The fact that it was a little higher concerned us, so we pulled some blood on him and his white count came back slightly elevated, indicative that he was possibly coming down with a virus or a bug." Pletcher will now aim his charge towards the Sept. 19 GI Futurity at Belmont Park.

ber Breeding Stock Sale to reap some handsome dividends on their investments.

If you remember, the top-priced mare was the five-year-old Mariah's Storm, bought for \$2,600,000 by John Magnier, with the next-best price of \$1,900,000 paid by Betty Moran's Brushwood Stable for La Affirmed. Significantly, both mares were carrying colts by Storm Cat, and both colts have now become Group winners in Ireland for Aidan O'Brien this year.

Ironically, after buying Mariah's Storm, Magnier explained, "We wanted a mare for Cigar for (Michael) Tabor and our pedigree people thought she was the best mare and would work well."

Of course, Cigar's fertility problems made all such speculation pointless, but Mariah's Storm has still proved a wise buy. Her Storm Cat colt, Giant's Causeway, made an impressive debut in a six-furlong maiden at Naas in July, drawing away to score by seven lengths, and he carried Sue Magnier's colours to a comfortable victory in the G3 King of Kings EBF Futurity S. at The Curragh last Sunday. It is hard to know what to make of the Futurity form because Giant's Causeway had only three opponents, but the best of them was his stable-companion Brahms, a million-dollar colt by Danzig out of Mr. Prospector's champion daughter Queena.

O'Brien commented afterwards that Giant's Causeway is "a smasher and he has a lovely, laid-back attitude." He also mentioned the G1 National S. Sept. 19 at the Curragh as a possible target for the colt as well as for Bernstein, the Storm Cat colt out of La Affirmed. Bernstein came into the O'Brien Stable after Demi O'Byrne bought him for \$925,000 at Keeneland a year after La Affirmed's seven-figure sale. This brother to the GIII winners Caress and Country Cat is also two-for-two, his Group success coming back in June when he easily landed the G3 Railway S. at The Curragh.

If these colts can fulfill their considerable potential, they will become very valuable stallion prospects, but I will defer a detailed look at their pedigrees until they actually justify the hype. Suffice to say for the moment that Giant's Causeway is the first foal of Mariah's Storm, a filly who retired with a 10-2-1 record from 16 starts. In addition to being a smart juvenile, weighted at 116 on the 1993 Experimental Free Handicap, Mariah's Storm received an impressive rating of 121 on the 1995 International Classifications. Nine furlongs was her most rewarding distance, so there is every reason to expect Giant's Causeway to be well-suited by a mile.

As a daughter of Rahy, Mariah's Storm represents one of two triumphs that her dam, the Roberto mare Immense, achieved with sons of Blushing Groom. Immense's mating with Rainbow Quest produced Panoramic, a very smart French middle-distance performer now known as the sire of Tuzla, a very good American turf miler. Mariah's Storm is inbred 4 x 3 to Hail To Reason and her pedigree also features three lines to the brilliant Nasrullah, a three-parts-brother to Hail To Reason's grandsire Royal Charger. This is a quality pedigree, especially as Immense was a GIII winner over 8 ½ furlongs on turf, as well as being a half-sister to the champion two-year-old filly Dearly Precious.



Some of the prominently represented first-season sires include the G1 Japan Cup hero Lando (Ger), who had his first winner last weekend; Monsun (Ger); Sternkonig (Ire); and Winged Love (Ire). The dam's side of the catalogued vearlings is best described as solid quality throughout but with no absolute highlight.
