MONTJEU EST MAGNIFIQUE!

The script for yesterday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp was written to determine who would be crowned the middle-distance champion of Europe: Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), El Condor Pasa (Kingmambo) or Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}). It was a sporting decision of the highest order by Sheikh Mohammed to allow Daylami to run on clearly unsuitable going and it was no surprise to see him play only a minor role as the race unfolded. El Condor Pasa's bold bid to lead from start to finish would have succeeded but for Montjeu, whose lightning acceleration inside the last quarter-mile took him not only from second to first, but to a European championship. El Condor Pasa set such a strong pace that Montjeu's intended rabbit, Genghis Khan (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), had to be content in second with Tiger Hill (Ire) (Danehill) third as Montjeu and Croco Rouge (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) were settled in seventh and ninth, respectively. Turning into the straight, El Condor Pasa still maintained a three-length advantage over the field, which was now headed by Tiger Hill and Greek Dance (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), as Montjeu had to check after becoming momentarily boxed in on the rail. Approaching the final quarter, Masayoshi Ebina kicked El Condor Pasa into a seemingly insurmountable four-length lead as Montjeu, having been extricated from his situation on the rail, gave chase with Croco Rouge traveling well on the outside. "I did not think he [Montjeu] would catch El Condor Pasa when that horse went so far clear after turning for home," said winning trainer John Hammond. El Condor Pasa's advantage had been reduced to two lengths by Montjeu by the furlong marker and Mick Kinane's repeated urgings began to pay dividends as Montjeu got on terms in the last half-furlong. His momentum carried him to the lead in the last 50 yards and he crossed the line to rapturous applause. Kinane said, "I had to be patient because I had Richard Quinn [aboard Leggera (Ire) (Sadler's Wells)] on my outside and he was entitled to hold his ground...but I wasn't patient for long, and once I got into the clear, I was always confident that I was going to pick him [El Condor Pasa] up. [Montjeu] showed amazing acceleration, he has the acceleration of a miler really, but you are always worried when the going gets this heavy it might blunt their speed." (Chart P. 2)

SOARING SOFTLY SPRINTS TO VICTORY

Soaring Softly (Kris S.) sashayed through her first five turf starts, capping the quintet with a 5 1/2-length romp in the May 31 GII Sheepshead Bay H. at 1 3/8 miles and a game nose decision in the July 17 GII New York H. going 1 1/4 miles. The chestnut saw her winning streak snapped last time out, coming back after a short break to be fifth in the nine-furlong GII Diana H. Sept. 5 at Saratoga, but she got back on track in yesterday's GI Flower Bowl Invitational. With jockey Jerry Bailey getting the call this time, the four-year-old settled off fractions of :25.09, :50.83 and 1:15.01, came up to join the leaders after a mile in 1:38.66 and drove past Coretta (Ire) (Caerleon) in the stretch to run her grass record to six-for-seven. "There were negatives in the Diana with the way the track was playing," trainer Jimmy Toner said. "It was speed conducive, it was pretty well chopped up, she had an outside post and was cutting back in distance off a layoff. Soaring Softly vindicated our faith in her by the way she came back and performed today. She showed she can kick with the best of them." As for what's next, Toner said, "The Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf was our goal early in the year and it is now. She'll go to Payson Park, then to Gulfstream." The runner-up also will head to the Nov. 6 Breeders' Cup. Mossflower (Affirmed), runaway winner of the GI Hempstead H. on the dirt last year, but now winless in four tries this season, ran on well to get third in her second turf try. Trainer Rick Schosberg said, "We'll go to the Breeders' Cup, but I don't know which race." The 5-2 choice Heritage Of Gold (Gold Legend), winner of the Diana, set those slow fractions, but weakened in the final furlong and finished fourth. "I think...coming here, with a heavier course and higher grass, compromised her chances of getting a mile and a quarter," jockey Shane Sellers said. "Hopefully, the course at Gulfstream will be a bit harder." (Chart P. 2)

The longest shot by far in this six-horse field, Mash One had not visited the winner's circle since Dec. 28, 1997, when he won the G2 Gran Clasico Coronacion in his native Chile. His two U.S. starts were on opposite coasts, a second in the GII San Gabriel H. at Santa Anita last Dec. 28 and a badly beaten sixth in the GI Man o' War S. at Belmont Sept. 11 on soft turf. Back on a firm surface, Mash One challenged right from the start, but was taken back slightly by David Flores, settling in third behind Lazy Lode and Docksider (Diesis {GB}). He continued to fall back, dropping three off the leaders, but charged up the rail through the stretch to win going away. "He came out of [the gate] really sharp," said Flores, who saw that Gary Stevens and Lazy Lode were keen for the lead. "I just took a nice hold and was patient to see what they were going to do. At the three-eighths pole, I asked to him pick it up and this guy moved really nice." About Mash One's future, trainer Bobby Frankel said, "He's not eligible, so we won't consider the Breeders' Cup. We could go to Japan if they invite us. We've also got the [GI Carleton F. Burke Oct. 31] at the end of the meet here."

The winner of a conditions race at Longchamp Sept. 5 on her only start to date, Lady Of Chad attempted to make all on the very heavy ground. Her bold bid was successful as she routed a quality field in impressive style. She went straight into the lead followed by Issey Rose (Bigstone {Ire}), Darakiyla (Last Tycoon {Ire}) and Dignify (Rainbow Quest {Ire}), as New Story raced in company with Lady Vettori in midfield, the pair well covered. Racing to the final quarter, Lady Of Chad had all her rivals under pressure and it wasn't until entering the last two furlongs that Olivier Peslier began to get busy on his mount. She responded well and readily pulled clear of the field inside the final furlong, keeping on strongly all the way to the wire. Lady Vettori, only sixth with a furlong to run, finished best of all and grabbed third on the line. Winning trainer Richard Gibson said, "I'm very lucky to have such a good filly. I've only been training for three years and that was my first runner in a Group 1 race. We have nothing definite planned, although I am sure we will have some big plans for the future. I am just so thrilled."

The winner of his last two starts in his native Japan. Agnes World continued an excellent run for Japanesetrained horses in France by becoming the fourth individual Group 1 winner in a little over a season. Running over five furlongs for the first time on ground completely foreign to what he had been accustomed, he was in the van throughout and kept on gamely when challenged by Imperial Beauty throughout the final furlong. Breaking smartly from the gate, Agnes World disputed the lead with the lightning-fast Sainte Marine (Kenmare {Fr}) as Imperial Beauty raced in third, just ahead of Sampower Star (Cyrano De Bergerac (Ire)), with Keos well off the pace. Imperial Beauty was ridden from the quarter-mile marker and challenged for the lead with 11/2 furlongs to run as Sainte Marine began to fade. Sampower Star threatened briefly, but it was left to Imperial Beauty and Agnes World to battle it out. They did so with gusto, battling nip and tuck throughout the final furlong, with Agnes World proving just superior in the last few strides. Keos finished with a rattling run and collared Sampower Star in the shadows of the post to grab third. Winning part-owner Teruya Yoshida said, "We will now think about the [G1] Breeders' Cup Sprint and we want to go to England next year for the [G1] July Cup. We were worried about the ground as he is a better horse on faster going, but it was the same for eveyone."

Trans Island was the winner of a valuable handicap at Leopardstown Sept. 11, and then followed up by winning the Listed Dubai Duty Free Cup at Newbury Sept. 19, despite jockey Olivier Peslier ignoring trainer lan Balding's instructions by holding him up instead of racing to the fore. Kieren Fallon followed instructions to the letter this time and Trans Island led from start to finish, holding on well as the pack closed up in the closing stages. Trans Island set a sound pace in advance of Slip Stream (Irish River {Fr}), Sand Falcon and Sugarfoot. He was ridden soon after entering the straight and Fallon kicked him into a three-length lead approaching the final furlong. Sand Falcon tried to give chase as Sugarfoot came under strong driving from Pat Eddery on the wide outside. Trans Island looked to have the prize safely within his grasp with 150 yards to run, but began to tire as Sand Falcon and Sugarfoot began to close, but Trans Island hung on to hold their bids. Balding said, "That was terrific, it is always nice to have a winner on Arc day and I have been lucky enough to have done it twice before. I was hopeful beforehand, he moved very well and he likes soft ground which is a big help. He likes to be in front and the front-runners today have done very well. He deserves this, he was disqualified from a Group race, wrongly in my biased opinion, in Italy last year. His best distance is perhaps seven furlongs so he may run in the [G2] Challenge S. at Newmarket [Oct. 16] or come back here for the [G1] Prix de la Foret [Oct. 17]."

Sensation preceded the race when Star Of Akkar (Distant Relative {Ire}) became distressed at the start and unseated Thierry Gillet before crashing heavily to the ground herself. The action continued during the race, when with just over a furlong to go, Thierry Jarnet was sent crashing to the turf in a sickening fall as his mount Visionnaire (Linamix (Fr)) clipped the heels of Zahrat Dubai (Unfuwain) and fell. Jarnet's woes continued as he was lifted from the turf, with his rein wrapped around his neck, when Visionnaire hauled herself up from the ground. The pair escaped beaten, but not bowed. These incidents detracted somewhat from an excellent performance for the ultra-tough Diamond White, who deservedly recorded her first group race success in her 22nd start of the season. The race started with Zahrat Dubai going into the lead from Star Of Akkar and the Italian challenger Bardonecchia (Indian Ridge {Ire}), as Juvenia and Diamond White raced in midfield with Miss Berbere last of 11. Straightening for the run home Juvenia, Diamond White and Miss Berbere made the challenges on the wide outside as misfortune befell Jarnet on the inside. Diamond White struck the front at the distance and ran on strongly for a determined win.
