#### SENDAWAR WINS LONGCHAMP BATTLE

The winner of the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains May 16 and the G1 St. James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 15, Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo) confirmed his status as the top miler in Europe with an authorative display in yesterday's G1 Emirates Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, setting a race record in the process. Settled in fifth on the rail as the G1 Lockinge S, winner Fly To The Stars (GB) (Bluebird) set a scorching pace for his stablemate Aliabr (Storm Cat), he was switched off the inside to make his challenge as Aljabr and Dansili (GB) (Danehill) took over at the quarter-mile mark. It was all Sendawar in the final furlong, as he ran on strongly for a comfortable win. Winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said, "This horse is very gifted and one of his strengths is his temperament--nothing worries him. He is so relaxed, he laid down in his box on the way to the races and had a nap. If he comes out of this race in good order and gets suitable ground at Ascot, he will travel for the [G1] Queen Elizabeth II S. [Sept. 25]." His Highness, the Aga Khan, added, "Daylami (Ire) will be retired...at the end of the season and there is no reason, therefore, to retire two horses of this caliber in the same year. He could have a wonderful season as a four-year-old."

#### OLD TRIESTE'S STREAK STOPPED AT FOUR

Old Trieste (A.P. Indy) had won four straight graded stakes going into vesterday's GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. and was the 2-5 favorite to keep the streak alive. But the chestnut colt bobbled at the break and then weakened late in his first start since taking the May 29 GII Californian S. and finished third, a length and an neck behind 9-1 winner Hollycombe (Capote) and 18-1 runner-up Flying With Eagles (Skywalker). "He needed the outing," said his jockey, Chris McCarron. "We knew that, but I thought with his class and inherent ability he would be able to overcome that today. When he stumbled out of the gate, it didn't help me." The lightly raced Hollycombe, making his stakes debut after a victory in an optional claimer at Del Mar Aug. 21, broke sharply, set honest fractions, shook off a challenge from the favorite after a half and had enough left in the tank to edge clear late. "Chris put some heavy pressure on me at the half-mile pole, but my horse was in good rhythm and he could handle it," winning jockey Gary Stevens said. "(Old Trieste) was giving me his best shot and I knew I had him."

His stable companion Saugerties (Trempolino) set the pace, going more than 10 lengths clear of Tiger Hill at one stage, with Sumitas (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) in third. Sumitas and Saugerties dropped away around the final turn as Tiger Hill took an easy lead and raced away for a comfortable score. The filly Flamingo Road and the German Derby winner Belenus engaged in a furious battle over the final quarter mile, with the former proving just the better at the line.

Winner of the Listed Debutante Fillies S. at Leopardstown Aug. 22 and unbeaten in two starts beforehand, Preseli maintained her perfect record with a strong stretch run to outfinish the British challengers Torgau and Littlefeather. She did have to survive a stewards' enquiry, having nudged Amethyst (Sadler's Wells) slightly when making her challenge. Torgau disputed the early running and held the outright lead at halfway. Preseli, in the rear early, made progress into mid-division as the field straightened up for home and looked menacing when switched to the outside, where Littlefeather was looking for racing room as well. Preseli's sustained effort saw her grab the lead inside the final furlong as Torgau ran on a gallant runner-up. Winning trainer Michael Grassick said, "I have won three Group 3 races before, but this is my most important victory as a trainer. Preseli looks as though she will stay further. She is in the Irish 1000 Guineas and Irish Oaks and I think she will get 12 furlongs because she has been finishing well in all her races."

Heritage of Gold launched a five-race assault on winner's circles in the Midwest which earned her four consecutive stakes victories. The streak began with a 1 3/4-length score in the Irving Distaff over the Lone Star turf Apr. 17 and two starts later included a onelength tally in the Prestonwood Distaff over the same course. The bay vaulted into national prominence when she rallied from well off the pace to win the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup at Monmouth Park July 5 over a strong field on the main track; she was most recently third in the Aug. 7 Gl Go For Wand H. Switched back to the turf for this effort, the bay broke alertly and rated kindly for jockey Shane Sellers outside Witchful Thinking (Lord Avie) and Khumba Mela for the opening six furlongs. Around the far turn, Sellers asked his mount to take up the running and she put in a powerful move to wrest command from Witchful Thinking at the eighth pole, then outsprinted Khumba Mela for the victory. Winning conditioner Tom Amoss was saddling the winner for only the second time. "The filly made a transition to our barn after the Monmouth race and it took longer for us to become accustomed to her habits," Amoss said. "We decided in the paddock that we were just going to let her be comfortable wherever she might be." Amoss indicated that the Breeders' Cup is the ultimate goal for the four-year-old. "We'll lean more towards the filly/mare turf race," he commented. The 2-1 favorite Soaring Softly (Kris S.), previously undefeated on the turf, put in a mild bid on the turn, but flattened out in the lane to finish fifth.

The winner was ridden to challenge for the lead on the outside at the quarter-mile marker and soon went clear, settling the contest in an instant. She was eased nearing the line and was much better than the official winning margin.

Pozarica went straight to the lead in advance of fellow British challenger Jaseur (Lear Fan) as the field raced in single file at equal intervals. Pozarica still held a commanding advantage at the two-furlong pole, but in-form jockey Gerald Mosse produced Tajoun on the outside to make his challenge approaching the final furlong. He readily went to the lead, but drifted in towards the rail once in front, causing Frankie Dettori to take evasive action aboard Pozarica, who rallied gamely and held on for second from the strong-finishing Divination. The winner will now point to the G1 Prix du Cadran at Longchamp Oct. 2.



#### HAYDOCK DEFENDS SPRINT CUP WATERING POLICY

Haydock officials strongly defended its watering policy after three leading trainers put in complaints to the Jockey Club about the ground Saturday. There were suggestions that the course was watered to persuade eventual winner Diktat (GB) to run in the G1 Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup. The going was officially good to firm, but the trainers argued it was on the slow side of good. Jeremy Noseda saddled Wannabe Grand (Ire) to be seventh in the big race and declared, "I said it before the race, it is not sour grapes, but in my view he [clerk of the course Philip Arkwright] has watered the ground to make sure certain horses ran in the race. The ground should be defined by the weather and all he should be doing is watering to make the ground safe, not to change the going." He was supported by Luca Cumani, trainer of the third Arkadian Hero (USA). Haydock's managing director Richard Thomas said, "We don't mind criticism when it is justified, but this is all nonsense and I do not want my team to get down about claims that we have produced bad ground because it was excellent ground and we have had a result to the big race which the handicapper would have expected."

#### HARD TO FIGURE H. FEATURES HARD TO FIGURE

Hard To Figure (GB) (Telsmoss {GB}) is heading for his 137th start today in his own race, the Hard To Figure H. at Bath, venue for seven of his 17 wins, including his last three, all in a row, in July and August of 1997. Somerset-based trainer Ron Hodges said, "I would think this will be his last season. We wouldn't want to abuse him, though he still enjoys it. If he runs a big race and he gets in the Ayr Silver Cup, then that could well be his last race. If he doesn't get in at Ayr, this could be his last race.
