#### "HIGH" HOPES

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas has another star in his barn. This time it's the \$1,050,000 yearling purchase High Yield (Storm Cat), who cruised to a five-length victory in the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga yesterday afternoon. Owned by a partnership comprised of Bob and Beverly Lewis, Mrs. John Magnier and Michael Tabor, the flashy chestnut was third in the July 18 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship in his second start, then shipped east and posted an eye-catching 8 3/4-length victory in a Saratoga maiden test Aug. 7. The 9-5 Hopeful favorite in the absence of More Than Ready, he broke well, stalked the pace from the inside, angled out for running room around the turn to carry jockey Jerry Bailey to the front at the eighth pole and strode away to a decisive score. Concerned about Bob Lewis, who underwent open-heart surgery Thursday, Lukas said, "I told Jerry, 'Don't make it close--no noses or nods." He added, "I wish More Than Ready had been in there today. I'd have to think...it would have been a hell of a race. (High Yield) is a very strong, athletic horse. I think the best is still in front of him. We're looking at one race before the Breeders' Cup. I would really like a twoturn race, but I wouldn't rule out the Champagne (GI, Oct. 9 at Belmont Park)."

#### SOPHOMORE SET TOPS PRIX DU MOULIN


Three-vear-olds dominate today's G1 Emirates Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, the penultimate European mile championship event, with only the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 25 yet to come. The Prix du Moulin features a re-match between Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo) and Aljabr (Storm Cat), who were separated by only 1 1/4 lengths when first and second, respectively, in the G1 St James's Palace S. over a mile at Royal Ascot June 15. Aliabr was making his first start of the season after an aborted trip to the U.S. for the Kentucky Derby, while Sendawar had previously won the G1 Dubai Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) May 16, beating Dansili (GB) (Danehill) by 1 1/2 lengths. While the French 2000 Guineas hero has not run since Roval Ascot, Aljabr went on to an all-the-way victory in the G1 Champagne Lanson Sussex S. at Goodwood July 28. Fly To The Stars (GB) (Bluebird) may be in the field to ensure a good pace for stable companion Aljabr, but he is no slouch, leading throughout to win the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. over a mile at Newbury May 15 when he was supposed to be setting the pace for Intikhab. Slickly (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) won the 1 1/4-mile G1 Grand Prix de Paris here June 27 and ran second to Dubai Millenium in the G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-Le-Buffard Jacques Le Marois over a mile at Deauville Aug. 15, with Dansili third. Gold Away (Ire) (Goldneyev), winner of the G3 Prix Edmond-Blanc and G2 Prix du Muguet in the spring, finished strongly to be a length runner-up behind Saturday's G1 Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup winner Diktat (GB) in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest over 6 1/2 furlongs at Deauville Aug. 8.

#### BADEN-BADEN SALE A RECORD SUCCESS

Yesterday's Baden-Baden Yearling Sales, Germanv's first horse auction in a purpose-built professional sales ring, produced a solid market and strong attendance, realizing many good prices. The combination ensured a spectacular opening of a new era in the German bloodstock business, developing into the best-ever edition in the 30-year history of the sale. The sales topper at a new German public auction price of DM620,000 was Lot 172, Gestut Etzean's colt Tareno (Ger) (Saddlers' Hall {Ire}--Triclaria {Ger}, by Surumu {Ger}), purchased by Baron Georg Von Ullmann. Triclaria is a half-sister to several winners, including the stakes-winning Thagus (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}). The second highest-priced colt, at DM480,000, was Lot 94, Banyumas (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}--Bennette {Fr}, by Top Ville {Ire}), bred by Mr. and Mrs. Dieter Meinke and consigned by Gestut Schlenderhan, Bought by Schlenderhan, Banyumas is a half-brother to the Banyumanik (Ire) (Perugino), winner of last year's Listed Kronimus-Rennen at Baden-Baden. The highest-priced filly was Lot 147, Denice (GB) (Night Shift--Desponia {Ger}, by Aspros {Ger}), was bought for DM500,000 by Manfred Hofer on behalf of Turf Syndikat. Turf Syndikat includes prominent ownerbreeder Alfred Steigenberger, who raced the champion and successful sire Platini (Ger). Desponia is a full sister to the German champion two-year-old filly of 1988, Diasprina (Ger). (Sales chart p. 3)

Winning his second straight Group 1 race, following his victory in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest over 6 1/2 furlongs at Deauville Aug. 8, and taking his record this season to a perfect four-for-four, Diktat gave the Godolphin team its 12th Group 1 win worldwide this year. Stepping down in trip to this six furlongs and sent off the 13-8 favorite against a strong field of specialist sprinters, Frankie Dettori's mount looked tapped for speed early on and had plenty to do as Bertolini grabbed the lead from Imperial Beauty (Imperial Ballet) and swept to a clear lead over a quarter mile out. But Dettori conjured a strong finishing burst from Diktat, who quickened brilliantly a furlong from the wire, caught Bertolini with only 50 yards to run and ran out a clever winner under a hands-and-heels ride. "He is a true seven-furlong horse, but he never ceases to surprise me," said Dettori, "With a furlong to run, Bertolini was three lengths up, but Diktat really knows where the winning post is." Trainer Saeed bin Suroor said, "Before we came here, we were a little worried about the ground, but when we checked it, we found that it was perfect." Next stop for Diktat will be the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp Oct. 17, with possibly the Breeders' Cup Mile also on the agenda.

Tuzla had won 11 of 19 races in her career, but had yet to win at Grade I level. Her last try, the 1998 Santa Maria H., ended with a 17-length defeat and was her final race on the dirt. She reeled off seven wins in her next nine starts, with three Grade II victories, and was the second choice here to even-money favorite, Tranquility Lake (Rahy). A recent purchase by Stonerside Stable from David Milch, her former trainer, Julio Canani, gave new conditioner Bob Baffert some advice. "Don't get crazy," he said. "Whatever you do, don't put her on the lead." Baffert told jockey David Flores to sit behind horses and he followed instructions perfectly, splitting rivals around the final turn and holding off the late surge of Happanunoit. "He [Baffert] said, 'Get a good spot, and then when the time comes for her to run, she'll run.' We made the lead so easy, I couldn't believe it. Maybe I went with her too soon. They were really coming at me at the finish." It was Baffert's fifth Grade I win at Del Mar this year, four with Flores, an unprecendented clean sweep.

Thornfield had won four straight turf races at Woodbine before finishing a close second as the heavy favorite in his last. Stepping up in class, he was dismissed by the public, raced off the pace while in-hand early, split horses approaching the turn, was briefly blocked but got clear as they entered the stretch and drew clear late under heavy urging to score a surprise victory. Winning jockey Richard Dos Ramos said, "When I asked him he just exploded in the lane. When he took off like that going a mile and a half, I knew he was going to be pretty tough to beat." Trainer Phil England added, "We always liked him, but never knew he was this talented a runner. It was time to try him in a stake and it worked out great." Heavy 4-5 favorite Tanaasa, who shipped in from California, seemed affected by the hot weather and finished second. The win for Thornfield sets him up for a possible shot in the \$1.5 million GI Canadian International Oct. 17.

Only a week after winning the Listed Sport On 5 March S. at Goodwood, Yavana's Pace stepped up to score his first group race victory and in the process has probably ended the Melbourne Cup aspirations of The Queen's Blueprint, After Night Flyer (GB) (Midyan) set a modest pace for the first three-eighths of a mile, Kieren Fallon shot Blueprint into the lead, pursued by Night Flyer and Yavana's Pace. With a guarter-mile to run, it became a duel between Blueprint and Yavana's Pace and the seven-year-old gelding would not be denied, grabbing the lead a furlong out and, despite idling in front, running on well in the closing stages. Jockey Joe Fanning, enjoying his first group success, said, "He traveled really well for me. I didn't think the pace was that fast during the early stages. I always felt that I could pick up Blueprint and...my horse proved the stronger in the finish."

#### Grosser Preis Von Baden Cont.

This year's edition of Baden Baden's seasonal highlight could be called a summit of the leading domestic three-year-olds and Germany's best older horse Tiger Hill. Tiger Hill, a gallant second to El Condor Pasa in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud at Saint Cloud July 4, won the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis over 1 1/4 miles at Munich Aug. 1. The 1 1/2 miles could prove a testing distance, even though this classy, honest and consistent performer will give everything he has. Owner Baron Georg von Ullmann also has Sumitas and Saugerties in the field; the latter will act as pacemaker. Stable jockey Andreas Suborics has interestingly picked Sumitas as his mount and Germany's champion juvenile possesses undoubted stamina. The winner of the G2 Mehl Mulhens Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) at Cologne May 16, he came right back to his best when just touched off by Ungaro (Ger) in the G1 WGZ Bank-Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf July 25, where Suborics gave him too much to do. Belenus, winner of the G1 BMW Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 4, was a most impressive winner of the G2 BMW Europa-Championat at Hoppegarten Aug. 8 on his last start. G2 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) winner Flamingo Road should not be underestimated. She has since finished third on two occasions, behind Belenus in the Deutsches Derby and also in the G1 ELE-Pokal-Grosser-Erdgas-Preis at Gelsenkirchen Aug. 15. Lucky Dream, the French challenger, is unbeaten in two starts this year and, on his last racecourse appearance, won the G2 Prix Maurice de Nieuil at Maisons-Laffitte July 24.

Torgau, trainer Giles Bravery's first runner in Ireland, won G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket July 6 but Bravery has voiced concerns about her ability to stay the trip. This race is part of a plan which, if all goes well, will also see her tackle the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket Sept. 28. Her biggest danger is another British-trained challenger, Littlefeather, who she beat by 2 1/2 lengths in a maiden event at Catterick June 4. Littlefeather has done nothing but improve since that race and has won her last three. She was most impressive on her latest start in a conditions race at Chester Aug. 20. Eurolink Raindance is another well-regarded British raider and will seek to improve on her second in the Listed Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket Aug. 14. The home defense is headed by Mandama, Amethyst and Yara. Mandama won her only start to date, a maiden at Tipperary Aug. 18. Amethyst, representing the all-conquering Aidan O'Brien team, was second at odds of 1-4 in the Listed Debutante 2vo Fillies' S. at Leopardstown Aug. 22, whereas Yara has, guite remarkably, finished second in all of her seven starts to date.

#### ST LEGER UPDATE

#### **Tchaikovsky Supplemented:**

As expected, trainer Gerard Butler and owner Prince Faisal bin Khalid yesterday supplemented **Tchaikovsky** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), at cost of £20,000, into the 223rd and richest-ever running of the world's oldest Classic, the G1 Rothmans Royals St Leger S. at Doncaster Saturday. The colt, who finished third in the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh in June, was bought out of Aidan O'Brien's stable and joined Butler's Oxfordshire stables last month. The race will now be worth £370,000, as the supplementary entry fee goes on top of the advertised prize money of £350,000.

#### Second-Choice Iscan May be Barred:

Sheikh Mohammed's Iscan (Ire) (Caerleon{USA}), trained by Michael Stoute, is technically ineligible to run in the St Leger, as he had been reported twice to the stewards after giving problems going into the stalls and there is not time to have a stalls test before the race, according to Jockey Club rules. Jockey Club spokesman John Maxse said, "After the second report, there must be a 14-day gap before he is submitted for a stalls test, which takes him to next Saturday, and he cannot do a test and run on the same day. So as things stand now, he is ineligible for the St Leger. My understanding is that Sir Michael Stoute will make representations to the Jockey Club to see if Iscan can run." Sir Michael said, "The position is that Nigel Macfarlane [secretary to the Jockey Club's disciplinary committee] said they will make a decision on Monday morning whether or not the horse can have a stalls test before the Leger. The rule is at their discretion, but one has to hope they will show a bit of flexibility and allow the horse to run in the Classic." Iscan is currently the second favorite.
