A "FRIEND" INDEED IN THE FOREGO

Never worse than second in his three starts since joining trainer John Kimmel's string this spring, Crafty Friend (Crafty Prospector) was second in the GI Met Mile before leading from gate to wire to take the July 4 GII Tom Fool H. last time out. The 9-2 second choice to make it two in a row in yesterday's GII Forego H. at Saratoga, the chestnut was once again sent right to the lead, battling favored Affirmed Success (Affirmed) every step and hanging on gamely to take a narrow victory. "My horse was one tough customer," winning jockey Gary Stevens said. "We were in the heat of battle throughout, but I knew I was never in danger." Added Kimmel, "Even though he's got some old aches and nagging injuries, he comes out here and gives you a tremendous effort. These kinds of horses are hard to come by, and it's a privilege to be able to work with them. I think we'll go to the Vosburgh (GI, at Belmont Park Sept. 25) and right into the Breeders' Cup Sprint." Affirmed Success, runner-up as the choice in the Tom Fool as well, won this race by eight lengths last year. He is possible for the Vosburgh.

When breeders select mates for their broodmares, they are always keen to compensate for any obvious weakness in the stallion by choosing a mare who is strong in that area. For example, Storm Cat had some physical flaws, including a pair of problematic forelegs, and the end result was a career restricted to only eight starts, even though he was in training at two, three and four years.

Perhaps Brushwood Farm had Storm Cat's fragility in mind when the decision was made to send him Scoop The Gold, a well-bred daughter of the ultra-tough Forty Niner. Whereas Storm Cat ran only twice in his second season, Forty Niner stood up magnificently to a 13-race three-year-old campaign, reaching the first two in 11 of them, and he retired to Claiborne as a veteran of 19 races in the space of around 16 months. Let's hope that High Yield, the colt that Scoop The Gold produced to Storm Cat, will prove as durable as Forty Niner, because this five-length winner of the GI Hopeful S. clearly has a great deal to offer.

Incidentally, High Yield's owners include Sue Magnier and Michael Tabor, the Coolmore associates who also rank as the owners of Storm Cat's exciting Irish juveniles Giant's Causeway and Bernstein. Is it any wonder that Coolmore recently struck a deal to acquire some lifetime breeding rights to Overbrook's star stallion? High Yield's emergence continues the excellent results that Storm Cat has enjoyed with mares by Raise A Native line stallions, led by Alydar (Aldiza, Cat Thief and November Snow) and Affirmed (Bernstein, Caress, Country Cat and Storm Broker). Again, is it significant that Alydar was sound enough to race 26 times and Affirmed 29 times?

High Yield has an apt name because his story illustrates the sort of profits that can be made in today's industry. Scoop The Gold was consigned by Paul Mellon's Rokeby Stables to Fasig-Tipton's 1994 New York sale of horses in training, with Fred Seitz paying \$185,000 to secure this winning four-year-old. Scoop The Gold's pedigree was more impressive than her performances up to that point. Her dam Leap Lively, an English-raced Nijinsky mare, had won the G3 Hoover Fillies Mile at two and the G3 Johnnie Walker Oaks Trial. And Leap Lively's first foal was Forest Flower, a very small Green Forest filly who more than made up for her lack of inches with her tremendous determination, which helped earn her the title of England's champion juvenile filly of 1986 and a victory in the G1 Irish 1,000 Guineas. Scoop The Gold is bred along similar lines to Miss Golden Circle, a smart American sprintermiler, both mares being by sons of Mr. Prospector out of daughters of the Graustark mare Quilloquick.

Scoop The Gold did well for Seitz early in 1995, winning the Likely Exchange S. over 6½ furlongs before being mated with the newly retired Holy Bull. Scoop The Gold was then dispatched to Keeneland's November Sales, where her price more than doubled to \$475,000. The Brushwood team have every right to be delighted with their purchase because High Yield, Scoop The Gold's second foal, realized \$1.05 million at Keeneland.

High Yield still has some way to go before he repays his purchase price but he looks likely to prove a bargain. He is inbred 3 x 4 to Northern Dancer, through Storm Bird and Nijinsky, and he must have prospects of one day getting 1¼ miles. His broodmare sire Forty Niner stayed the distance well enough to win the Travers S. and finish a close second in the Kentucky Derby, and his second dam Leap Lively was Group 1 placed over 1½ miles, finishing third in the Oaks and second in the Yorkshire Oaks.

MONMOUTH WRAP-UP Sunday's closing crowd of 15,453 helped boost the attendance for the 1999 Monmouth Park meet to 713,454, bringing the daily average to 9,909, just one-half of 1 percent below the 1998 figure of 9,959 for the 72-day season. "I am very pleased," Bob Kulina, vice president of racing for Monmouth and the Meadowlands, said. "We didn't have the best weather in the world, but besides that, it was a good meet. We had 90-degree day after 90degree day, and the only day it rained during the drought was the morning of the Haskell. The weather could have been a heck of a lot better, and then we would have seen a more positive reflection in the (handle and attendance) numbers." Nevertheless, wagering averaged more than \$3.85 million a day, five percent higher than last season. Purses, aided by a \$3 million supplement, were also higher, with a record \$256,687 distributed to horsemen daily. Jockey Joe Bravo closed out the season with a double on Sunday's final card to take his seventh Monmouth riding title, besting Stewart Elliott 67 wins to 53. The leading owner at Monmouth was Runnin Horse Farm Inc. with 15 tallies overall. Juan Serey topped all trainers at the meet for the fifth straight time, saddling 29 winners, eight more than runner-up Ben Perkins Jr.



Speculation that Doncaster Bloodstock Sales was set to take over selling at Ascot following the retirement of Botterills at the end of the year came to end yesterday when it issued a statement to the contrary. Henry Beeby, Doncaster's managing director, said, "We have looked into the prospect of conducting sales at Ascot. However, we felt we should concentrate our attentions on our existing full program of sales at Doncaster. We have worked hard to upgrade our facilities as part of an ongoing program to offer our Doncaster clients the very best service, but felt we could not provide that level of commitment in Ascot." Ascot sales, whose site is owned by the racecourse authority, has had a meager turnover in recent years and, with Tattersalls not thought to be interested, the only existing domestic Thoroughbred sales company who could take over from Botterills would be Russell, Baldwin & Bright.

ISCAN TO GET STALLS TEST BEFORE ST LEGER

The Jockey Club yesterday gave special dispensation for Iscan (Ire) (Caerleon {USA}) to have a stalls test before racing at Leicester today, rather than waiting until Monday, which would have ruled him out of Saturday's Rothmans Royals St Leger.
