GENERALLY UNCHALLENGED

A pace-prompting two-length victory in the GII Santa Catalina S. set General Challenge (General Meeting) squarely on the Triple Crown trail, a course which was altered temporarily by a very disappointing run when fifth in the GII Louisiana Derby in March. Baffert added blinkers for the gelding's next run, and the long chestnut responded with an authoritative victory in the GI Santa Anita Derby, an effort which propelled him, along with entrymate Excellent Meeting into Derby favoritism. Bumped, checked and six wide at various times in the race, the Cal-bred emerged 11th and was rested until a two-length success in the June 26 GIII Affirmed and was most recently a bang-up second in the July 18 GI Swaps. Passing on the Haskell and Travers against fellow sophomores, Baffert entered his charge against older horses for the first time in the GI Pacific Classic. General Challenge, with blinkers added once again, broke cleanly under jockey David Flores and was maneuvered to the rail to save ground into the backstretch. Flores had a handful of horse in between rivals nearing the four-furlong marker and guided his mount through an opening approaching the far turn. General Challenge opened two lengths at the guarter pole as stablemate River Keen (Ire) (Keen {GB}) loomed the sole threat, but the three-year-old was able to hold his more seasoned opponent safe for the victory. Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo {Arg}), the 6-5 favorite, never reached contention and finished fifth, beaten 11 3/4 lengths. "He never looked like he was into the race," said trainer Richard Mandella. The success of General Challenge is reminiscent of the performance turned in by another Golden Eagle three-year-old gelding, the late Best Pal, who won the inaugural Pacific Classic in 1991. Owner Betty Mabee was overcome with emotion. "When I saw at the quarter pole that he had the lead and was going to win, I just started crying. It was very emotional," she said. The victory capped a trying week for the Mabees, as their Excellent Meeting was forced to the sidelines with an bone chip in her ankle. "I'm glad that's over. The Mabees need that," said winning conditioner Bob Baffert. "This horse has so much talent. What you saw today was just the tip of the iceberg." Flores added, "I had confidence in him today. When we hit the backside, I let him open up some and then at the three eighths, I let him roll. Turning for home, I didn't think anybody was going to beat him." (Chart p. 2)

STAR OF THE BALL: CHILUKKI WINS DEBUTANTE

Chilukki (Cherokee Run), the dominant force of this year's two-year-old filly division, entered yesterday's GI Vinery Del Mar Debutante with a perfect four-for-four record, three graded stakes wins and two track records to her credit. The Del Mar bettors sent her off the prohibitive 1-5 favorite, but it wasn't as easy as all that. The Bob Baffert trainee dueled for the early lead while in tight along the rail, and appeared home free as she spurted clear at the top of the lane. But The Thoroughbred Corp.'s Spain (Thunder Gulch) charged from the back of the pack to cut Chilukki's three-length lead down to one length at the wire. Despite his dwindling advantage, winning rider David Flores said, "She was playing around (in the stretch). I know she looked like she was tired, but she wasn't. She just didn't have any competition. When that other filly (Spain) came to her, she went again." Trainer Bob Baffert added, "I was scared to death when I saw :22 1/5 and :44. They're vulnerable at seven furlongs. She'll never have to go :44 3/5 again. It set up for a horse to come off the pace today." Jockey Gary Stevens, recently returned from a stint in England, almost pulled the 16-1 upset with Spain. "Going into the race, it didn't look like there was any way we were going to beat (Chilukki)," Stevens explained. "(Spain's) people said they'd just be happy with a placing. Then at the eighth pole, I thought I was going to win it." At the start of the race, longshot Princes Melissa (Marquetry) ducked in sharply and jumped the inner rail, dumping rider Garrett Gomez. The filly suffered only minor lacerations in the accident and Gomez was uninjured. Chilukki's victory gave Baffert and Flores the Del Mar stakes daily double. The pair teamed up to take the Pacific Classic with General Challenge. (Chart p. 2)

excellent Meeting (General Meeting) will miss the rest of the year after a bone chip was discovered in her ankle, according to a report in *Daily Racing Form*. The filly will have surgery Tuesday and is expected to miss five months of training. Owner John Mabee told the *Form*, x-rays showed the chip was likely there since Excellent Meeting's runner-up finish in last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. The filly finished next to last in the Aug. 22 Gl Del Mar Oaks.

"This horse lugs in a bit when he gets in front and he tried to do that again today, but when he heard the other horse (Catienus) coming, he dug down deep," explained winning rider Shane Sellers. "He's a real phenomenal horse to be able to go back and forth across the ocean like he does." Trainer Philip Mitchell said his charge will race next in the Sept. 18 Gl Woodward at Belmont and then head to Hong Kong in December for the Hong Kong Cup.

Her persistent run paid dividends and she hit the front in the last half furlong, running on strongly for a decisive win. Cap Coz eventually found racing room in the final furlong and ran on in good style, but didn't have the ammunition to trouble the winner.

In a dramatic and tight finish, when the first four could have been covered by a single blanket, the homebred Icicle, from the in-form Fanshawe stable, stuck her head out on the line to snatch the honors from Croeso Cariad, Winner of a minor Folkestone maiden in her debut in late May, Icicle was then thrown straight into stakes company, but could finish only sixth in the Listed Empress S. at Newmarket at the end of June. Settled at the back of the field early on as Hypnotize (Machiavellian) led at a good pace from Marah (Machiavellian), Icicle still had plenty of ground to make up entering the final furlong after Croeso Cariad grabbed the lead, but she finished strongly along with Goodwood Blizzard and Chez Cherie (Wolfhound), and these four hit the line together. A stewards' inquiry into the scrimmaging in the final furlong followed, but the placings remained unaltered. Icicle's trainer, James Fanshawe, said, "There is a chance to supplement her for the Marcel Boussac [Oct. 3 at Longchamp] and she likes soft ground and will appreciate the extra distance." Winning rider Ray Cochrane said, "I think the finish and the inquiry were more nerve-wracking for the trainer than for me. I was quite happy. I made a clear run and maintained it. Later in the year, when the ground is softer, this filly will do even better."
