SEVEN FIGURE SUMMER SQUALL COLT

On the day that Hurricane Floyd ripped through the east coast of the United States, a colt by Summer Squall topped the fourth session of Keeneland's September Yearling Sale, fetching a final bid of \$1 million from Robert and Janice McNair's Stonerside Stables. The yearling, consigned to the auction by Jim FitzGerald, Agent XIII, and sold as hip number 1288, is out of the Housebuster mare Plucky Maid. It was believed to be the first time in the sale's history that a yearling sold for seven figures at the fourth session. "He is a tremendous individual," said John Adger, who signed the sales' slip for the colt. "We didn't think that we would have to go that high for him. We figured about \$600,000 or \$700,000. But I guess it shows you that there were some other people out there that thought he was a pretty nice colt, too."

VINERY SOLD Vinery has been sold to a partnership headed by Lynden Burns of Roselands in Victoria, Australia, the farm's founder Ben Walden, Jr. announced yesterday. In June 1998, George and Kay Hofmeister purchased a majority interest in Vinery from Walden and his wife Elaine and earlier this week, it was revealed that Walden had sold his remaining 10-percent interest in the farm to the Hofmeisters. The new owners will retain the names Vinery Kentucky, a 245-acre property in the Bluegrass, and Vinery Australia, a 2500-acre farm in the Southern Hemisphere. In addition, the organization owns interests in the dual-hemisphere sires Red Ransom, Gilded Time, Langfuhr and Sandpit.

PEDIGREE SHORTS:

We have noted several recent stakes winners with inbreeding to a stallion through the direct male line of the sire, and through a mare in the female line of the dam. A recent addition to the club is **One Man Tango** (c, 2, **Storm Boot--Avadance**, by **Avatar**), winner of the William Henry Harrison H. He has Northern Dancer 4x3 as the great grandsire of Storm Boot, and as the sire of the second dam.

Roberto's son Shuailaan registered a first-crop stakes winner when **Lost in Paradise** (c, 2, **Shuailaan--Lost Silver**, by **Lost Code**) captured the Beau Brummel S. Lost in Paradise has a clever pedigree pattern as he is linebred to Sir Gaylord and also carries Sir Gaylord's genetic relative Fast Turn, the dam of Ack Ack.

WHO'S HOT, WHO'S NOT

During the 1980s, Northern Dancer was the undisputed heavyweight champion among stallions standing in North America when it came to producing stakes winners and sires. When he was pensioned in 1987, waiting in the wings was Mr. Prospector, who claimed the top spot for most of the '90s. During these two decades, there were many top contenders, stallions like Nijinsky II and Danzig, but when it came to the production of top-class runners and sires, Northern Dancer and Mr. Prospector were the best. And they commanded the highest stud fees of their era.

With the passing of Mr. Prospector earlier this year, the top spot has been up for grabs. There are plenty of contenders. The over-20 crowd includes Deputy Minister (20), Danzig (22), Nureyev (22), Seattle Slew (25), and the younger set consists of A.P. Indy (10), Gone West (15) and Storm Cat (16). This year Storm Cat has laid claim to the top spot and he won't be easy to dethrone. As a sire of stakes winners and as a sire of sires, he has been on fire.

On Sept. 4, Storm Cat reached a North American milestone when his two-year-old son High Yield easily captured the GI Hopeful S. to become Storm Cat's 20th stakes winner of 1999. No North American-based stallion has ever had 20 individual unrestricted stakes winners in one year. In fact, none had achieved 19 until Storm Cat did so in 1998. Prior to Storm Cat's 19, Danzig had come the closest in 1992 with 18 stakes winners.

This has been a career year for Storm Cat, and he still has three-and-a-half months to go. Consider his 1999 stats: 20 unrestricted stakes winners, 13 of them graded-stakes winners including four Grade I winners; 11 juvenile winners of which six are stakes winners (four of them graded) and two others are graded stakes-placed; and he's is North America's leading sire by earnings, leading juvenile sire by earnings and leading sire by international earnings.

Storm Cat sires precocious two-year-olds, but many of them develop into outstanding three-year-olds and handicap horses. The age breakdown of his 20 1999 stakes winners tell the story--six 2YOs, seven 3YOs, four 4YOs, two 5YOs and one 6YO.

With nine crops to race, Storm Cat has sired 72 unrestricted stakes winners for an amazing average of eight stakes winners per crop, and he's done it with an average foal crop of just 58.6. He's sired 16 Grade I winners, and 22 of his stakes winners are winners on the turf. It's no wonder that his 2000 stud fee has been announced at \$250,000, highest in North America.

Storm Cat's success as a sire of sires is also impressive. The first runners by sons of Storm Cat appeared in 1997. Storm Boot, who began his stud career with a \$1,000 stud, now has five stakes winners from his first three crops and stands for a fee of \$10,000. Mountain Cat has six stakes winners from his first three crops and commands \$15,000, triple his original \$5,000 fee. Others include deceased Harlan, who was apparently undervalued at \$5,000 as the sire Menifee, one of this year's best three-year-olds; Delineator, who stands in Washington already has sired his first stakes winner; Florida's Future Storm has three stakes winners; and Catrail, the sire of two stakes winners while standing at the Irish National Stud.

Sons of Storm Cat are a hot commodity in the stud barns around the country, and Kentucky houses some of the most promising. Nine Hennessy yearlings averaged a whopping \$559,444 at the Keeneland July sale, and seven more averaged \$311,428 at the Saratoga sale. Forest Wildcat has turned out to be a surprise with his yearlings selling extremely well. First-year stallion Tale of the Cat was in big demand this year, and Exploit covers his first book of mares in 2000 and will probably be fully booked long before he covers his first mare.

As the leading sire of stakes winners two years running and with the progeny of his sons excelling on the race track and in the sales ring, Storm Cat is clearly following in the hoofprints of Northern Dancer and Mr. Prospector.

CURTAIN FALLS ON AUNTIE MAME'S CAREER

Auntie Mame (Theatrical {Ire}) has been retired after suffering a torn ligament in her right front leg, trainer Angel Penna Jr. reports. Though Auntie Mame had not run since the Nov. 29 GI Matriarch at Hollywood Park, Penna was hoping to bring the five-year-old mare back for this year's GI Flower Bowl Invitational and the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. However, following a stiff gallop Wednesday at Belmont, the ligament problem flared up and Penna realized he would not have time to get her ready for the Breeders' Cup. "Trying to get ahead of the storm, I gave her a strong gallop Wednesday. She did it great, but this morning the ligament swelled up again and hardened," Penna said. "Normally, it wouldn't be a career-ending injury. She'd be fine in a few months, but that would be too late for the Breeders' Cup. There's no sense carrying on and waiting for another year." Penna said the injury was a tear to a ligament that goes from the seasmoid to the pastern. Among the top turf fillies in training last year, Auntie mame won the '98 Flower Bowl and compiled a career record of 17-10-2-3 with \$961,480 in career earnings.

FLOYD KOS RACING The New York Racing Association announced early Thursday morning that racing had been cancelled at Belmont due to the impending arrival of Hurricane Floyd. Calder in Miami and New Jersey's Meadowlands had already announced closures. racing is expected to resume Friday afternoon.

ReRun Announces 1999 Award Recipients

ReRun, the Kentucky-based program to place ex-racehorses into adoptive homes, announced the recipients of the 1999 Wooden Wagon and Spirit Awards Thursday. Claiborne Farm of Paris, Kentucky is the winner of this year's Wooden Wagon Award, given to the outstanding donor of the year. Claiborne donated **Region** (Forty Niner), a multiple stakes winner and earner of nearly \$900,000 to ReRun in May. Region was adopted by Cindy and Dennis Taylor of Lafayette, Indiana, and will be used as a trail horse. Charlotte Griffis, of Murphreesboro, Tennessee is the recipient of the 1999 Spirit Award for her work with **All Canadian** (Alleged). "I'm happy to report that All Canadian is rapidly becoming the talented show horse we knew he could be," said ReRun co-founder and president Shon Wylie. "Without adopters from outside of the Thoroughbred industry, we could never find homes for these horses," explained ReRun co-founder Lori Neagle. "Working together, we can put a big dent in the number of horses headed to slaughter." The ReRun awards will be presented in the Turfway Park winner's circle following the first and second races on Kentucky Cup Day of Champions, Sept. 25.

KINANE RETAINS MONTJEU MOUNT IN ARC

Former Irish champion jockey Michael Kinane will retain the ride on Michael Tabor's French and Irish Derby winner **Montjeu (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp Oct. 3, according to Coolmore Stud representatives. Kinane was on board the John Hammond-trained colt in Sunday's dramatic last-stride victory in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp. Kinane has replaced Cash Asmussen on Montjeu as the Texan, who piloted the colt to his two Derby wins in the summer, will honour his retainer to the Niarchos family and partner their four-year-old colt **Dream Well (Fr)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}), winner of the 1998 French and Irish Derbys and third in last weekend's G1 Esat Digifone Champion S. at Leopardstown.

UNGARO SKIPS MELBOURNE, STAYS NORTH

Multiple Group One winner **Ungaro (Ger)** (Goofalik {USA}) will not after all ship to Melbourne, Australia for the G1 Caulfield Cup Oct. 16 but will instead pursue a Group One campaign in the Northern Hemisphere. Winner of the G1 WGZ-Bank Deutschland-Preis at the end of July and the G1 E.L.E.Pokal-Grosser Erdgas-Preis Aug 15, owned and bred by Gestut Rottgen and trained by Hans Blume, now has a choice of engagements in either the G1 EMS-Kurierpost-Europa-Preis at Cologne Sept 26 or the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp Oct. 3, while longer-term targets may include a shot at the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club in Milan Oct. 17 or the G1 Canadian International at Woodbine in Toronto the same day.

CHAPPLE-HYAM MULLS HONG KONG MOVE

Trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam, who is searching for new premises after owner Robert Sangster's decision to dismiss him from Manton, said yesterday that he had not ruled out a possible move to Hong Kong. There is currently a vacancy in Hong Kong following the suspension of Patrick Biancone's license until June, 2000. Chapple-Hyam, who has looked at several options in Britain, said: "We are definitely looking at it (Hong Kong). But they (Hong Kong Jockey Club) haven't actually spoken to me, honest to God. If and when they do, I will discuss it with them but I have not been in contact with them."
