#### **DEAUVILLE: DAY 2**

The second session of the Deauville Yearling Sale, held yesterday, continued the strong showing of the first, with 15 horses selling for FF1 million or more. That brings the total of seven-figure yearlings to 38 for the sale, one more than the record set in 1985. The Haras du Mezeray consigned the top two lots at the session. Hip No. 95, a colt by Sadler's Wells out of the group winner Savoureuse Lady (GB) (Caerleon), brought a final bid of FF6 million from Demi O'Byrne; the dam is a half-sister to MG1SW and Arc runner-up Mtoto (GB). Hip No. 113, a filly by Kingmambo out of Tippecanoe (Ire) (Dancing Brave), was sold for FF4.5 million to John Ferguson Bloodstock; her dam is a half-sister to MGISW Sabin (Lyphard). "We are obviously delighted at such a result, with the gross up 23 percent and the average up 3 percent," Philippe Augier, managing director of the Agence Francaise, said. "Many new investors, mostly Europeans, have invested tonight and the French buyers have been also guite active. We are also very happy that many French stud farms have benefitted from such a good sale. French breeders get the reward of their investments."

#### FASLIYEV FAST AND TRUE IN PRIX MORNY

Fasliyev (Nureyev) earned his first group victory when taking the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 15 and progressed to win his first Group 1 in the Heinz 57 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 8, but in doing so displayed an alarming tendency to hang to his left. All precautions were taken to stop that habit here. The two-year-old was fitted with a cross-noseband to give Michael Kinane greater control, but the jockey needn't have had any worries as he guided the colt to a highly impressive success, maintaining a straight course throughout and retaining his unbeaten record. Harbour Island (Fr) (Selkirk) led, with Fasliyev and Warm Heart (Diesis {GB}) both close up. The pacesetter took them to the quarter-mile marker, but was challenged and passed by Fasliyev with 11/2 furlongs to run. The winner took off a furlong out; the acceleration was instant and awesome and the race was settled at that point. Trainer Aidan O'Brien said, "He looks a lovely horse and I think he will improve more. He won in great style. We used his last race as preparation for this and he was fitter today than he was last time. I'm not sure what his next race will be."

Furlough was the last-to-first winner of the 1998 GIII Honorable Miss H., but broke through the gate before last year's GI Ballerina and was a non-threatening fourth. The bay posted another come-from-the-clouds victory, this time in the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. at Aqueduct Mar. 13 in her second start of 1999. Freshened off a fifth-place result in the GI Hempstead June 19, she made another nice late run in this year's edition of the Honorable Miss Aug. 4, but could finish only fourth behind Bourbon Belle. There were no problems at the gate this year as jockey Mike Smith guided the Phipps colorbearer to the rear of the field while Bourbon Belle established the lead down the backside. Into the stretch, Bourbon Belle was still clear and looked the winner, but Furlough commenced a powerful rally from last, switched outside at the eighth pole and was up in the final jump. Said Smith, "She comes from so far back, it was nice to get away good (at the start). She settled down in the back of the pack, then she got on that long lope and that's a good sign. Once we got some daylight, I asked her to run and we got up there just in time." Winning trainer Shug McGaughey indicated that the GI Ruffian at Belmont Park Sept. 18 could mark the next start for Furlough.

Second to Excellent Meeting (General Meeting) in the GI Las Virgenes and GI Santa Anita Oaks on the main track over the winter, Tout Charmant tried turf for the first time May 23 and finished second by a head to Sweet Ludy in the GII Honeymoon H. Fifth, again behind Excellent Meeting, in the GII Princess S. on the dirt June 20, the bay returned to the turf for her latest and came away with a win in the restricted Sandy Blue S. over this course Aug. 2. Overlooked despite the solid grass record as Excellent Meeting was sent off the 2-1 favorite in her turf debut, Tout Charmant shadowed Smooth Player under a stout hold through moderate fractions, came wide into the stretch to take the lead and held on. "She has been improving, getting better and better and better, and it was her turn," trainer Bob Baffert, who also conditions the favorite, said. "She was in the bridle," added jockey David Flores. "I didn't want to turn her loose too early. I really asked her at the guarter pole and she went to the front. But she was kind of pricking her ears and not knowing what to do. She was running kind of funny, but she was running." The runner-up had to steady when the winner went by, but ran on gamely to be second. Sweet Ludy was also blocked as they raced into the lane, but finished well once clear to be third. Excellent Meeting was in traffic early while at the back of the pack, came with a mild bid on the far turn, but had nothing for the drive and beat only one home. "She seemed to handle (the grass) OK," said her jockey, Chris McCarron. "On the backside I took her outside and she picked it up. She made a nice run, but she couldn't sustain it."

A most impressive winner of the G2 Goodwood Cup at Goodwood July 29, Kayf Tara moved another step closer to being named Europe's champion stayer, en route to a possible tilt at the G1 Fosters Melbourne Cup in Australia Nov. 2, when landing the odds in comfortable style. Fourth in this race last year, Kayf Tara went into the lead soon after the start when Frankie Dettori noticed there was a lack of early pace. The front runner showed no signs of faltering as Invermark came to challenge with two furlongs to run--Dettori shook the reins at Kayf Tara and he lengthened clear in fine style. Invermark kept on nicely, over a trip short of his optimum, and safely held second. Dettori said, "His favorite going is soft so I was not worried about the ground. The horse is better than he was last year and we were very confident going into the race." Simon Crisford, Godolphin's racing manager, added, "He is very strong this year; he has improved. The ground was a bit too fast for him in the Ascot Gold Cup and the distance was also a bit too far for him even though he won it the year before. This distance and this going are pefect for him and he is just a tough, honest, genuine, good, top quality horse. We will look at the [G1] Irish St Leger [Sept. 18] and then hopefully he can go for the Melbourne Cup. We are very much hoping the Australian handicapper will give him a reasonable weight to give us the encouragement to go there."

Budrovale, claimed for \$50,000 in February of 1998, went over the \$1 million mark in earnings since the claim with this victory. The eight-length winner of the GII Mervyn Leroy H. May 1, he was a well-beaten second in the May 29 GII Californian, but came back to take the Super Diamond H. against fellow Cal-breds June 13. He missed by a half-length behind Real Quiet in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup two starts back, then faded badly in the GIII San Diego H. last out Aug. 7 and finished fourth, 18 lengths behind the winner. Rebounding as the second choice here, the bay stalked pacesetter Kid Katabatic through six furlongs in 1:10, drove to the front on the far turn and outgamed Mike K to the wire to take a narrow decision. "This was the No. 1 goal, more than the Dubai Cup, the Breeders' Cup Classic and the Kentucky Derby," trainer Ted West insisted. "This is the race (owner Jeff Sengara) wanted to win more than anything." He added, "He really is getting better with age. He is better at this moment than he has ever been in his entire life." Classic Cat (Mountain Cat), the 4-5 favorite, hadn't been out since posting back-to-back wins in the Mar. 12 Tokyo City H. and the Apr. 11 GII San Bernardino H., both at Santa Anita. The chestnut was never in the hunt here and trailed in more than seven lengths behind the next-to-last horse. "Real early on in there he told me that he didn't want to run," his jockey, Russell Baze, said. "He was done after fiveeighths of a mile. He just let the bit drop and he didn't want to go on. I think he probably didn't handle the track real well."

#### Sunline Stars Again; Runner-up Berated:

New Zealand "Horse of the Year" Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) brought her record to 12 wins from 14 starts with her victory in Saturday's A\$150,000 Warwick S. at Warwick Farm. Racegoers witnessed a Cox Plate trial, with half of the field likely to clash in the weight-for-age championship at Moonee Valley Oct. 23. Sunline held off seven-time Group 1 winner Tie The Knot (Aus) (Nassipour) after controlling the race throughout. But the Warwick S. aftermath proved sensational as the stewards took jockey Shane Dye to task during an extremely heated inquiry over his riding tactics on Tie The Knot. The stewards said they had "grave concerns" with a ride that "lacked vigor and purpose." Dye elected to stay on the inside behind 125-1 Zoregal (Aus) (Zoffany) rather than switching to the outside and making a run. "So you sit for another 100 meters, doing nothing, feet high in the irons," said Murrihy. "If you were out and gone, wouldn't you have won the race?" Tie The Knot made up about five lengths in the final 100 meters. An agitated Dye snapped back, "I'm happy with my ride. You're not, you do something about it!" Dye usually drops out a distant last on Tie The Knot and sprints home late, but stewards maintained he should have made his run earlier and disputed his view that Sunline had his measure. Tie The Knot's trainer Guy Walter said he was "surprised Dye was so far back."

Britain's 59 racecourses are set to sell Internet rights for British racing, but any link-up with the Internet side of Arena Leisure, which owns five courses, is likely to be non-exclusive. Racecourse Association racing director Morag Grav said, "It is true we are looking to form relationships with companies interested in betting on the Internet with a view to providing pictures for web sites, but we are not planning to become directly involved in betting." Arena Leisure's chief executive Graham Parr said, "I will be meeting Angus Crichton-Miller [the RCA chairman] on Tuesday with a view to pulling all this together. It is the main reason I got involved with Arena Leisure and I think the racecourses have got to come on-board. Remember, Arena owns five racecourses and 18 percent of the fixtures." Parr hopes to have the site up and running by April next year and is in talks with two overseas betting organizations, one each in America and Australia.
