TATTERSALLS HOUGHTON OPENS TODAY

All eyes will be on Newmarket this evening as the Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sales get underway at 5:15 p.m. Just days after the close of a phenomenally strong September Sales at Keeneland, and on the back of other record yearling auctions this year, expectations for the Houghton are high. The wealth of high-class pedigrees does not make picking out the stars easy-there are 28 full or half brothers and sisters to Group 1 winners. The first point of note is that champion sire Sadler's Wells accounts for 27 of the 260-strong catalogue, although three of these have been withdrawn. Among those still in the sale are Lot 148, a half brother to the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup winner Iktamal (Danzig Connection), and Lot 234, a half sister to the dual Group 1-winning juvenile Danehill Dancer (Ire) (Danehill). Ted Voute, agent for Fittocks Stud, sells a Sadler's Wells colt out of Group 3 winner Kithanga (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) as Lot 207. Voute is also the consignor of Lot 17, a Gone West filly who is the first foal of the G1 Irish Oaks winner Pure Grain (GB) (Polish Precedent). Offerings from Meon Valley Stud are often among the most sought after, and the Hampshire nursery sells Lot 3, a Mtoto (GB) colt who will receive a timely boost if his half-brother Pissaro (GB) (Green Desert) maintains the family record set by Maidaan (GB) (Midyan) last year by winning today's Tattersalls Houghton Sales race. Meon Valley also offers Lot 80, a half-sister from the first crop of Ashkalani (Ire) to this year's G1 Oaks runner-up Noushkey (GB) (Polish Precedent). Woodcote Stud consigns Lot 150, a Darshaan (GB) half brother to eight winners, including G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine Danseuse Du Soir (Ire) (Thatching {Ire}). New England Stud offers a rare opportunity to buy a Derby winner's half brother in Lot 194, an Inchinor (GB) colt whose older half-brother High-Rise (Ire) (High Estate {Ire}) won the Epsom Classic last year. Two of the most expensive of those to have been sold as foals are Lot 47, a Sadler's Wells colt out of a half-sister to Pentire (GB) (Be My Guest) who realized 430,000 guineas at Tattersalls last year, and a colt bought for \$650,000 at last year's Keeneland November Sales, Lot 117, a Rainbow Quest half brother to the 1991 G1 Oaks winner Jet Ski Lady (Vaguely Noble {GB}). Bidding begins tomorrow at 2:30 p.m.; Thursday's final session starts at 5:15 p.m.

CHEVELEY PARK A CHAMPIONSHIP TEST

Today's G1 Shadwell Stud Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket will go some way to determining the pecking order of juvenile fillies come the end of the season, and the quality of this year's renewal does not disappoint. Torgau (Ire) (Zieten), who makes her final European start here, is already high up the list. A fine second to Preseli (Ire) over seven furlongs in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh Sept. 5, she drops back in distance and can boast sound form at the trip, having already won the G2 Cherry Hinton S., with Forever Midnight (Ire) (Night Shift) fifth, over today's course and distance July 6. Torgau will head to America after the race, where she will be trained in California by Jenine Sahadi. A win in the Cheveley Park could earn her a trip to the Breeders' Cup. Moon Driver (Mr. Prospector), one of two French-trained challengers, is a beautifully bred individual and has had this race as her target for quite a while. She prepared for this with a highly impressive win in the G3 Prix d'Arenberg at Chantilly Sept. 8, where she beat the useful yardstick Harbour Island (Fr) and Criquette Head's Mall Queen (Sheikh Albadou {GB}). Head has a fine record in this race, having won with Ma Biche in 1982, Ravinella in 1987 and Pas de Reponse in 1996. Warrior Queen (Quiet American) got back to winning ways when scoring in the Listed Round Tower S. at The Curragh Sept. 5, and had previously done herself no favors when a hard-pulling eighth to Jemima (GB) (Owington {GB}) in the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug 19. That run is best ignored, as a decent pace is virtually assured and she represents the powerful Aidan O'Brien team, who have already scored a half-century of juvenile wins this season. Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern) is held in high regard by her trainer Clive Brittain, who saddled Teggiano (Ire) to win Sunday's G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile at Ascot. CROCO ROUGE IMPRESSES IN FINAL WORK:

Four-year-old colt Croco Rouge (Ire) (Rainbow Quest), owned by the Wafic Said/Irish National Stud partnership and trained at Chantilly by Pascal Bary, did his last piece of serious work before Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe-Lucien Barriere at Longchamp when covering 1 1/4 miles with three lead horses on the Les Aigles course at Chantilly Monday. Fourth in last year's Arc and winner of this season's G1 Prix d'Ispahan in May, defeating the Japanese champion El Condor Pasa (Kingmambo), Croco Rouge delighted his trainer, who said, "It was an easy, routine piece of work as the horse is ready for Sunday and doesn't need much. He won his gallop this morning, which was expected, but it is more important to win on Sunday. We go into the race knowing that we have a horse in top form. He loves Longchamp, where he has won his two Group 1 races [the other being last year's Prix Lupin] and he ran a superb race in the Arc last year, also on soft ground. We can only cross our fingers." Thierry Jarnet, who was on board Croco Rouge in the Prix d'Ispahan, maintains his partnership with the horse Sunday.

MONTJEU ON TRACK FOR ARC:

Trainer John Hammond yesterday reported Michael Tabor's dual Derby winner Montjeu (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) fit and well for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp on Sunday. "I haven't done much with him over the weekend, but he's fine and on course for the race," Hammond said. "I'm not worried about the ground--he goes on the soft. It's very exciting so let's just hope we get him there in one piece."

BIENAMADO AND DREAM WELL UNDECIDED:

Bienamado (Bien Bien) and Dream Well (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) may miss the Arc. Peter Chapple-Hyam, trainer of Bienamado, said, "He's in good form, but if it gets too soft then he's not a certain runner. I'll wait until Wednesday before making a decision, but if he runs Richard Hughes will ride." Trainer Pascal Bary said that it was "50-50" whether Dream Well would run, with the GI Turf Classic at Belmont Oct. 9 an alternative. The Longchamp going is currently soft.

"I learned a lot in the last race [a 13th-place finish in the Hakodate Sansai S.]," said jockey Naoto Ito. "So I didn't want to move on our own and I put him in mid-position on the rail. He showed a good turn of foot in the stretch."

Thanks to such as Awesome Again, Touch Gold and Deputy Commander, Deputy Minister dominated the leading sires' list in 1997 and 1998, but the retirement of these high earners seemed to have left the champion sire's cupboard somewhat bare this year. While his son Silver Deputy has been doing his best to prevent Storm Cat running away with the champion sire title, Deputy Minister experienced a severe drought at the stakes level, failing to come up with a single stakes winner throughout the first eight months of the year.

However, it's said that you can't keep a good man down, and the same applies to stallions of Deputy Minister's considerable talents. Sept. 8 saw his son Forest Camp coast home a very impressive winner over Dixie Union in the GII Del Mar Futurity and now a second unbeaten Deputy Minister two-year-old, Hello Seattle, has also recorded a scintillating victory at stakes level, this time a 14-length romp in the GI Mazarine Breeders' Cup S. Sunday.

With another Deputy Minister filly, Darling My Darling, finishing a good second to Finder's Fee in the GI Matron S. on Sept. 19, it seems that a whole new wave of potential stars is poised to put Deputy Minister back among the leading sires before too long.

Hello Seattle has every right to develop into yet another champion for her owner/breeder, Sam-Son Farms. Not only is she by a champion sire, but she is out of a mare, Seattle Classic, with a very special pedigree.

Seattle Classic's sire Seattle Slew won the Triple Crown and her dam Classy 'n Smart produced Dance Smartly, a brilliant performer who in 1991 became the first filly to win the Canadian Triple Crown. The three-year-old Dance Smartly also took the Breeders' Cup Distaff and the Molson Export Million, plus an Eclipse Award and the title of Canada's Horse of the Year.

This family has enjoyed such widespread success in recent years that I hardly need go into great detail. Dance Smartly is a half sister to Smart Strike, a Grade I-winning son of Mr. Prospector who commands a fee of \$30,000, and their dam Classy 'n Smart landed the title of Canada's champion three-year-old filly in 1984. Classy 'n Smart preceded Grey Classic, Regal Classic and Sky Classic as the first of four Canadian champions produced by the exceptional Nodouble mare No Class.

Sons and grandsons of Northern Dancer play a significant role in the success story of this magnificent female line. Danzig sired Dance Smartly, while Nijinsky II was responsible for Sky Classic, who followed Dance Smartly's example by winning an Eclipse Award for his efforts outside Canada.

More to the point, Regal Classic and his very talented sister Classic Reign were by Vice Regent, the Northern Dancer stallion also responsible for Deputy Minister. Although Regal Classic was at his most successful as a juvenile, when he won four stakes races at up to nine furlongs, he trained on well enough to win one leg of the Canadian Triple Crown, the Prince of Wales S., and to finish second in another, the Queen's Plate. As Classy Reign was second in the other leg, the Breeders' S., this pair established that they stayed reasonably well, as did Dance Smartly and Sky Classic.

Hello Seattle isn't the first major winner sired by Deputy Minister from this family. His mating with No Class resulted in Always A Classic, a very late foal who developed into a very good turf performer at around nine furlongs as a four-year-old in 1997, when his victories included the GI Early Times Turf Classic S. Shortage of stamina is clearly not going to be a problem for Hello Seattle, and neither is lack of talent judging by her exciting display at Woodbine.
