#### DAYLAMI DAZZLES IN CHAMPION S.

On paper, vesterday's G1 ESAT Digifone Champion S. at Leopardstown looked like a highly competitive contest, but Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) turned the race into a rout, securing Godolphin's 14th Group 1 victory worldwide this season with a dominating nine-length decision. By adding this victory to his five-length win in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 24, the five-year-old establishes himself as the runaway leader in the Emirates World Series Racing Championship. Royal Anthem (Theatrical {Ire}) was sent right to the lead in this leg of the series, but, due to the presence of Godolphin's pacemaker Lord Of Men (GB) (Groom Dancer), he was not allowed to dictate the pace as he had when winning the Aug. 17 G1 Juddmonte International. He led into the straight, but Daylami, who had been cruising along in third, was switched to the inside rail to make his bid and in only a few strides the race was over, with jockey Frankie Dettori looked around for non-existent danger from fully a furlong out and easing his mount down in the final 100 yards. Daylami, who has won six Group 1 contests and will retire to his breeder The Aga Khan's Gilltown Stud in Ireland at the end of the season, will now point for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 3. Godolphin boss Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum was naturally elated, but could not resist having a dig at the many experts who had rated Royal Anthem superior to Daylami. "I've been telling everyone that this is the next Swain (Ire)," he said. "I cannot think why the experts rated Royal Anthem superior to our horse. He had beaten him before and now he's done it again. Perhaps those experts should be called something else now." Dettori paid tribute to the decision to run Lord Of Men, saying, "It was hugely important that Lord Of Men took on Royal Anthem up front. He was able to dictate the Juddmonte at York, but our horse harrassed him from the start (in the Champion S.). But even without Lord Of Men, I still think Daylami would have won today." French-based trainer John Hammond was fine Ir£15,000 by the stewards for not starting the Michael Tabor-owned Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) in the race, having declared the horse to run and then deciding to run him instead in today's G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp. ### "SILVER" EXTENDS STREAK TO 11

The 1-10 favorite facing five overmatched rivals, Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) extended her winning streak over the fairer sex to 11 with a 1 3/4-length victory in yesterday's GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Park. Looking to add a fifth Grade I win to her resume, the champ swerved toward the rail from her inside post shortly after the start, then straightened away and settled just off the pace down the backstretch. She carried jockey Jerry Bailey to the lead while three wide on the far turn, drew off at the top of the lane and was not threatened by the late bid of 27-1 runner-up Queen's Word (Kingmambo), who was in receipt of 11 pounds. Explaining the change of course at the start of the race, Bailey said, "The Belmont chute is longer than any other racetrack's. There is stuff back there that many horses never see, and I don't think that she realized that she was in a race. But she got her mind on running...down the backstretch." Added trainer Bob Baffert, "I had no concern. There were some nice fillies in there, but she just outclasses them so much. She's a great filly." Silverbulletday will take on the older distaff set in her next start, the GI Beldame S. Oct. 10.

Displaying courage of the highest order, Mutafaweq galloped relentlessly to the line to deny Ramruma what would have been a famous victory. In the process, he gave Godolphin the record for quickest 50 Group 1 wins worldwide. The winner had previously impressed when taking G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot June 18, but then disappointed slightly when fifth in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 27. He was an encouraging fourth with a late run in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. Aug. 17 and this test of stamina certainly suited his requirements. Outsider Praslin Island (Be My Chief) led at a strong pace from All The Way (Shirley Heights {GB}), Adair and Ramruma, as Mutafaweq raced in relaxed style in fifth. The running began in earnest as the field passed the three-furlong marker, where Ramruma, Mutafaweg and Adair all fought for the lead. Mutafaweg held a definite advantage entering the final quarter, but Ramruma would not give up. The pair treated the fans to a gritty battle until Mutafaweq gained the upper hand inside the final furlong, despite rolling into Ramruma, and he stayed on for a gutsy win, but the effort took its toll. There were distressing scenes in the unsaddling enclosure afterwards as the colt, in obvious discomfort, struck out vigorously. Robin White, the Jockey Club veterinary officer, said, "I think that he suffered from the effects of heat stroke and post-race exhaustion and was dehydrated. We think that caused the incoordination and discomfort. He has been given 10 liters of fluid in an intravenous drip, including a sedative, to settle him down, and antiinflammatories. At the moment we think that it is not a major problem. He has recovered very quickly."

Winless since taking the G2 Hong Kong International Cup in December of 1997, Val's Prince was off the board in five of his six starts last year, but ended the abbreviated campaign with a second-place finish in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga in August. The seven-year-old was then sidelined for 11 months, returning to be second in a July 16 Belmont allowance test and again in the Sword Dancer in his latest effort Aug. 14. The third choice off that performance, the chestnut gelding was on the bridle as he sat just outside pacesetters Mash One (Mashkour) and Fahris (Generous {Ire}), drove to the front as they raced into the stretch and left his rivals in the dust as he kicked away to a decisive victory over the soft turf course. Trained by Jimmy Picou until recently, he was making his first start under the auspices of Jim Bond. "We actually just got him in the barn," Bond assistant Mark Shuman said. "He was in good shape and we just tried to keep him happy. We're still learning about him." Winning jockey Jorge Chavez said, "He loves Belmont. He likes the big turns, and the soft turf is good for him." The winner could go next in the GI Turf Classic Oct. 9, a race he won in '97, with the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 6 as his ultimate goal. Honor Glide (Honor Grades), the 2-1 favorite, was never in the hunt and finished last. "When I asked him, he ran for about 50 yards. After that, he was struggling," jockey Jose Santos said. "From the half-mile pole on, he was going nowhere. He definitely doesn't like the soft going at all."

Daryaba was a game winner of the June 13 G1 Prix de Diane Hermes in what was only her third start and her first in stakes company, beating the highly regarded Star Of Akkar (GB) by a length in a race that was run at a muddling pace. She makes her first start since that victory. Etizaaz, the pick of the Godolphin pair on jockey bookings, is also inexperienced, but she belied her lack of racecourse action to win the Listed Atalanta S. Aug. 21 on her only start this season. That race came over a mile, but it would be foolhardy to suggest that her connections do not believe she will stay this extra half mile. Godolphin's Fairy Queen started the season with a decent effort when 10th in the G1 English 1000 Guineas May 2 and followed up with good wins in the Listed Victress S. June 4 and the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot June 17. She is guaranteed to stay and will be running on her own merits.

Croco Rouge, who finished unplaced in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown July 3 on his most recent outing, will find the 12 furlongs at the outer limits of his stamina capabilities. But he had an abundance of excuses for his latest performance and can be forgiven one poor run. Sagamix has finished fourth in both his starts this season, the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp May 2 and the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at the same track May 23. He has to find improvement to challenge the top two, but he comes good at this time of year and is sure to find track conditions to his liking. Borgia's best effort this season was a second in the G3 Prix Exbury Mar. 13, but she has yet to recapture the form that saw her run second in the Breeders' Cup Turf and third in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in 1997.

Thornfield is by one of the best North American-based sons of Nijinsky II, and his third dam The Temptress is a daughter of Nijinsky, which gives him Nijinsky 2x4 at the top and bottom of the pedigree.

Inbreeding to various members of the Thong family is working extremely well. The latest example is Sabre Dance (f, 2, Sword Dance {Ire}--Sister of Darkness, by Geiger Counter), winner of the Florida Stallion Susan's Girl S. Sword Dance's granddam Lisadell is a multiple group-winning daughter of Thong, and Sabre Dance is out of a mare by Lisadell's half brother Geiger Counter. Note that Sword Dance has sired an earlier stakes winner Sword of Freedom out of a mare by King Pellinore, a half brother to Lisadell and Geiger Counter.
