DEAUVILLE YEARLING SALE OFF TO STRONG START

The opening session of the six-day 1999 Deauville Yearling Sale went strongly as 81 percent of the 73 yearlings on offer were sold with an aggregate of FF55.83 million, compared with FF54.08 million last year. English agent Peter Doyle signed the slip for the top lot of the day, going to FF4.4 million for Hip 43, a Woodman filly out of G1 winner Lemon Souffle (GB) (Salse). Like her dam, the filly will be trained in England by Richard Hannon. He also took the second highest-priced filly, a half-sister by Salse to Group winner Ronda (GB) (Bluebird), for FF1.7 million. Michael Goodbody, acting for the Gainsborough Stud of Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid al Maktoum, bought six yearlings, including Hip 23, the top colt of the evening at FF4.2 million, a Danehill half-brother to G2 winner Majorien (GB) (Machiavellian). Philippe Augier, managing director of the Agence Française, was pleased but cautious. "The sale was strong, the market was active but very selective," he said. "There were 23 yearlings who made a million francs or more, compared with 15 in the same session last year, and they were bought by 14 different buyers, which shows there was a broad international demand. It's too early to draw conclusions as the first two days are sometimes quite different. We will know more tomorrow." The sale continues today at 6 p.m. (Top Five Colts/Fillies p2)

SWEET HOME ALABAMA

The skies were gray and a steady rain was falling, but nothing was going to stop Silverbulletday from winning for the 13th time in 15 starts and maintaining her dominance over her division. After conquering the Bluegrass with convincing wins in the GI Ashland and GI Kentucky Oaks, the 1998 champion two-year-old filly took the GI Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico, a race which propelled her into the Belmont, where she tired to be seventh. The bay came into this effort on the heels of a five-length success in the GI Monmouth Breeders' Cup Oaks July 10, but despite the ease with which she does things, the main question to be answered would be her ability to get the mile and a quarter. Silverbulletday bounded out of the gate and settled in fifth behind the deliberate pace established by Strolling Belle. Leaving the far turn, jockey Jerry Bailey sent his mount after Strolling Belle, collared that rival just inside the quarter pole and left the field in her wake, coasting home under a hand ride. Echoing the sentiment of the 27,043 in attendance, Bailey said, "Awesome. She was a little wide today and had to run down a soft pace. She surprised even me today, she's that good." Owner Mike Pegram indicated that Silverbulletday could next appear in the GI Spinster at Keeneland Oct. 16. "We're going to have to hook Banshee Breeze sooner or later," he said.

Flashback to Aug. 12, 1989, a rainy afternoon on the Jersey Shore when Carson City, a 9-2 shot, splashed his way to a 7 1/4-length victory in what was then the Gil Sapling. Fast forward one decade, and, it is, as Yogi says, *deja vu* all over again. Dont Tell The Kids broke his maiden at first asking over the local strip July 31, speeding through an opening quarter in :21 1/5 and never looking back en route to a 3 3/4-length success. Fifty-one year old jockey Jorge Tejeira broke his mount on top, but was kept from getting to the rail as Tyro S. winner Outrigger applied pressure from the rail. Splashing out of the turn, Dont Tell The Kids began to inch away from the Lukas trainee, but that one was not quite finished, as he tried to sneak through on the wood. Don't Tell The Kids lugged in briefly in the final eighth, brushing slightly with Outrigger, but was able to hold him off for the victory, surviving a stewards inquiry into the events of the final eighth and awarding his jockey his first graded stakes victory in 15 years. Said winning trainer Bob Durso, "I told Jorge (Tejeira) if he came out running the he could go 3/16ths head and head, but after that to go on with him. Having the outside post was great. He didn't have to run hard to get position and that helped him finish better." The winner could go next in the GI Futurity at Belmont Sept. 19 and/or the GI Champagne Oct. 9, but will not be pointed for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, according to Durso.

Enjoy The Moment accounted for her first graded stakes tally with a powerful, front-running three-length victory in the Feb. 23 Gill Las Flores H. at Santa Anita and sandwiched a 1/2-length success in the restricted Valiant Pete H. between a couple of forgettable efforts in New Orleans and New York. Most recently, Enjoy The Moment returned to the win column with yet another wire-to-wire effort in the GII A Gleam H. at Hollywood June 27. Sporting a three-for-three record in first races off a layoff, the Bill Spawr trainee broke alertly from her outside post and set sizzling fractions of :21 3/5 and :44 for the half mile, at which point she was 2 1/2 lengths clear. Racing off the rail, the four year old waltzed past the eighth pole with a three-length advantage and was ridden out the balance. Jockey David Flores was awestruck. "Whew, she's something. She was just cruising. I never moved on her." The winning conditioner said that Enjoy The Moment would be given a couple of weeks off, with the possible long-term goal being the Breeders' Cup Sprint. "She's not eligible, so she'd have to be supplemented. If we don't go to the Breeders' Cup, our goal would be the Safely Kept the next day (Nov. 7)," said Spawr.

Second in the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly June 13, Star Of Akkar went on to win the G3 Prix Chloe at the same course July 16. She was always racing up with the pace here and showed tenacious battling qualities to first get to the lead and then hold on well as Sage et Jolie made a late lunge for victory. The British trained challenger Balladonia (Primo Dominie {GB}) towed the field along from Star Of Akkar, the German-trained Catella (Generous {Ire}) and Mother Of Pearl while the Andre Fabre-trained pair of Sage et Jolie and Visionnaire (Linamix {Fr}) raced together in the rear. Mother Of Pearl challenged for the lead at the entrance to the straight and led soon after as Star Of Akkar was ridden at the quarter-mile marker and went in pursuit of the new leader. She finally got on terms with 150 yards to run, grabbed the lead with 50 yards to go and under a strong drive from Thierry Gillet, Star Of Akkar was all out to hold the late surge of Sage et Jolie and Mother Of Pearl in an exciting finish. Gillet said, "We went fast today and she was a little fresh, being slightly keen. In these conditions, 2000 meters is her limit and she will be even better over a shorter trip."

The first French Group 1 race of the season for juveniles sees three locally trained horses facing four foreign raiders. **Fasliyev** (Nureyev) is already a Group 1 winner, having scored in the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 8, despite veering sharply left in the closing stages. He has undoubted ability, but that quirk shown in his last race would be cause for concern. **City On A Hill** (Rahy) has done nothing wrong, and like Fasliyev, takes an unbeaten record into the race. He was most impressive on his latest start when accounting for Mull Of Kintyre, winner of the G2 Gimcrack S. at York this week, in the G3 July S. at Newmarket July 7. He has had an easy time of it to date and this will be his first serious test. **Warm Heart** (Diesis {GB}) won the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 17 on unsuitably fast ground and will certainly appreciate the likely easier going. **Bachir** (Desert Style {Ire}), stablemate of Warm Heart, was impressive when winning the G2 Richmond S. July 28, and has at least place claims on the bare form alone. He is unbeaten after two starts, but on both occasions has entered the stalls with the aid of a Monty Roberts blanket. He may be of a nervous disposition and has also had to contend with a lengthy journey from England. **Harbour Island** (Selkirk) can be expected to confirm the form of the G3 Prix de Cabourg over course and distance, July 31, with runner up **Mount Abu** (Foxhound).

Excellent Meeting (General Meeting), a warrior of this year's Triple Crown series, in which she finished a troubled fifth in the Kentucky Derby, returned from a displaced palate in the Preakness to win the GII Princess at Hollywood before being upset by **Smooth Player** (Bertrando) in the GI Hollywood Oaks last out. She makes her first visit to the infield today, but is the class of the field and her turf drills suggest she will take to the lawn. **Mumtaz** (Kaldoun {Fr}) is two for two in the U.S., parlaying victory in a Churchill allowance into an easy five-length score in the Walmac Lone Star Oaks July 4. She was 12 lengths last after a quarter, but made a huge middle move to win going away and looms a serious threat. **Sweet Ludy** (Be My Guest) tallied her first American win in the GII Honeymoon H. two back and followed that with a two-length success in the July 31 GII San Clemente H. over the local green.

Furlough (Easy Goer) was a rallying winner of the seven-furlong GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 13 at Aqueduct in her second race off a layoff. The bay was fifth in the GI Hempstead H. June 19 before returning from that effort with a solid late run to be fourth in the six-furlong GIII Honorable Miss H. Aug. 4. The expected fast pace and extra furlong should set up her late run once again. **Catinca** (Storm Cat) won three consecutive graded stakes events last fall, including the GII First Flight H. at today's trip. The topweight has been equally impressive this season, with wins in the one mile GII Bed O' Roses Breeders' Cup H. and GII Shuvee, but found the 8 1/2 furlongs of the Hempstead a little too much when third last out. **Countess Diana** (Deerhound), champion two-year-old filly of 1997, scored her first victory since that year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile with a 5 3/4-length victory in an allowance heat Aug. 8 in the slop and looks to continue her winning ways.

Kayf Tara (Sadler's Wells), fourth in this race last year, can confidently be expected to make amends here. He has been in outstanding form this season and was very impressive when streaking to success in the G2 Goodwood Cup July 29. Godolphin are in the middle of a purple patch with their group race runners and he can add another to the impressive 1999 portfolio. **Invermark** (Machiavellian) was second in the Ascot Gold Cup at Royal Ascot June 17, when Kayf Tara was third. He will give the favorite the most to do, but will find the task that much harder than at Ascot given this race is over a five-furlong shorter trip. **Largesse** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) is a good handicapper who has performed well in group company. He will endeavor to give Britain a 1-2-3 finish, and, on his latest start, was a fine second in the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York May 13. **Mayshiel** (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}) is the only home-trained runner and will find it hard to trouble the foreign challengers. **Alpha Blues** (Acatenango {Ger}), the German-trained raider, was a fine winner of the Listed Prix Louis Desboudet at Vichy July 23, but will find this will take a lot more to win.

With a maiden win at Frankfurt July 18 on her only start, Mona Em justified trainer Hans Blume's decision to send her abroad for a stakes race by flashing home late to win in excellent style. Travesty Of Law (Case Law {Ire}) set a searching pace from Legend Of Spring (Night Shift {USA}) and Iyavaya (Valiant Nature {USA}), as Rosalita, Mona Em, who was ridden throughout, and Walnut Lady raced in the rear. Legend Of Spring took the lead at halfway and led until the final furlong, as Rosalita quickened to lead from Walnut Lady with a half-furlong to run. The pair looked to have the race between them, but Mona Em, who was four lengths down with a furlong to run, produced a telling burst to take over inside the last 50 yards to win going away. Blume, said, "I am surprised that she won. I had heard beforehand there were very good horses in the race so I thought it would be good if she was placed. Maybe she will run in France again, I don't know at the moment, but her next race will be a Group 3 over five furlongs." The G3 Prix d'Arenberg at Chantilly Sept. 8 at 5 1/2 furlongs certainly fulfils her trainer's criteria.
