“KID” GETS DROP ON TRAVERS FOES

Think back to the final leg of this year's Triple Crown. Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), coming off a third-place finish over a muddy track in the GII Peter Pan S., sits eighth as Silverbulletday and Charismatic battle it out on the front end, then swings wide at the quarter pole to take the lead. Vision and Verse (Storm Cat), who was never far from the front, comes at him from the rail, but the three-year-old refuses to lose, winning the GI Belmont S. by a head. The GI Travers S., run yesterday afternoon at Saratoga, was a virtual replay of that race. The Belmont winner, second over a sloppy Saratoga strip in the GII Jim Dandy S. last time out, was a little bit closer to the pace this time. Third as Cat Thief (Storm Cat) and Vision and Verse dueled through six furlongs in 1:12.50, the bay was three wide as they straightened into the stretch, joined the Belmont runner-up at the furlong pole and once again proved gamest, this time edging off to a three-quarter length victory. It was another 1 3/4 lengths back to 8-5 favorite Menifee (Harlan), who was a little rank while rating early, loomed at the top of the stretch, but couldn't get past the top two. "(Trainer Scotty Schulhofer) told me he brought this horse in at 110 percent and he was right," winning jockey Jose Santos said. "I was in a perfect position the whole race. Every time I asked him to run, he was right there. This horse shows he's really got guts." Looking ahead to a possible Eclipse Award, Schulhofer said, "He's got a lot to do yet. He has a good chance, but he'll have to beat Behrens and some of those other older horses." The colt will make his next start against older horses in the GI Woodward S. at Belmont Park Sept. 18. Jockey Pat Day, aboard the favorite, said, "The pace and the trip hurt me significantly. We got shuffled back and...we got locked in behind a trotting-horse pace. They just don't back up with those kind of fractions." Cat Thief tired badly to be seventh and jockey Mike Smith said, "He was making a lot of noise out there. He has trouble breathing...he seemed to have displaced his palate." Attendance at Saratoga was 51,371, a record for the Travers. The total handle for Travers Day was an all-time Saratoga record of \$27,154,229.54, surpassing the mark of \$24,371,931 set on the 1998 Travers card. (Travers chart, p2)

CLASSIC FIELD AT MERCY OF MALEK?

It looks like today's \$1 million GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar is his to lose. Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo {Arg}) is by far the most accomplished runner in a field which was diminished when Victory Gallop and Mazel Trick suffered career-ending injuries and Real Quiet came up with a fractured splint which could send him to the breeding shed as well. Malek has never been off the board in eight U.S. starts, posting his most important victory in the 1998 GI Santa Anita H. at the Pacific Classic distance of 1 1/4 miles. Always there or thereabouts at the finish, he was within a length of the winner in three straight, including a second in this year's G1 Dubai World Cup and a third after setting the pace in the June 27 GI Hollywood Gold Cup, before getting a confidence booster with his half-length win over Smile Again (Wild Again) in the 1 1/16-mile Viking Spirit H. July 29. His toughest competition is likely to come from stablemate Lazy Lode (Arg) (Lode), who switches to the main track for the first time since finishing fourth in this event last year. He didn't appear to handle the track in the '98 Pacific Classic, but looked very comfortable when he worked five furlongs in a bullet :57 4/5 over the strip Aug. 23.

Forestry, winner of the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont July 11, was a hard-fought third in the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Aug. 8. In that effort, the bay carried the lead through swift fractions for a mile, then was caught in the final furlong, but gamely hung on for the show. Turning back in distance for this event, the \$1,500,000 yearling purchase was hustled early, sitting second through a hot opening half mile in :43 2/5, joined front-running Five Star Day for the lead around the turn, battled that one gamely through the stretch and prevailed to draw clear at the wire. The final time of 1:21 was two-fifths of a second off the track record set by Salt Lake in 1992. Winning jockey Chris Antley commented, "Five Star Day was going pretty fast up front, but Forestry was actually pulling me into the fractions. He finished up real strong in the stretch, and any horse that is going to try to out-kick him to the wire is in trouble." Trainer Bob Baffert added, "The way he ran today, I might point him to the Breeders' Cup Sprint (Nov. 6, Gulfstream Park)." Classy sprinter Yes It's True (Is It True) faded badly to finish last of all. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "We're going to go over him and scope him to see if he is okay."

World traveler **Running Stag** (Cozzene) returns to America, where he was last seen crushing six rivals in the GII Brooklyn H. at Belmont June 12. He shipped home for the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. July 3, but was unable to handle some of Europe's best, running fifth. At the same distance, but back on the dirt here, the five-year-old is spotting the field seven to nine pounds and may be vulnerable. **Nite Dreamer** (El Prado {Ire}) is a bit of an enigma. He was second to Victory Gallop in the GII Stephen Foster H. June 12 at Churchill, an easy winner in the GIII Cornhusker H. at Prairie Meadows July 5, but was 16½ lengths behind Victory Gallop in his last start, the GI Whitney H. at this track Aug. 1.

Public Purse was not disgraced when sixth to El Condor Pasa in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud July 4 and had previously won the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay at Saint-Cloud May 24. **Bimbola** was a good winner of the G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville Aug. 1 and, with **Public Purse**, forms the backbone of the home defense which has the necessary ability to withstand the three-pronged British challenge. **Sadian** was badly hampered when third to Silver Patriarch (Ire) in the G2 Geoffrey Freer S. at Newbury Aug. 14. He is a dual group winner already this season, having captured the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 17 and the G3 Ormonde S. at Chester May 6, and would hold the best chance of taking the prize back across the English Channel.

Following a brief delay caused when four horses burst through the gate prior to the start, the runners in South Africa's premier staying event got away to a good even break. The slow pace began to heat up at the five-furlong marker, but once into the straight the field was still fairly compact and there were any number of horses still in with a chance. The lightly weighted Place of Gold, a winner of five of his last six starts, finally asserted himself and drew clear in the final stages to win by 1 1/2 lengths from top-weight Golden Hoard.

The winner of the G2 Prix Hocquart in May of 1998, Sayarshan was eighth in the '98 G1 French Derby, then went to the bench for 9 1/2 months. Off the board in a pair of French group races in March and April, he shipped across the Atlantic and made his U.S. debut a winning one, taking the Gill Golden Gate H. June 19. Eighth after a rough trip in his latest, the Gil Sunset H. July 18, he rebounded in his first try over the Del Mar course, rating in sixth through a moderate mile before angling out at the quarter pole and finishing full of run to catch pacesetter Dancing Place in the final yards. "In his last race, he was very aggressive," jockey Brice Blanc said. "He was all wound up. But (trainer Nick Canani) and I have been working with him in the mornings to calm him down. He was settled today. He was relaxed, then, when I asked him, he exploded."

Ultra-consistent Cape Cross, winner of the 1998 G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. and the G2 Queen Anne S. at the Royal Ascot meeting in June, was supposedly Godolphin's second string here, but collected his third group race win with this comfortable defeat of his odds-on stable companion, Josr Algarhoud. Sent straight to the front, Cape Cross led throughout and was always traveling too strongly for Josr Algarhoud, who challenged briefly two furlongs out, but failed to quicken. Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford was not surprised by the win. "Cape Cross is a top-class horse and Josr Algarhoud is lightly raced and the one who had something to prove," he said. "Josr Algarhoud became a little unbalanced on this track, but he will be a nice horse next year."

GRAND NATIONAL TV RIGHTS UP FOR GRABS

Aintree Racecourse will offer the television rights for the Martell Grand National on the open market. The BBC has broadcasted the race since television coverage began in 1952, but the present rights agreement ends at the end of next year. The BBC has lost many sporting events to rival broadcasters and wants to retain the rights for the race. It also wants to win back the rights to the Cheltenham Festival, which is now televised by Channel 4, whose contract also ends next year. The BBC coverage of the Grand National is one of the most popular live sporting events on the calendar, with more than 10 million people watching in Britain and hundreds of millions more around the world. Charles Barnett, managing director of Aintree, said, "We will gladly listen to bids from channels like ITV and Channel 4; we are not expressing a preference for anybody. We will be looking at a series of factors, including the fee, the likely potential audience, the quality and type of coverage and what the bidders can bring in terms of build-up. Nothing has so far been decided." A BBC spokesman said, "We would expect that other companies would bid for the Grand National, but after the time spent working on the event with Aintree, we have no interest in giving it up." The Grand National must be screened on one of the terrestrial channels, although a joint bid with one of the satellite operators cannot be ruled out. A Channel 4 spokesman said, "Channel 4 has developed a fantastic relationship with the horseracing community and clearly any conversation about the future coverage of the sport is almost certain to involve us. We believe we have done a good job in covering the Cheltenham Festival and are bidding strongly to retain that coverage."

WALWYN TO RETIRE; TRAINED DERBY WINNER GRUNDY

Trainer Peter Walwyn, best known for his training of Grundy (Ire) to win the 1975 Derby, is to retire at the end of the season, with assistant Ralph Beckett due to take over at his Windsor House stable in Lambourn. Walwyn, 66, has been training for 38 years and been champion trainer twice, in 1974 and '75. He also had 1000 Guineas winner Humble Duty (Aus), Britain's Champion Two-Year-Old Filly, Champion Miler and Three-year-Old, and won the 1974 Epsom Oaks with Polygamy (GB). "Time goes on and I have made the decision," he said. "I have had very good horses and very good owners. There have been so many highlights, but Grundy was a champion at two and at three and very few horses do that. He was a very good horse."
