ART, NOT CRAFT, IN VOSBURGH

Crafty Friend (Crafty Prospector) was the 4-5 chalk in yesterday's GI Vosburgh S. at Belmont Park, but he chased 4-1 Artax (Marquetry) through a half in :44.69 and tired to be fifth as the pacesetter went on to a convincing 3 1/2-length score. The winner of the GI Carter H. back in May, Artax then ran into fan interference, finishing fifth after narrowly avoiding a man on the track in the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. May 15. He was second or third in his next four starts, all graded sprint stakes, but ran an even fifth in the Sept. 6 GII Forego H. last out. "The whole game with him is the break," owner Ernie Paragallo said. "If he breaks, they can't beat him." A slight hesitation at the start yesterday didn't cost him. "He broke a little slow, but he recovered pretty fast," winning jockey Jorge Chavez said. "I knew we were setting fast fractions, but I didn't want to fight him...he's a tough horse to ride. He dug in today and proved he's one of the best sprinters in the country." Crafty Friend was looking for his third straight graded-stakes win at seven furlongs after taking the July 4 GII Tom Fool H. and Sept. 6 GII Forego H., but couldn't run back to those efforts. "He just was totally flat today," jockey Gary Stevens said. "He was real lethargic before the race and he was empty when I called on him. I think he ran too fast in his last race."

ASCOT'S GROUP ONE RACES RESCHEDULED

The G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. and the G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile were rained out yesterday, but could be run at Ascot this afternoon if conditions allow. Ascot officials, who scrapped Saturday's program after heavy morning rains turned the course into a quagmire, will hold another inspection at 7 a.m. today. A dry afternoon left a chance that the expanded nine-race card, with the two Group 1s from yesterday added, can go ahead. The Fillies Mile and the Queen Elizabeth II are scheduled to run at 1:05 and 1:35 p.m., respectively. Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne said, "The course is drying out well and, providing there is no significant overnight rain, we are hopeful that racing can go ahead." If racing is called off once again, the two Group 1 events may be reopened for entries and moved to Newmarket Tuesday. That may be good news for The Aga Khan's Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo). Europe's top miler skipped the Queen Elizabeth II to avoid the heavy going, but will be entered if the race is rescheduled for Tuesday. "If the QE II is to take place at Newmarket, and if the ground conditions are suitable, then Sendawar will travel to take his chance," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said. "The horse is in tremendous condition and I am keen to run him, but only if the conditions are not against him." Sendawar has won three straight Group1 races going a mile at Longchamp and would be making his first foray outside of France. "I don't think that the straight mile (at Newmarket) will prove a problem," de Royer-Dupre said.

Da Devil had scored in back-to-back allowance races at Ellis Park, winning on turf in July and on dirt in August, but failed to threaten in a pair of subsequent stakes starts, most recently running fifth in the prep for this race, the Sept. 11 GIII Kentucky Cup Classic Preview H. Understandably ignored this time, the outsider trailed the field for a half, swept six wide around the far turn to catch the front runners, opened up a clear lead in midstretch and held on as Social Charter came back at him in the closing yards. "I told (jockey Calvin Borel) the only shot we've got is if you take him back," trainer Forrest Kaelin said. "I said, 'We can't go with these horses. Let's hope they burn themselves out--it's the only shot we've got." Favored Cat Thief won the July 18 GI Swaps S. and missed by a half length when second in the Aug. 8 GI Haskell Invitational, but was a tiring seventh in his latest, the Aug. 28 Gl Travers. The three-year-old set the pace, lost the lead at the top of the lane, but continued on gamely to the wire.

With the Flow, who started his career in France, had won half his eight career starts, including the G3 Prix de Fountainebleu Apr. 19, 1998. A badly blocked fourth in his U.S. debut, the GII Jamaica H. last Oct. 18, he was given a rest until Mar. 6, when he was dropped into the allowance ranks, ran fourth and was sidelined for another three months. He came back to win a June 4 Belmont allowance, but had not been out since finishing third as the overwhelming favorite in an allowance over that course June 30. Vergennes (Dynaformer) set the early pace, with With the Flow and jockey Jose Santos on his flanks. Santos asked for run entering the stretch and his mount responded, drawing clear inside the eighth pole and digging in to repel the late challenge of Comic Strip. "He came back a little sore from his last race and that's why he has been off," trainer Christophe Clement said. "I had him ready to run, but the ground wasn't to his liking. This horse needs turf with some give in it to run at his best." Tangazi (Jade Hunter), the 3-2 favorite, was shut off in the stretch, had to be checked sharply and ended up sixth.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races. Successful Appeal, somewhat overlooked in the wagering due to the presence of speedball Five Star Day, rallied from just off the pace to capture his third graded stakes of the year. Winner of the GII Withers S. over a mile at Aqueduct May 1, the dark bay tried a route several more times without finding the winner's circle, including a third to Forestry and Doneraile Court in the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont July 11. Shortened up, the Florida bred strong-armed a nice field in the GIII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga going six furlongs and, in his most recent start, chased a hot pace in the GI King's Bishop Aug. 28 before finishing gamely for third behind Forestry and Five Star Day. Breaking well here, he raced forwardly while outside as 3-5 Five Star Day, pressed by Freespool (Geiger Counter), went through fractions of :21 2/5, and :44 4/5, moved to challenge that rival five wide into the stretch and kicked clear for a daylight win. "I wanted to be a little farther back, but he went to the leaders on his own," winning jockey Edgar Prado said. "He took the lead early in the stretch and I hadn't even asked him. He found another gear and went right past them." Plans for the winner have not been announced, but Five Star Day will make his next start in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Gulfstream Park. "(Freespool) kept pressing him and wouldn't let him get away and he got a little bit tired," jockey Alex Solis said of the runner-up. "But my colt is maturing with every start and I'm not the least bit disappointed in him. He's right on schedule for the Breeders' Cup."

Runners from Germany, France, England and even Slovakia feature in Germany's end of season middledistance feature, but the absence of top older horses Tiger Hill (Ire) and Ungaro (Ger) somewhat diminishes the event. However Germany's three leading members of this year's Classic generation, Belenus, Hibiscus and Sumitas, are in the field. Belenus won the G1 BMW Deutsches Derby July 4 and followed with an easy fivelength success in the G1 BMW Europachampionat in early August, but then could manage only third behind Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe contenders Tiger Hill and Flamingo Road (Ger) in the G1 Mercedes-Benz Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 5, when Sumitas was fourth. Hibiscus was sixth in the Derby after two straight Listed victories, but bounced back with a good win in the G3 Furstenberg-Rennen at Baden-Baden Aug. 29. Sumitas was rated the leading three-year-old male after winning the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) in mid-May, but has been beaten in his last four starts. English-trained filly Silver Rhapsody looks the best of the overseas contingent after being placed in four straight group races, including a third to Craigsteel (GB) in the the G2 Princess Of Wales' S. at Newmarket in early July and a good third to dual Oaks heroine Ramruma in the G1 Aston Upthorpe Yorkshire Oaks at York Aug. 18 on her most recent run.

Cool Ashlee is undefeated in her two starts, breaking her maiden at Woodbine in August, then shipping south of the border to score by eight lengths in the Sept. 6 Critical Miss S. at Philadelphia Park. The Kentucky-bred filly stretches out beyond six furlongs for the first time. Hello Seattle makes her stakes debut after only one outing, but that was a 12-length romp over Woodbine maidens at seven furlongs Sept. 4. Golden Path is the most experienced of this group. The dark bay makes her seventh start after taking the Sept. 6 Muskoka S. going seven furlongs at Woodbine last time out.

Best Of The Bests caused a surprise when winning at odds of 20-1 in the G3 Solario S. at Sandown Aug. 20, but the manner of his win was such that his starting price was something of an insult. He had previously finished third to leading G1 2000 Guineas fancy Distant Music in a maiden event at Doncaster July 28 and so had the form to merit more respect than was afforded him. Royal Kingdom, the standard bearer of the Aidan O'Brien stable, was an 11th-hour withdrawal from last week's G1 National S, at The Curragh. He is unbeaten in two starts to date and was impressive when scoring in the Listed Flame Of Tara Tyros S. at The Curragh Aug. 14. Chinatown would be a poignant winner and represents one of the last opportunities for the Robert Sangster/Peter Chapple-Hyam axis to record a group win before the trainer's imminent departure for Hong Kong. The colt was third in a maiden race at Haydock Aug. 6, but showed marked improvement to break his maiden on his next start at Newcastle Aug. 30.

The ability to handle testing conditions is a necessary qualification and the likes of Warningford, Vision Of Night and Tomba fall into that category. Warningford revels in muddy conditions and has finished first or second, in equal measures, in each of his six races this season. Off since finishing second in the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot at Longchamp June 27, he just missed on his return, getting caught on the line when second in the Listed Dubai Airport World Trophy at Newbury Sept. 19, where Tomba was an encouraging third. Vision Of Night was a battling winner in the G3 Prix de Meautry at Deauville Aug. 29 and had previously finished fourth in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at the same track Aug. 8. Tomba, winner of last year's G1 Prix de la Foret on heavy ground, seeks his first group win of the season and has a penchant for testing conditions. Before his third last week he was a respectable sixth in the G1 Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup.

"The other horse just ran better today, that's all." Hickey has not committed to a future plan for Buck's Boy. The winner will go next in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine Oct. 17.
