MILLENNIUM CELEBRATION AT ASCOT

Yesterday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot was stamped firmly by the presence of one horse alone, **Dubai Millennium (GB)** (Seeking the Gold). Godolphin's colt put the disappointment of being unplaced in the G1 Epsom Derby behind him when he stormed home in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 18 and then made light task of the Aug. 15 G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois, taking advantage of the absence of **Sendawar (Ire)** (Priolo). With the heavy ground once again keeping Sendawar away, Dubai Millennium had no equal. He was fastest away from the stalls, but it was Pat Eddery on **Gold Academy (Ire)** (Royal Academy) who made the running for as long as Frankie Dettori allowed him to. With two furlongs remaining, Dettori gave Dubai Millennium full license to go and he responded with a flourish that took him six lengths clear of **Almushtarak (Ire)** (Fairy King). "I think this horse is the best we have ever had at Godolphin," said Sheikh Mohammed. "We have always thought he was very, very good and he was just a baby when he disappointed in the Derby. He will be an even better horse on better ground, he is outstanding. That will be it for the year and we will take him back to Dubai for the World Cup and then bring him back to England after that."

TEGGIANO TAKES FILLIES' MILE

Teggiano (Ire) (Mujtahid) hinted that she might be a filly with a bright future when she followed up a win in a Newbury maiden Aug. 13 with a smooth success in the G3 May Hill S. at Doncaster Sept. 9, a performance that led to 16-1 quotes for next year's G1 1000 Guineas. In yesterday's G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile S., she had to struggle a bit to cope with the heavy ground, but got on top at the end, outbattling the game **Britannia** (Sea Hero) in the final strides. Only Britannia, Teggiano, and **My Hansel** (Hansel) were in the front line two furlongs out, but it was Ray Cochrane who was controlling the race on Britannia. When he went for everything inside the final furlong, the only horse in pursuit was the winner. Frankie Dettori pushed her out and she extended in good style, going past Britannia. **Issey Rose** (Bigstone {Ire}) finished fast and caught the eye, but she was denied third by a short head by My Hansel. "The one thing about Teggiano is that she really has a heart and that is why she won today," said trainer Clive Brittain. "I had to be worried about the ground, as going as heavy as this is unknown territory for all of them and I thought it might beat her. I'm sure she'll stay the Oaks trip next year and she has plenty of speed for the 1000 Guineas."

The form of the German Derby was maintained after a tremendous duel between Belenus and Hibiscus, who finished first and sixth in the Hamburg Classic July 4. On that occasion, there were 10 lengths between them, but it was a nod of the head which decided this contest. Saugerties (Tremolino) set a steady pace for stable companion Sumitas (Lomitas {GB}), with the pair pursued by Silver Rhapsody (Silver Hawk). The latter took the lead briefly early in the straight, only to be swallowed up in a few strides by the cruising Sumitas, who looked the probable winner. Once again, however, the German 2000 Guineas winner's stamina ran out, and Hibiscus quickened smartly to grab the lead, pursued by Belenus. Hibiscus ran on bravely, but jockey Kevin Woodburn conjured a great finish out of Belenus, who caught his rival on the line to land his fifth win in eight starts this season and become German racing's newest millionaire.

Hello Seattle said goodbye to an overmatched group of local maidens when taking a seven-furlong event Sept. 4 by a handy 12 lengths as the 3-10 favorite. Thrust not surprisingly into stakes company for the first time, the homebred was made the 9-10 chalk to remain undefeated in her first attempt at a route of ground. The chestnut broke alertly and attended the pace while three wide into the clubhouse turn. Jockey Robert Landry cut his filly loose around the far turn and she was kept under left-handed urging while widening her margin down the lane. "She's such a tremendous filly, she scares me," Landry said. "She has moved forward leaps and bounds since her last race." Trainer Mark Frostad said his filly could be Breeders' Cup bound.

With a masterful ride from Michael Kinane here, Royal Kingdom became trainer Aidan O'Brien's 50th two-year-old winner of the season. The race was run at a searching pace set by Kingsclere, with Royal Kingdom in second. The winner took command inside the last quarter-mile, but Best of the Bests soon made his challenge. The runner-up looked as if he had Royal Kingdom's measure as they toughed it out, but Kinane managed to forge his way back in front inside the final furlong.

The photo confirmed that Bold Edge had prevailed by the shortest of margins. "He has always been one of my favorite horses," said trainer Richard Hannon. "I honestly fancied my other runner [Sampower Star] more, but when Bold Edge gets in front, he is hard to get past. He is already booked for a stallion job, and will be taking over from his father Beveled at Newbury next year."

Gritty Sandie earned his maiden win only two starts back, taking an Aug. 23 Saratoga allowance by seven lengths, before running second in a Sept. 2 allowance. The chestnut gelding was allowed to settle in the early going, moved up nearing the stretch and charged to the lead late. "The key factor was that the distance was in his corner this afternoon," said winning trainer James Toner. "I told (jockey) Mike (Smith) to ride him all the way. You can't allow this horse to relax at all. As for his future, I haven't given any thought to that beyond this race." Smith added, "Jimmy's done great work with this horse and we figured he'd love a mile and a half. We had a good trip and I swung him out at the right time. This horse can run all day."

Third choice to earn his first graded stakes victory, the dark bay pressed the pace before forging to the lead leaving the backstretch and drew off to the wire. "He relaxed so good today," commented winning rider Roberto Gonzalez. "He was just galloping behind that horse. I gave him his head at the three-eighths pole to let him open up a little bit because I wanted to be able to give him a little breather at the quarter pole. He got a little breather and when I asked him, he changed leads and opened up three lengths. I knew somebody would really have to fly to catch him."

DAYLAMI CONFIRMED AS ARC RUNNER

Godolpin yesterday declared **Daylami (Ire)** (Doyoun {Ire}) as a runner in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 3 at Longchamp. He is the 2-1 second choice, and **Montjeu (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) is the 13-8 favorite, with **Victor Chandler On Course**. Racing manager Simon Crisford said, "We will see how he runs in the Arc and then decide on the Breeders' Cup Turf or Japan Cup--it would be very difficult to run in both." Crisford confirmed that Daylami will retire at the end of the year to the Gilltown Stud of his breeder the Aga Khan, who has retained some shares.

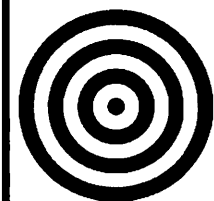
