### **RECORDS SHATTERED AS KEENELAND SALE CONCLUDES**

A total of \$233,075,800 changed hands during the just-concluded 11-day Keeneland September Sale, the most money in any yearling sale ever. The old mark had been \$175,932,000, set at Keeneland's two-day 1984 July Selected Sales, while the September Sale record had been last year's \$169,811,800. The average of \$77,357 was up a whopping 30.3 percent from last year's \$59,375, which had itself been a record. A total of 23 horses brought \$1 million or more, six more than in all the previous September Sales combined, topped by the \$3.9 million Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum paid for a colt by Kris S.-Mr. P's Princess, by Mr. Prospector. The sale record for a filly also fell after Demi O'Byrne went to \$2 million for a daughter of Storm Cat-Piquetnol, by Private Account. Thursday's final session was topped by a \$155,000 colt by Fast Play-Sistine Chapel, by El Gran Senor, who was bought by the Merv Griffin Ranch Company.

### INAUGURAL INFIELD FESTIVAL HIGHLIGHTS KENTUCKY CUP

For the first time in its history, Turfway Park will open up its infield during a live racing program for the inaugural Kentucky Cup Infield Festival. The main attraction of the day will be continuous live music by three bands, running straight through the day and into the evening. Three 1998 Kentucky Cup winners went on to finish first or second in the Breeders' Cup: Reraise (Danzatore), who won the Kentucky Cup Sprint by 12 lengths before going on to a win in the Breeders' Cup Sprint and an Eclipse Award; Kentucky Cup Juvenile champion Aly's Alley (Alwuhush), second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile; and Silver Charm, second in the Breeders' Cup Classic.

Offered up at Goffs Orby Sale last October, Petrushka was knocked down for Ir110,000 guineas.
