattle, to Intrepity (Aus), unplaced at Cessnock July 13. Smith has lodged an appeal, seeking a stay of proceedings to allow him to continue training pending a review of the case. In addition, trainer John Curan was suspended for a year, his owner Geoff Lynam for three months and trenbolone supplier John Carroll for two years. Chief Steward Ray Murrihy said it was likely that trainers Anthony Cummings and Paul Englebrecht would be called next week to answer questions about their involvement in the trenbolone scandal, which surfaced when the Australian Forensic Racing Laboratory perfected a test for the substance in mid-June and a Cummings horse tested positive.


MALEK PREPS FOR PACIFIC CLASSIC Malek

(Chi) (Mocito Guapo {Arg}), getting ready for the Aug. 29 GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar, worked six furlongs in a rapid 1:10 4/5 at the seaside track yesterday morning. Trainer Richard Mandella termed it "the best work I've ever seen him do. He did it with a lot of enthusiasm, which isn't like him in the morning." The Chilean champ, winner of last year's GI Santa Anita H., was second in his first three starts this year, including the G1 Dubai World Cup, then came back to be third in the June 27 GI Hollywood Gold Cup. Last time out, he captured the July 29 Viking Spirit H. at Del Mar. "I have no doubt that the win in the Viking Spirit did him a lot of good," Mandella said. "I don't think he has ever come into a race better than this."

PARADE GROUND RETIRED The *Blood-Horse* online reports that MGSW **Parade Ground** (Kingmambo--Battle Creek Girl, by His Majesty) has been retired due to complications from an infected hock. "He developed an infection in his (left) hock and it worked its way up and damaged his suspensory," owner William S. Farish told *Blood-Horse*. "Dr. (Larry) Bramlage did some ultrasound tests and examined him. He could return to racing, but it is doubtful that he would be as effective." The four-year-old captured four graded stakes on the turf, including the '98 GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S., as well as the Tampa Bay Derby on the dirt. He retires with a record of 21-7-6-4 and a bankroll of \$794,995. Stud plans have not yet been finalized.

TAMPA BAY STAKES WORTH \$1 MILLION Tampa Bay Downs has unveiled an expanded 1999-2000 stakes program worth over \$1 million. The showcase event of the season is the Mar. 19 runnings of the \$125,000 GIII Florida Oaks and the \$150,000 Tampa Bay Derby. 

Child Dies After Laurel Fall:

A 16-month-old boy died yesterday after falling from a window in the Laurel press box. The child and his mother were alone in a separate room in the press box when the accident occurred around 3 p.m. Thursday, just prior to the running of the fifth race. The races were delayed until the victim was taken by medivac helicopter to Johns Hopkins University Hospital. The Anne Arundel County Police are investigating the accident. "Our thoughts and prayers remain with the family," said Karin De Francis, co-owner of the Maryland Jockey Club.

Monmouth Raises Stakes Purses:

Monmouth Park has raised the purses for the final eight stakes races of the meet by a total of \$80,000. Bob Kulina, vice president of Monmouth Park, said, "The daily purse increase instituted at the start of the meeting has encouraged bigger fields and more wagering and that allows us to give more back to the horsemen." The Omnibus S. and Personal Ensign S., both run Aug. 28, and the Sept. 5 Miss Woodford S. are now worth \$70,000. The Aug. 29 Choice S. and the Sept. 4 Bob Harding S. have been increased to \$60,000. The Aug. 29 Junior Champion, Sept. 4 Continental Mile and Sept. 5 Spruce Fir will now be worth \$50,000.

Florida's Pari-Mutuel Director Resigns:

For nearly five years Debbie Miller, director of Florida's Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, ruled over racing in the state. Her controversial reign came to an end on Wednesday. "Debbie decided this was a good time to turn in her resignation and move in another direction," said her boss Cynthia Henderson, secretary of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. Miller's most recent action was to suspend trainers Mark Hennig, Todd Pletcher and David Donk for trace levels of cocaine found in horses they ran a Gulfstream and Hialeah. The three went to Federal Court in New York and got an injunction against the suspension which has allowed them to continue training. Miller's replacement has not yet been named; Deputy Director to the Secretary Charlie Crist will take over until a new director can be hired.

Agent Anthony Stroud, formerly Sheikh Mohammed's racing manager, brokered the sale, and the three-yearold will be aimed at the 2000 Hong Kong Derby rather than a trip to the States. Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's managing director Harry Herbert said, "We had been looking to aim Housemaster at the [GI] Man o' War [Sept. 11 at Belmont Park] as well as a prep race at Saratoga, but we were offered a substantial amount of money which was too much for the 20 syndicate members to turn down. I imagine the horse will be gelded because he doesn't have a stallion's pedigree and I'm sure that on the firm ground he will encounter he will do very well for his new owners in Hong Kong." Housemaster was bought as a yearling for 72,000 guineas by agent John Warren, who buys all the Highclere horses.
