## DAY 5: FOREST WILDCAT FILLY TOPS KEENELAND

Martin Cherry made a session-high bid of \$310,000 to bring home a filly from the first crop of multiple graded stakes winner Forest Wildcat at Friday's fifth day of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington, Kentucky. The dark bay yearling, consigned by Trackside Farm, Agent VII, is out of the Faraway Son mare Las Manitas. Two colts shared the second highest price of the day. A colt by Unbridled's Song--Ms. Stalwart (Stalwart) sold for \$300,000. The gray yearling, hip 1643, was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, Agent XI, and was purchased by Mike Pegram. Also fetching \$300,000 was hip number 1738, a son of Conquistador Cielo--Sock City (Bailjumper). The chestnut, consigned by Longfield Farm, agent, was sold to James Spence. Through five sessions, Keeneland continues to do a brisk business. The session average was up 43.4 percent and the median rose 33.3 percent from the fifth session in 1998. For the whole sale, the average is up 39.4 percent and the median is up 28.9 percent. The 11-day sale continues today at 10 a.m.

**Running Stag** returns to the scene of his North American debut as the favorite for the 46th renewal of the Woodward. An improbable third last year at 48-1, the five-year-old has captured two of three starts on these shores this year, including a narrow half-length loss to Behrens (Pleasant Colony). Running Stag captured the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 29 in his most recent start and looms as the top choice. **Almutawakel** snared the G1 Dubai World Cup for Godolphin in March over Malek (Chi) and Victory Gallop, but finished seventh in his only start since to Royal Anthem in the GI Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 17. Back on the dirt for this outing, Godolphin's raider looks to get on course for the Breeders' Cup Classic with a good effort here. **River Keen** ships east off a second in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 29 and previously captured the GII Bel Air H. at Hollywood July 10 over **Barter Town**.

**Kayf Tara** will start at short odds to repeat last year's impressive win, where he beat **Silver Patriarch** (second) and **Enzeli** (fourth), in a small but select field. He has created a favorable impression in three of his four starts this season, his only minus being his third to **Enzeli**, when clearly not staying on unsuitably fast ground, in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at Royal Ascot June 17. Since that defeat, he has stormed to victory in the G2 Goodwood Cup July 29 and the G2 Prix Kergolay at Deauville Aug. 22, and will use this as a stepping stone to an attempt at the G1 Fosters Melbourne Cup at Flemington Park Nov. 2. **Silver Patriarch** has been in fine form all year, with the highlight being his fourth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 24. **Enzeli** is unbeaten in two starts this season, having won the Listed Saval Beg S. at Leopardstown May 19 and the 2½-mile G1 Ascot Gold Cup.

The bay filly returns to the scene of her triumph in the GI Gazelle last September. **Catinca** went to her knees at the start, but recovered to finish third last out in the GI Ballerina H. at the Spa Aug. 22. The four-year-old captured the GII Shuvee over this surface earlier this year. **Furlough** is not the most consistent sort, but rallied for third in this event last year to Sharp Cat and comes off a nose win in the Ballerina.

**WALMAC OPENS FLORIDA DIVISION** Walmac International and Hartley & DeRenzo Thoroughbreds of Ocala, Florida have joined together to form Walmac South, a new stallion venture. "Florida has a long history of producing top-quality racehorses and has had a very significant effect on the breed," said Walmac owner John T. L. Jones, Jr. "Stallions like Mr. Prospector, Fappiano, and Dr. Fager all started or stood their entire career in Florida. Skip Away, Holy Bull and Silver Charm are the most recent additions to a long list of top racehorses that are just now starting in the breeding shed. We want to be involved with and hopefully add to the success of the Florida breeding program."

**VINERY APPOINTMENTS** Vinery, LLC announced the appointment of R. Bates Newton as managing director of operations. Neil Bowden and Peter Bradley have been named co-directors. Newton has been involved with stallion syndication and management at both Lane's End Farm and Gainesway Farm. Bradley & Bowden, LLC is a Thoroughbred brokerage. Jamie LaMonica will remain as stallion manager for the farm which was recently purchased by Roselands, a European-backed farm in Australia.

**TOBA SUPPORTS NTRA CONTRIBUTIONS** The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association has given its support to a voluntary 0.1 percent contribution by auction buyers, sellers and sales companies over the next three years, as an interim funding mechanism for the National Thoroughbred Racing Association. "We are committed to the NTRA and strongly encourage all buyers and sellers to contribute to its funding program," said Daniel Metzger, president of TOBA. "The NTRA has made significant progress, especially in the areas of television and marketing and the entire industry needs to support them during this important time."

**LUCKY AGAIN** (f, 3, Wild Again--Countess Jig, by Jig Time) opened her career with two impressive sprint victories, but was not the same in a pair of two-turn efforts. Adding Lasix and dropping back to six furlongs, the gray filly dueled for the lead and was just edged at the wire in a Saratoga allowance Sept. 1. The 3-1 shot set a pressured pace, was headed by Carleaville (Carson City) in midstretch and outgamed that rival by a neck. Graded stakes winner Honest Lady (Seattle Slew), off since a seventh in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 3, finished third as the 3-5 favorite. Lifetime Record: 6-3-1-1, \$67,080.
