FULL CIRCLE FOR PLETCHER

Two days after trainer Todd Pletcher announced that his superstar juvenile More Than Ready would not run in the GI Hopeful S. due to a fever, his talented filly Circle of Life (Belong to Me) brought home Spinaway glory for the barn. After slamming state-breds by 8 3/4 lengths in her July 8 debut at Belmont, she made a game move for second, beaten three-quarters of a length by Magicalmysterycat, in the GI Schuylerville S. July 28. Breaking alertly, Circle of Life pressed Miss Wineshine (Wolf Power {SAf}) through a half in :44 4/5, took command entering the stretch and drew clear under a drive. Said Pletcher, "We thought the added distance would help her. When she turned for home on the lead, I thought they would have a tough time catching her." Circle of Life is now eligible for a \$1 million bonus from the New York Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund if she can win two more Grade I races in New York this year. The two remaining races in her division are the Sept. 19 GI Matron S. and the Oct. 10 GI Frizette S. "We have a tough decision to make," said Pletcher. "Obviously, the Breeders' Cup (Nov. 6) is our major goal. We have to see if those other two races fit into that schedule." Favored Surfside (Seattle Slew) stalked the pace in third and closed gamely, but was no match for the winner.

NINE READY & HOPEFUL

In the absence of the undefeated divisional leader More than Ready (Southern Halo), nine two-year-olds will go postward today in the 95th running of the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga. Afternoon Affair (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) chased More than Ready home in the GIII Tremont and, after dueling on the lead, finished gamely to be second in the Aug. 18 GI Saratoga Special last time out. "He's still learning," trainer Stanley Hough said. "Depending on how much speed is in the Hopeful, we'd like to see him reserved a little more. He's bred to go the distance." While still a maiden, High Yield (Storm Cat) ran third in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship before trainer D. Wayne Lukas shipped him east to win an Aug. 7 Saratoga maiden race by 8 3/4 lengths last time out. "We always thought he was a good horse, but he has really come into his own (at Saratoga)," Lukas said. "That maiden race indicates his readiness. I think we'd be tough with or without More Than Ready." Exciting Story (Diablo) dominated the competition in two starts at Woodbine, winning a July 18 maiden race by five lengths before taking the Aug. 21 Silver Deputy S. by four.

BIANCONI TO ASHFORD STUD

Bianconi (Danzig--Fall Aspen, by Pretense), the highweight three-year-old sprinter in Ireland last year, has been retired and will join the stallion roster at Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky for the 2000 breeding season. Fall Aspen, the dam of eight group/graded winners including 1994 champion two-year-old and 1995 GI Preakness winner Timber Country, was purchased for \$2.4 million while carrying Bianconi. The late broodmare also produced G1 July Cup winner Hamas (Ire) (Danzig), leading South African sire Fort Wood (Sadler's Wells), Grade I winner Northern Aspen (Northern Dancer) and Elle Seule (Exclusive Native), the dam of English 1000 Guineas winner Mehtaaf (Nureyev) and G1 July Cup winner Elnadim (Danzig). Her son Colorado Dancer (Shareef Dancer) sired Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold), who won the G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois last month. Bianconi, foaled in 1995, went on to finish fourth in the Irish 2000 Guineas in what was only his third career start, then ran second by a neck in the G3 Phoenix Sprint S. before capturing the GII Diadem S. The Kentucky-bred, who failed to train on at four, retires with three wins and two seconds from his 12 starts and earnings of \$135,150. His stud fee will be announced at a later date.

STUD FEE SET FOR EXPLOIT

The *Thoroughbred Times* on-line reports that Exploit (Storm Cat--My Turbulent Miss, by My Dad George) will stand for a fee of \$30,000 at Taylor Made Farm near Nicholasville, Kentucky next season. The three-year-old was the early favorite for this year's Kentucky Derby before suffering a career-ending injury following a second-place finish in the Mar. 13 GII San Felipe S. He retired after winning five of his six starts, including three graded stakes, and \$396,254.

After breaking his maiden on his second start in a Listed race at Hamburg July 2, Auenklang was then pitched into group class at Maisons-Laffitte and finished a good second to Rossini in the G2 Prix Robert Papin. He looked to be facing a tough nut in the G2 Richmond S. runner-up Hunting Lion here, but he simply murdered the opposition, leading throughout and racing home by clear daylight, suggesting that he could be something special for the future. Hunting Lion tried to go with the leader, but he was cooked a long way out, tiring to be third. Auenklang became the first German-bred winner of this prestigious event since Landsgirl (Ger) in 1981.

Tuzla captured the GII Dahlia, GII Buena Vista and GII San Francisco Mile H., but had a four-race win streak broken when she ran second behind Happyanunoit in the Aug. 11 GIII Palomar H. Tranquility Lake won both the Apr. 17 GII Santa Barbara H. and June 6 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. by daylight before running second in the July 3 GI Beverly Hills H. last time out. Happyanunoit, a Group 1 winner in her native New Zealand, has won two of five American starts, but tired to fifth the only time she tried this distance in the Gamely Breeders' Cup H. three starts back.

Diktat will be a warm order for this based on his excellent victory in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 8. He is something of a seven-furlong specialist, though, and would prefer a bit of give in the ground. The track management have watered the course to ensure the best possible racing ground. He will be more inconvenienced by the trip than the ground, but he still has the necessary class to overcome these minor irritations. Arkadian Hero, winner of the G2 Mill Reef S. as a juvenile, has two recent Listed stakes victories to his name. He overcame a terrible draw to be a respectable fourth to Stravinsky in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 8, and, on his latest start, was successful in the Hopeful S. at Newmarket Aug. 27. Bertolini finished ahead of Arkadian Hero in the July Cup, as did Bold Edge, and then chased home Diktat in the Prix Maurice de Gheest. He has undoubted class, but has been just that bit short in the highest company.

Tanaasa has started only twice in each of the last two years. The lightly raced Irish-bred was off the board in both 1998 outings, but he has already won two races this year, capturing a June 11 Hollywood allowance in his first start in seven months and returning to take a 1 3/8-mile restricted stakes at Del Mar July 23 by 7 1/2 lengths last time out. Desert Waves, winner of this year's GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H., has a long history in the Niagara. The nine-year-old won this race in 1997 and 1996, was second in 1995 and third in 1994. He is coming off a third-place finish behind Crown Attorney in the GII Hong Kong Jockey Club Trophy S. Crown Attorney will seek this third straight victory since finishing second behind Desert Waves in the King Edward in June.

NANI ROSE'S VET BANNED Dr. Greg Fox, the veterinarian who allegedly treated Nani Rose (Peteski) prior to the running of the Aug. 25 Lake Placid H. in violation of New York State Racing and Wagering Board rules, has been barred from practicing at New York tracks by the NYSRWB, it was announced yesterday. Fox was found to have administered an illegal race-day injection to the Pat Byrne-trained filly, which led the track stewards to scratch the horse. According to Byrne, Fox mistook Nani Rose for another horse and gave her a shot of a nutritional supplement called CRE-O-PAN. The supplement itself is not illegal, but a horse cannot be treated with anything but Lasix in New York once its name appears in the entries. Fox, who normally practices on the Kentucky circuit, was granted temporary privileges in New York Aug. 6. Those privileges were formally revoked and the staff of the NYSRWB will recommend that his privileges to practice in New York be permanently withdrawn. In addition, the NYSRWB said that Byrne will be ordered to appear before the three-member board at an unspecified date. Following that hearing, the Board will decide what penalties, if any, will be levied against Byrne. According to a media advisory issued yesterday by the NYSRWB, possible penalties include temporary or permanent revocation of Byrne's New York license. "I'm glad they're taking a thorough investigation," Byrne said. "I plan to be vindicated."

"He was just dragging (jockey Jose Santos) around out there," trainer Christophe Clement said. "He's doing super." The five-year-old goes next in the GI Man o'War S. Sept. 11.
