CAN MENIFEE MASTER A MILE AND A QUARTER?

He has been close in his two attempts at the distance, but Menifee (Harlan) has yet to win at a mile and a quarter. That won't stop him from being the favorite in today's \$500,000 GI Super Derby going 10 furlongs at Louisiana Downs. The colt, winner of the GI Toyota Blue Grass and GI Haskell Invitational at a mile and an eighth, missed by a neck running the Classic distance in the GI Kentucky Derby. He was most recently third, beaten 2 1/2 lengths, in the GI Travers at that route. "I wouldn't say he can't win at a mile and a quarter because he almost won the best three-year-old race in the country and he was flying at the end," trainer Elliott Walden said. But he added, "If I could make the Breeders' Cup Classic or the Super Derby a mile and an eighth, I might do that for Menifee." The fact is, none of the horses in the Super Derby field have won at a mile and a quarter. Menifee's stablemate, Ecton Park (Forty Niner), has tried it twice and finished off the board both times, running fourth in the Travers last time out. Last year's champion two-year-old Answer Lively (Lively One), winless since taking the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, was 10th in the Kentucky Derby. He was freshened after that test, coming back to be second after setting the pace in the Sept. 5 Remington Park Derby. "I think our colt has bounced right back from his race at Remington," trainer Bobby Barnett said. "He's come back and worked well and I think he's going to run a dynamite race." Remington Park Derby winner Temperence Time (Temperence Hill), who was trying his longest distance to date in that nine-furlong event, will attempt to follow in the hoofsteps of his father, winner of the 1980 Super Derby. He is a perfect two-for-two with blinkers off.

Short Field for Arc:

With 14 set to start, the field for the 1999 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe will be the joint lowest since Trempolino won in 1987, and it could become shorter still. The connections of Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) have expressed concern regarding the persistent rain in the Paris area and his participation hinges on a course inspection by Team Godolphin today. Conditions at Longchamp are currently very testing, with a 5.0 penetrometer reading--the equivalent to heavy ground in Britain--and there is rain forecast. Simon Crisford, Godolphin's racing manager, said yesterday, "It is true to say we are very concerned about the state of the ground and with the weather forecast from tonight through the weekend looking particularly bleak with rain predicted, it does raise some questions. But as we speak right now, Daylami is an intended runner in the race. He will travel tomorrow and we are hoping he will run, but we reserve the right to pull him out. We know he goes on soft ground, but this is worse than soft ground." Trainer Sir Michael Stoute is less concerned about conditions for Greek Dance (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), but he feels the ground may not suit Fantastic Light (Rahy). "Greek Dance's preparation has gone well," he said. "He went on good to soft ground at Haydock, but this will be heavy so we will just have to hope he will handle that type of ground. They either handle it or they don't. Fantastic Light has won on soft ground, but I would prefer him on good to firm ground."

Yellow Ribbon S. cont.

Eclipse Award winner Fiji makes her first start since taking the 1998 Yellow Ribbon, her sixth win from seven starts last season. The five-year-old has been beset by a series of minor problems since. "In the spring she pulled a muscle in the rear," trainer Neil Drysdale explained. "Then she got a dirty throat at the beginning of Del Mar. She's training well, but of course she could get a little tired. She may not be right on top of it." The champ is a perfect three-for-three at the Yellow Ribbon distance. Tuzla won four in a row, including a victory over the boys in the GII San Francisco Mile in April, before running second in the GIII Palomar H. at Del Mar, but bounced back to win the Sept. 4 GI Ramona H. She has tried a mile and a quarter just once before, running fourth in the GII E.P. Taylor H. last year. Second choice Tranquility Lake captured the Apr. 17 GII Santa Barbara H. over this course and distance, took a month and a half off, then came back to win the 1 1/8-mile GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood June 6. Second by a half length in the July 3 GI Beverly Hills H., she had another two months off before pressing the pace, then tiring to be fifth behind Tuzla in the Ramona.

Invermark bids to repeat his success in this race 12 months ago and will be confidently expected to do so as he will not have to face Kayf Tara (GB), Europe's best stayer of 1999. He was an excellent second in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup June 17 and followed up with a second behind Kayf Tara in the G2 Prix Kergolay at Deauville Aug. 22. Tajoun is perhaps the best stayer in France and presents Invermark with his biggest danger. He finished second to Kayf Tara in the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier at Longchamp May 23, but disappointed, admittedly on unsuitably fast ground, when only 17th in the Ascot Gold Cup. He made amends, however, when romping to success in the G3 Prix Gladiateur at Longchamp Sept. 5.

Considering that Zieten won the G1 Middle Park S. to round off an unbeaten juvenile campaign, and that his sister Blue Duster remained unbeaten by easily winning the fillies' equivalent, the G1 Cheveley Park S., it isn't so surprising that fillies from Zieten's second crop made such a major impact on last Tuesday's Cheveley Park. In addition to supplying Seazun, the 10-1 winner, Zieten is also responsible for Torgau, the Group 2 winner who made Seazun fight all the way to the line.

What makes this feat all the more remarkable is the smallness of the crop that produced Seazun and Torgau, as well as the winners Asturian Lady and Zietzig. Zieten stood his first season in 1995 and unfortunately proved to be one of four new stallions by Danzig which experienced difficulties that year, the others being the American pair of Lure and Furiously and the New Zealand-based Maroof. There is no escaping the seriousness of this setback now that Lure and Zieten have each managed to sire a two-year-old Group 1 winner from their limited opportunities.

Zieten started his stud career at Haras du Logis in France before moving to the Irish National Stud for the 1996 and '97 seasons. However, he covered comparatively small books during his time in Ireland and was returned to Logis, whose advertisement for Zieten in *Sires for '99* proclaimed that he was "proving that quality is better than quantity!!" He certainly remains a tempting prospect.

Seazun represents another triumph for the Burns family's Lodge Park Stud, which has also supplied the 1999 Group 1 performers Central Park, Shinko Forest and Dazzling Park. Appropriately, Seazun's pedigree includes the name of Red God, a stallion who played a starring role in Lodge Park's development. It was this temperamental son of Nasrullah who sired Folle Rousse, who became the stud's first major success by becoming Britain's champion juvenile filly in 1968.

Red God also sired the Royal Ascot two-year-old winners Greenland Park and Red Sunset from Centre Piece, one of Lodge Park's foundation mares. Seazun is out of Red Sunset's daughter Sunset Cafe, a moderate performer who won over 1 1/2 miles.

As Sunset Cafe was placed twice over 1 3/4 miles, she clearly stayed much better than Red Sunset, who never tackled more than a mile. Her brother Beeshi was also well suited by 1 1/2 miles, as he showed by winning the G3 Prix Foy, and the source of their stamina is easy to identify.

Their dam Cafe au Lait was a middle-distance winner who shared the same sire, Espresso, as the exceptional long-distance horse Sagaro. Cafe au Lait also produced the smart middle-distance horse Chaumiere to the sprinter Thatching. Sunset Cafe is the third of her daughters to produce a group winner, the others being Olderfleet, dam of the speedy Peace Girl, and Petit Eclair, whose son Insatiable has won group races in England, France and Ireland. Petit Eclair is also the second dam of Pipe Major, a good fourth in the 1995 2000 Guineas, and another of Cafe au Lait's daughters, Black Crow, is the second dam of Classic Ruler (G3 Molecomb S.).

Seazun is by no means the first very good juvenile filly from this female line. Indeed her tremendously speedy fourth dam, Star of India, earned top weight on the 1955 Free Handicap and later became the third dam of Mrs Mcardy, a 1000 Guineas winner who won her last four starts at two. This is also the family of the excellent filly Ruby Tiger, so Seazun is maintaining an excellent tradition.

Hever Golf Rose Dead:

Hever Golf Rose (GB) (Efisio {GB}), who won 17 races in five countries, died in Newmarket after failing to come around after surgery on a front leg, according to Britain's *Racing Post*. The eight-year-old mare, who retired last year, was in foal to Entrepreneur (GB). She started 66 times, winning in England, France, Germany, Italy and Sweden, and was older female champion sprinter in England, France, Germany and Italy in 1995, when she won eight stakes. Her six group wins were highlighted by the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp. Altogether, she finished in the top three in 29 stakes events. Trainer Joe Naughton told the *Racing Post*, "She was a one-off. We all thought she would have many years ahead of her, breeding racehorses that would inherit her bravery, determination and speed, but sadly that has not been the case." She was bought back as a yearling by breeder Ronald Popely for 6,000 guineas at the Doncaster St. Leger Sale in 1992 and went on to earn more than \$1 million. Popely has her only foal, a colt by Danehill.

PRECOCITY RETIRED Precocity (Aferd--Super Starlz {Super Concorde}) has been retired from racing after suffering an ankle injury, today's *Daily Racing Form* reports. The five-year-old John Franks colorbearer captured the 1998 GI Oaklawn H. In 1999, he defeated Kentucky Derby winner Real Quiet to win the GIII New Orleans H. in March. In the final start of his career, he finished fifth in the June 12 GII Stephen Foster H. Precocity retires with nine wins in 33 starts and earnings of \$1,735,796.

FAIRPLEX SEASON ENDS The 1999 racing season at Fairplex Park in Pomona, California, which ran from Sept. 9 through Sept. 26, saw total handle drop four percent from the track's record wagering of a year ago. The handle for the meet was \$104,084,856, compared to a figure of \$108,454,254 in '98. The meet's beginning was marred by tragedy when jockey J. C. Gonzalez was killed in a spill in the fifth race on opening day. At the suggestion of jockeys Danny Sorenson and Corey Black, track officials established the J. C. Gonzalez Memorial Jockey Trophy. The perpetual trophy will be presented each year to the leading Thoroughbred rider at the track. Martin Pedroza became the first recipient of the award. The 34-year-old rode 29 winners. Mel Stute and Paul Aguirre tied for the trainer's title with nine victories.
