KEENELAND SEPTEMBER KICK-OFF

Duncan Taylor is on his toes. "It's been busy," said Taylor, who owns and operates Taylor Made Farm with brothers Ben, Frank, Mark and father Joe. "There's been a lot of people looking. But that's good. There's a lot of horses to sell." A lot of lots. This morning, the annual Keeneland September Yearling Sale will begin in Lexington. For 11 long days and nights, yearlings will be offered. Going in, there have been 4,090 horses cataloged for the sale, which dates back to 1944. Coming out, the sale figures to threaten several records. "The sales season started off very strong this year and we had a very, very good July Selected Yearling Sale," said W.B. Rogers Beasley, Keeneland's Director of Sales. "All the signs are that the September Yearling Sales are going to be strong, too. We've had tremendous response for catalogs from both Europe and Asia. We've delivered them on the East Coast and the West Coast and nearly everywhere in between. I really feel like we're going to have a great September." It certainly appears that Keeneland has the horsepower. There are 14 colts and nine fillies by the grand A.P. Indy; five colts and a filly by the ever-popular Danzig; nine colts and nine fillies by two-time leading sire Deputy Minister; eight colts and nine fillies by Gone West, whose off-spring were most popular in the July Selected Yearling Sale. There is a filly by Forty Niner, who now stands in Japan, and one by the standout young stallion Machiavellian. There are eight colts and nine fillies by Storm Cat, one of the hottest-selling stallions in the world. But the big bucks may be reserved for the six colts and one filly that were sired by the late, great Mr. Prospector. "When we added a Select portion to the sale, I think it moved the September Sale into one of the world's most premier events. No longer was this considered a sale for the culls. It became a premier sales event," said Beasley. "The sire power in this sale is really unbelievable. There's quality and quantity of horses in nearly every price range and I think that attracts buyers." It has attracted the consignors, too. Said Taylor, "We feel like there's a lot of good horses here and the right buyers are here, too. We put a lot of emphasis on getting our horses ready and looking good and being here. Now, it's time to find out how good a job we've done." Bidding begins at 10 a.m. each day.

DARYABA TAKES PRIX VERMEILLE

Once again belying her relative inexperience, Daryaba (Ire) (Night Shift) proved her win in the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly June 13 was no fluke by putting up an even more impressive display to take her second Group 1 in comfortable style. She was settled in third as Godolphin's Etizaaz (Diesis {GB}) set a good pace. Daryaba, boxed in against the rail early, found the perfect split between Etizaaz and Mother Of Pearl (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) inside the final quarter and was soon on terms with Etizaaz, cruising by to lead in the last 150 yards. Daryaba will now point to the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe over course and distance Oct. 3. His Highness the Aga Khan said, "She was quite impressive and I think that she should run in the Arc. We have to wait and see how she comes out of this race and we will discuss it with her trainer, but it seems obvious that she should take her chance."

Perfect Sting was a winner of her first three starts for trainer Joe Orseno beginning with a head victory against older over an off-turf course at this trip May 22. She was then a 1 1/2-length victoress of the GIII Sands Point H. June 6 and scored an impressive two-length victory in Monmouth's Captive Miss S. on Independence Day. Most recently, the homebred fell victim to the front-running prowess of turf queen Nani Rose in the Aug. 2 GIII Lake George at Saratoga, getting to that one with every stride in the late going, but ultimately finishing second, ½ length short. Under a masterful ride from Pat Day, Perfect Sting took up a stalking position in midpack while saving all the ground early on as Confessional (Holy Bull) set a moderate pace. Turning into the stretch, Day sent his mount wide and was joined by British invader Ronda nearing the eighth pole, but was able to dispose of that threat and drew clear to the victory. Nordican Inch closed well to be up for the place spot. "Once she kicked clear, she kind of loafed and just galloped to the wire," said Day. "I believe that if another horse had come, she would've picked it up again." Nani Rose, second into the lane, tired late to finish eighth, beaten about six lengths. Of the winner, Orseno said, "We're going to Keeneland and running in the Queen Elizabeth Challenge Cup (GI, Oct. 9). That's a turf course that she's run on before and she's handled it. After that, I'll send her to Danny Vella in Ocala, Florida then he'll take her down to Gulfstream for the

A brilliant winner of both the French and Irish Derbies, Montjeu won his fourth group race of the campaign after a 10-week layoff, but only just, as Michael Kinane got him to lead in the shadow of the post. Kinane settled Montjeu last of the four runners, six lengths off the pace set by First Magnitude. Bienamado followed in second, but Richard Hughes was not happy with the sedate pace and sent Bienamado into the lead before halfway. As the field swung into the straight, Bienamado was ridden and pinched a good advantage on First Magnitude. It was at this point that Kinane brought Montjeu to the outside to make his challenge. Running on strongly, he grabbed the lead in the last couple of strides for a cozier win than the head margin might suggest. Winning trainer John Hammond said, "These trials with only four horses are sometimes very tricky. Everyone knows it is difficult to come from behind at Longchamp when the ground is good and there is no outside rail, especially in a slowly run race. Montieu did it and that's what is important. He needed the race, mentally and physically, and that will help him to be at his best for the big race itself."

With the late scratch of Sagamix (Linamix {Fr}), El Condor Pasa's task seemed somewhat easier, but that thinking proved to be wide of the mark. The Japanese champion had to battle to get the better of a back-toform Borgia in a protracted duel which lasted nearly the length of the straight, and he only asserted his authority close to home for a courageous win. El Condor Pasa was forced to make his own pace and he did so with enthusiasm in advance of Borgia, as Croco Rouge trailed. Turning into the straight, Borgia menaced on the inside rail, and with Kieren Fallon hard at work, the filly responded gamely and got on terms with 1½ furlongs to run. El Condor Pasa was not to be outdone, and the stylish and able Masayoshi Ebina forced his way back into a definite lead in the last half-furlong. Croco Rouge was not disgraced in third and left the form of his disappointing run in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. well behind as he ran on strongly in the closing stages to be a close-up third at the finish. Winning trainer Yoshitaka Ninomiya said, "There is no doubt in my mind that El Condor Pasa was not 100 percent ready, but he was ready enough to run as good a race as he did. He blew after the race and has some weight to lose. Hopefully we will have him spot on for the Arc."

She was cruising behind the leaders as the field turned for home, was quickly on terms once into the straight and went into a clear lead soon after.

SAGAMIX DUBAI BOUND Sagamix (Fr) (Linamix (Fr)) will likely be heading to Dubai as owner Jean-Luc Lagardere is in advanced negotiations to sell last year's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner. Diana Cooper, racing manager of Godolphin's French-based operation, reported on the sale and stressed the purchaser is not Godolphin. Sagamix has been ruled out of running in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 3, and has probably run his last race in Europe. He was an 11th hour withdrawal from yesterday's G2 Prix Foy Gray d'Albion Barriere and finished fourth in both his starts this season, the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp May 2 and the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at the same track May 23.

History often repeats itself, as the St Leger reminded everyone last Saturday. It was back in 1988 that Diesis' daughter Diminuendo started odds on to add the St Leger to her wins in the Oaks, Irish Oaks and Yorkshire Oaks, but this gallant filly found Minster Son too strong in the closing stages. This year it was the turn of Ramruna, another of Diesis's daughters, to start odds on after she had matched Diminuendo's trio of G1 wins. The result was the same, though, with Ramruna running out of stamina against the very determined Mutafaweq.

The timing of Mutafaweq's first Group 1 victory was ideal for the connections of his yearling brother, coming just two days before Craig Bandoroff was scheduled to offer the colt as Hip number 279 at Keeneland. Mutafaweq had come on the market at Saratoga, where the Shadwell team was able to buy him for \$310,000.

Mutafaweq's dam, The Caretaker, became famous when she ran out a three-length winner of the 1989 Cartier Million, a sales-linked race which carried a huge first prize. Although her nearest pursuers included the future Group winners Anshan and Jovial, The Caretaker surprisingly failed to fulfill the high hopes she generated in the Million. She won nothing better than a couple of Listed races at three and finished a fair fourth in the Irish 1,000 Guineas before being sold for 230,000gns. The Caretaker also failed to live up to expectations after her transfer to the United States and retired without adding to her four Irish wins.

All horses in the International *TDN* were bred in North America unless otherwise indicated.

The Caretaker's best Irish performances appeared to come over seven furlongs, which is a reflection of the speed in her female line. The other winners out of her dam Go Feather Go, a five-furlong juvenile winner, included Feathers Lad, who set a track record for six furlongs in the Laurel Turf Sprint, and Go Honey Go, a Grade 3 winner over 8½ furlongs. Significantly, Go Feather Go was bred along very similar lines to Flirting Around, a Round Table colt who showed tremendous speed to win the G1 King's Stand S. over five furlongs in 1975. Both Go Feather Go and Flirting Around were by sons of Princequillo and Go Feather Go's dam was a three-parts sister to the dam of Flirting Around.

So where has Mutafaweq's stamina come from? Caerleon can take some of the credit because he sired winners of the St Legers in England, Ireland, France and Italy, and was himself a son of the great Nijinsky II, the only English Triple Crown winner in a depressingly long time. Otherwise, the credit must go to Mutafaweq's sire, Silver Hawk.

Silver Hawk contested the first two legs of the English Triple Crown, starting favorite for the 2,000 Guineas before finishing third in the Derby, but a cracked cannon bone put him on the sidelines before he had a chance to test his stamina in the St Leger. I suspect he would have stayed the Leger trip, though. His sire, Roberto, was responsible for Touching Wood, the St Leger winner of 1982, and for Bob Back, sire of the 1993 winner Bob's Return. Silver Hawk himself supplied Minds Music, the 1995 second. Perhaps the relevant statistic is that Silver Hawk's broodmare sire, the man-eating Amerigo, numbered the 14-furlong San Juan Capistrano H. among his victories.

Silver Hawk's lengthy list of high-class winners covers a wide range, with Silver Ending, Memories of Silver, Devil Peak River and Grass Wonder among those capable of winning top races at up to 1 1/8 miles. Red Bishop (San Juan Capistrano H.) and Silver Wedge (Queen's Vase) are among the Group winners at the other end of the scale and the intermediate group features Silver Hawk's previous classic winners, Benny The Dip (Derby) and Lady In Silver (Prix de Diane).

Daylami Has A Host of Options:

The next outing for Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) following his sensational victory in the G1 Esat Digifone Champion S. at Leopardstown Saturday has yet to be decided. Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford said, "It was an amazing performance, but we will not be making a decision about his next race until we see how he is over the next few days. The Emirates World Series is very important to Daylami, but more important is his own well-being and we'll monitor things for a while." Bookmakers make him the favorite for the G1 Prix de I'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 3 at Longchamp, but it is not part of the World Series. Other possible Series races include the Breeders' Cup Turf, the BMW Cox Plate in Australia and the Japan Cup.

Mutafaweg Okay but His Year--And Adair's--Is Over: Mutafaweg (USA) (Silver Hawk {USA}), who won Saturday's G1 Rothmans Royals St Leger at Doncaster, but nearly collapsed afterwards, was fine yesterday. Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford said, "Obviously at the time Mutafaweg was suffering in the heat and he had a little bit of heat exhaustion afterwards. which was all under control very quickly. It was a hard race for him as well as for Ramruma (USA) (Diesis {GB}) and Adair (USA) (Theatrical {Ire}), who left the others for dead. I'm pleased to say he's showing no signs of anything that would be of worry to us, but he's done a fantastic job and won't run again this year. He'll go back to Dubai for the winter, but he stays in training next year. Adair was always a fairly immature horse who needed plenty of time and we'll be looking to step him up next year in staying races. He showed us that he's a class act, but it was a hard run and a hard battle and it's quite likely that we'll call it a day with him for this season."

Here and There:

High-Rise (Ire) (High Estate {GB}) could run in the Arc if he performs well in the Listed Arc Trial at Newbury Sept. 19...Last year's St Leger winner Nedawi (GB) (Rainbow Quest {USA}), injured when second to Daylami in the King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot in July, will not race again this year.

FOAL CROP UP IN IRELAND; STEADY IN BRITAIN

Figures released by the Racing Industry Statistical Bureau show that Ireland sharply increased its foal production in 1998, with 7,718 foals on the ground compared to 7,130 in 1997 and 6,556 in 1996. On the other hand, foal production in Britain has been largely static, with 5,233 in 1998, 5,220 in 1997 and 5,198 in 1996. Britain and Ireland exported 4,357 horses in 1998, with 1,023 going to Italy, 757 to France and 528 to the United States.
