KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES

Aaron and Marie Jones are no strangers to picking out sales-topping yearlings. While they did not get a sales topper on Saturday, they did account for the highest price paid for the session when they went to \$725,000 for a filly by 1995 Breeders' Cup Sprint runner up Mr. Greeley out of the 10-year-old Deputy Minister mare Final Deputy. The filly was consigned by Dixiana Farm acting as agent for Stoneworth Farm. Dixiana also consigned the \$3.9 million sale topper (to date) on behalf of Harold Harrison. Another filly accounted for the afternoon's second highest price when Mr. & Mrs. Jerome Moss went to \$325,000 for a daughter of champion sprinter Cherokee Run, sire of the undefeated Chilukki from his first crop to race. Jonabell Farm, the home of the freshman sire, consigned the filly to the sale. Bidding was once again brisk as 289 horses went through the sales ring for a gross of \$14,264,700 and an average of \$49,359, up 45 percent against the average from the corresponding session in 1998. After six days of the sale, gross receipts total over \$202 million for an average of \$124,099 and a median of \$62,000, significant increases from last year. The sale continues daily through Thursday with bidding at 10 a.m. (Top 7 colts/fillies, p2)

BAFFERT'S KEEN ON NEW YORK

Used to be that Bob Baffert couldn't win a Grade I in New York. Now he can't lose one. Sure, there are Silverbulletday and Forestry, but the grey-haired wizard showed that he could pull it off even with a reformed claimer. River Keen won the 1997 GII Californian S. and appeared destined for stardom, but ultimately he bottomed out a bit and began running for high price claiming tags. Claimed for \$100,000 out of a winning effort at Hollywood Park last Dec. 4, River Keen has rounded back into form at the ripe old age of seven to win the GII Bel Air H. and run second in his last two outings, beaten six lengths by Mazel Trick in the GII San Diego H. two back and most recently three lengths behind stablemate General Challenge in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 29. Part of a foursome within two lengths of front-running Black Cash (Deposit Ticket) for the opening three quarters, River Keen slithered his way up to challenge for the lead, while Dubai World Cup champ Almutawakel took the outside route into the lane. The two rivals hooked up for a memorable final eighth of a mile, with River Keen just getting his nose down on the line first. Said Baffert, "The reason for running here was to keep River Keen away from General Challenge. River Keen showed today just how good a horse he is." A rematch of the top two is expected in the Oct. 10 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup.

Godolphin's aim was to win 15 Group 1 races worldwide this year and Kayf Tara enabled the team in blue to reach its target with plenty of time to spare. Winner of three of his four previous starts this season, his only blemish came on unsuitably fast ground in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup in June, when finishing four lengths behind Enzeli. The five-year-old won this stayers' Classic for the second year running and now goes into quarantine in preparation for the long haul to Australia for the G1 Melbourne Cup at Flemington Nov. 2. Racing in second until over three furlongs out, Kayf Tara swept into the lead and was closely pursued by Yavana's Pace, while Enzeli and Silver Patriarch were left foundering a long way behind. Yavana's Pace briefly threatened, but while Kayf Tara raced straight down the center of the track, Yavana's Pace drifted over to the stands rail and could never get in a serious blow on the leader, who came home alone for an easy win. Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford said, "The horse is ready mentally and physically for Melbourne." Jockey Frankie Dettori added, "Kayf Tara is even better than last year, he has won pushed out without me having to give him a smack."

Catinca finally got her first Grade I win after a thrilling stretch duel with Furlough. The dark bay went to her knees at the start of the GI Ballerina Aug. 22, but still managed to rally for third behind Furlough that day. Breaking smoothly today, Catinca stalked the early pace and made a wide move on the turn, while Furlough, conversely, hugged the rail throughout. The two arrived at the top of the lane together and raced inseparably to the wire with Catinca prevailing. "We were lucky we had an outside post," said winning trainer John Kimmel. "He (jockey Bailey) tracked the speed on the outside, which was a good place to be today. We'll look to stretch her out a mile and an eighth in the Beldame (GI, \$500,000, Oct. 10). We'll have to decide if we want to chase the Breeders' Cup dream or not." Shug McGaughey, trainer of the runner-up, commented, "She got good like this last fall. I might just train her up to the Breeders' Cup."

A possible attempt at the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp Oct 10. is in the cards for Giant's Causeway, having accounted for a top-class field in highly impressive style. Continuing the good form he showed when scoring in the G3 Futurity S. at The Curragh Aug. 29, Giant's Causeway led from flagfall, at a strong pace, in advance of Bachir and Valentino (Nureyev), as Race Leader and Grigorovich (Nureyev) raced at the rear. Michael Kinane sent Giant's Causeway into a clear lead entering the final quarter and with minimal encouragement, Giant's Causeway strode away to an easy success despite a tendency to change leads on several occasions. Race Leader kept on well enough to be the clear second, but was a class below the winner, while Bachir proved best of the remainder. Winning owner Michael Tabor said, "We have always thought a lot of this colt. With the long straight here at Longchamp and for him to have led all the way is a good performance. I think he will have no problem staying further in the future."

Doneraile Court put up a career-best effort to outgame Vicar in the stretch on photo-finish day at Belmont. After finishing fifth to Vicar's fourth in the GI King's Bishop at Saratoga Aug. 28, the dark bay colt returned to his favorite track, where he is four-for-six lifetime. Off alertly, the \$1 million yearling raced with the pace while outside then rallied while still wide on the turn. Hooking up with Vicar at the top of the stretch, Doneraile Court prevailed narrowly under a stiff drive. "This horse is a miler and he definitely loves Belmont Park, He beat a good colt in Vicar," said winning trainer Nick Zito. "We're going to hang around New York and the Cigar Mile (GI, \$350,000, Aqueduct, Nov. 27) is our main goal." Vicar put forth a valiant effort despite jockey Pat Day dropping his whip in midstretch. "It was a superb effort today," said trainer Carl Nafzger. "We're going to point him to the Breeders' Cup Sprint (GI, \$1,000,000, Nov. 6)."

With consistent form all season and an excellent second to Dubai Millennium (GB) in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 18 on his last start, State Shinto was afforded a patient ride close to the pace and stayed on in good style to win comfortably. The British-trained challenger Manndar was sent into the lead and raced two lengths clear of Way of Light and State Shinto, with the only other runner, Raucous Lad, settled in last. State Shinto was soon moved up to second and tracked Manndar, traveling sweetly, but was ridden soon after straightening for home. He joined Manndar at the two-furlong marker and was not asked for a decisive effort until approaching the final furlong. He was eventually sent to the lead at the distance and stayed on well all the way to the line for a deserved success.

Aug. 20 to Poteen (Ire). Breaking from the rail, the chestnut quickly assumed command, with eventual runner up Special Quest hounding him throughout. Kirkwall, equipped with blinkers for the first time, shook loose to lead by 1 1/2 lengths at the furlong maker, then dug deep in the waning yards to hold Special Quest safe. Odds on favorite Majorien could do no better than fifth. Said winning rider Victor Espinoza, "The blinkers helped, but the slow pace helped more. He relaxed pretty good today and I tried to slow him down as much as I could. He finished strong.

WRITERS UP

AT THE SALES ... with Bill Oppenheim

With a 40-percent rise in average in Keeneland's Books 1-2 (Mon-Thu), it has generally been a very good year for the stallions having their first yearlings sell (as well as nearly everybody else). Among 13 first-year sires who had seven or more yearlings catalogued in Books 1-2, here is how things stood at close of business Thursday, including all yearlings sold through Saratoga plus September Books 1-2 (unofficial figures): 1--Unbridled's Song (23 for an average of \$285,956), finally repeating his placing ahead of Hennessy from the 1995 Breeders' Cup Juvenile (though helped by his rival already having more yearlings sold than many horses used to have in their entire first crop). 2--Hennessy (50, \$276,940)-- these two well clear. The next six are bunched fairly closely: 3--Gold Fever (8, \$153,000); 4--Smart Strike (18, \$148,222); 5--Roar (12, \$141,167); 6--Forest Wildcat (28, \$137,821); 7--Grindstone (16, \$126,875); 8--Honour and Glory (33, \$117,242). You get the idea. There are some good returns on investment there. Continuing there are: 9--Our Emblem (9, \$88,500); 10--Peaks and Valleys (21, \$82,619); 11--Afternoon Delites (20, \$80,725). Trailing were: 12--Candy Stripes (14, \$34,531); 13. Lit de Justice (15, \$32,467). These results are through Thursday only so averages will probably drop in most cases. Among those with fewer than seven catalogued in Books 1-2, a Cobra King sold for \$450,000, and six yearlings by Torrential brought an average over \$100,000.

On the whole, it seems as though many stud fees will not rise again, which is an altogether good thing. Of course, it is justified in some cases. Kingmambo, who now looks one of the best, if not the best young sire in Kentucky, is trading at \$75,000 to \$80,000 no guarantee, for example. A horse like Cobra King, who has huge returns for a \$5,000 stalion, goes to \$7,500. These seem fair enough, but on the whole stud fees need to essentially hold rather than rise.

You remember we talked about Sheikh Mohammed buying 25 yearlings in Book 1. Here is how they break down by sire line: 5--Northern Dancer; 6--Mr. Prospector: 3--non-Phalaris: and 11 Hail to Reason (10 Roberto + 1 Southern Halo)! Does that signal a new trend? Maybe, maybe not (will there be sons of Silver Hawk, Kris S., Red Ransom, etc. who will carry on?), but it's pretty interesting that 44 percent of their buys were Hail to Reason.

Are Storm Cat and Forty Niner yet so convincing as sires of sires? One swallow does not a summer make, as they say. Sure, Storm Boot is good, and Harlan was going to be...the rest are just very popular so far. Not that they won't, just that the evidence thus far isn't that overwhelming, at least in this observer's view.
