#### BEHRENS IS THE ONE TO BEAT IN GOLD CUP

Behrens (Pleasant Colony), the leading contender for top older horse this season after winning the GI Oaklawn H., Gl Gulfstream Park H., Gll Suburban H. and GII Massachusetts H., drew the rail for Sunday's \$1 million GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park. Facing eight rivals in the 10-furlong event, he will try to join the likes of Affirmed, Buckpasser, Cigar, Citation, Forego, Gallant Fox, John Henry, five-time hero Kelso, Man o'War, Shuvee, War Admiral and Whirlaway, all winners of the race. "Being a New York-bred, the Jockey Club Gold Cup means a lot to me," trainer Jim Bond said. "I've been lucky enough to win the Travers and to have won the first running of the Cigar Mile. This race is a high priority to me as a trainer." And Bond feels Behrens, off since finishing second by a nose in the Aug. 1 GI Whitney H., can win it. "I train this horse very hard," he said. "Basically, since last Dec. 6, he has been in tough training. We knew that there would come a point when he would need to rest his legs and to get his mind re-focused. He had about three weeks with no speed work, but he kept training. That freshened him, and then we started back training him hard. Believe me, he is ready to run." The William Clifton Jr. and Rudlein Stable colorbearer faces the talented three-year-olds Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) and Vision and Verse (Storm Cat), first and second, respectively, in the GI Belmont S. and GI Travers. "I have respect for the three-year-olds, but I don't fear them," Bond said. "All I know is that if it's the same Behrens who shows up that has shown up the last five races, they're all in a lot of trouble."

### DEJA VU FOR VAL'S PRINCE IN TURF CLASSIC?

They might start calling Val's Prince (Eternal Prince) the "Comeback Kid" if he can pull off a victory in today's GI Turf Classic at Belmont Park. The seven-yearold, who took the Turf Classic in 1997, was winless in six 1998 starts and away from the racetrack for nearly a year, but he returned to top form when second in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational for trainer Jimmy Picou two starts back, then dominated the Sept. 11 Gl Man o' War S. over this course with a 4 1/2-length victory in his first outing for trainer Jim Bond. "He's a gift," said Bond. "He does everything right and he's an easy horse to train." The gelding should be able to stalk what will most likely be a slow pace, giving him an advantage over morning-line favorite Yagli (Jade Hunter), the winner of the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H., GI Manhattan H. and GI United Nations H. earlier this year. Yaqli has not raced since a last-place finish in the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga Aug. 14. Explaining the sub-par performance, Bill Mott, elected to the Hall of Fame just last year, said, "A bad trainer ran him back too quick. He was dull." The wild card in this bunch is Dream Well (Fr) (Sadler's Wells), winner of the 1998 G1 French and Irish Derbies. Never out of the money in five starts against Europe's top runners this year, he was most recently third, but beaten 11 1/2 lengths to Davlami (Ire), in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 11. His connections decided to skip a rematch with Daylami in last Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. "It's difficult to think we could run in the Arc and turn around that many lengths," Alan Cooper, racing manager for the colt's owners, said. "This race is out alternative. It's a good opportunity to figure out if we'll go on to the Breeders' Cup."

On A Soapbox (Mi Cielo) won two of four starts this year, all on the main track, including the GI Coaching Club American Oaks. However, a switch to the turf should not be problematic as the bay filly scored an allowance victory and ran second in the Green River S. over the Keeneland grass last fall. Probable favorite Perfect Sting (Red Ransom) has won four of her last five, most recently the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. over the soft Belmont course Sept. 12. Longshot Bendecida (Silver Ghost) hasn't faced the toughest competition, but she is undefeated in four starts and has done everything asked of her. The bay filly won her first two starts over the main track at Lone Star earlier this summer, then scored in the Aug. 7 Chapel Belle S. at Louisiana and the Sept. 6 Summertime Promise S. at Hawthorne in her only two grass attempts.

Chilukki (Cherokee Run) gets the big two-turn test today after she spent most of the summer sprinting her peers into submission. The winner of four graded stakes got her first Grade I victory last time over Spain (Thunder Gulch) in the Aug. 29 Del Mar Debutante.

Abby Girl (Meadowlake), a winner of her first two starts by a combined 12 lengths, may be the biggest threat to Chilukki's undefeated record.

More Than Ready (Southern Halo) dominated fellow juveniles in his first five starts, where he won four stakes, including the GIII Tremont S. July 4 and the GIII Sanford S. July 29, before coming down with a fever while preparing for the Sept. 4 GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga. His connections passed on that race, and the colt returned to action in the Sept. 19 GI Futurity S. at Belmont where he finished third, a half-length behind the winner, as the 2-5 favorite. With that race under his belt, he should be more than ready to return to his winning ways here. The \$1.05 million yearling High Yield (Storm Cat) has been improving in each of his four starts, most recently posting a runaway score in the Hopeful. Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew) won his first outing by 9 3/4 lengths and, despite a stumbling start and a troubled trip, managed to finish a close fourth in the Futurity. He gets Lasix for the first time here.

PYRAMID PEAK MOVES TO DARBY DAN MGSW Pyramid Peak (Mt. Livermore--Way It Should Be, by Stalwart) will stand at Darby Dan Farm in Lexington, Kentucky as the property of John Oxley next year. The seven-year-old, a stakes winner at three, four and five, captured eight of his 22 career starts, including three graded-stakes wins, for earnings of \$871,556. He was also second in the GI Travers and GI Haskell Invitational. "The Blushing Groom (Fr) sire line is one of increasing importance, especially as manifested in Pyramid Peak, who is free of both Raise a Native and Northern Dancer," said John Phillips, owner of Darby Dan. Pyramid Peak's 2000 stud fee will be \$5,000 live foal.

LITE THE FUSE SOLD TO STRONACH Frank Stronach has purchased Lite The Fuse (Buckaroo--Annie's Dream, by Droll Role) from the partnership of Vinery and Victoria Dutrow and will stand the eightvear-old stallion at his Adena Springs South in Ocala, Florida for the 2000 breeding season. The top-class sprinter won both the GII Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash and the GI Carter H. twice; he was also twice runner-up in the GI Met Mile and earned \$1,036,882. FRUITS OF LOVE TO SKIP BREEDERS' CUP The Racing Post reports that Fruits Of Love (USA) (Hansel {USA}) will bypass the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Gulfstream Park Nov. 6 and instead take aim at two other races in the Emirates World Series, the GI Canadian International at Woodbine Oct. 17 and then the G1 Japan Cup in November. "We had targeted all three races, but we've now had second thoughts," trainer Mark Johnston told Racing Post. "The travel costs from Toronto to Miami were huge, and it doesn't seem worth it when he can go to Canada and Japan for nothing. If he wins in Canada, we might change our minds, but we probably won't." The four-year-old, who survived a van accident last winter, went on to win the June 18 G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot, then finished third to Daylami (Ire) in his latest outing, the July 24 G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. Jockey Kieren Fallon will be aboard the colt in the Canadian International.

**DETTORI DECIDES ON APPEAL** Contrary to initial indications, jockey Frankie Dettori will appeal against the four-day whip ban that he picked up at York on Wednesday. The suspension at present rules him out of the Oct. 16 £880,000 Champions' Day at Newmarket. Dettori's business manager Peter Burrell said on Thursday that an appeal was unlikely, but a Jockey Club spokeswoman announced vesterday: "A letter has arrived from the jockey stating that he wishes to appeal and the hearing will take place next week, though it won't be on Monday." The ban, incurred for the jockey's winning ride on Strahan (Ire), is due to begin on Friday.
