VAL TURNS BACK CLOCK IN TURF CLASSIC

He's seven years old, but Val's Prince (Eternal Prince) can still turn it on in the stretch. The 3-1 third choice in the \$600,000 Turf Classic at Belmont Park yesterday afternoon, he turned the clock back to 1997, driving past 40-1 Sunshine Street (Sunshine Forever) and holding off 5-2 Dream Well (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) to repeat in the Grade I event. "I had them the whole way around," jockey Jorge Chavez said. "I was waiting for the stretch and when I asked him to run, he was ready. You can't hold this horse, you have to let him do what he wants." The chestnut gelding was picking up his second Grade I victory after taking the Man o'War S. Sept. 11, and he will try to make it three in a row in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Gulfstream Park Nov. 6. The 9-5 favorite Yagli (Jade Hunter), who put together three consecutive Grade I wins earlier this year before finishing a lackluster seventh in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational in his latest Aug. 14, found himself in rush-hour traffic when he tried to make a move from fifth at the top of the stretch and couldn't get it into gear once clear, finishing a non-threatening fourth. "I had a horrible trip," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "I could never get off the rail. I saw a hole at the three-sixteenths pole--l just couldn't get to it." Trainer Bill Mott said, "My intention is still to run in the Breeders' Cup."



CHAMPAGNE FLOWS FOR GREENWOOD LAKE

The tactics, the trainer, the closing odds and the outcome were identical. Last year, trainer Nick Zito saddled The Groom Is Red in the GI Champagne S. and watched as the 6-1 shot closed from last to catch 5-2 second-choice Lemon Drop Kid and draw off for a 2 3/4-length victory. The 13-10 favorite, Tactical Cat, finished fifth. Zito was back in the Belmont Park paddokc for the Champagne yesterday afternoon, sending the 6-1 chance Greenwood Lake (Meadowlake) against one-time superstar More Than Ready (Southern Halo), the 7-5 chalk in the 1999 edition of the race. Once again, Zito's horse had only the ambulance behind him as he raced down the long Belmont backstretch. "I was not confident as the horse was turning for home," Zito admitted. "He was nine lengths out of it at the top of the lane." But More Than Ready had spit the bit and 2-1 second choice Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew) was tiring after leading through six furlongs in 1:10.81. Greenwood Lake, runner-up in the Sept. 19 GI Futurity last time out, was full of run, catching the pacesetter at the sixteenth pole and drawing off to win by 2 1/2 lengths. "These closers are the most exciting kind of horses," Zito said. "What a thrill!" As for the colt's future, the New York-bred trainer said, "It would be nice to make the trip (to the Breeders' Cup) and win the thing, but I am going to monitor this horse...if he is not 100 percent, we are not going to go. If he's right, we'll go. But the slightest thing, we would not go. That's what I have to do, because this is a special horse." John Kimmel, trainer of runner-up Chief Seattle, said, "He's still learning. I feel he'll improve with experience. Assuming all goes well, the Breeders' Cup is next." Third-place finisher High Yield (Storm Cat) is also Breeders' Cup bound, but plans for More Than Ready, who faded to fifth after pressing the pace, are up in the air. "He just didn't fire," jockey John Velazquez said. "He broke flat and once the dirt hit him in the face, it took him even more off his game. When we got to the turn, he had no punch. That's all I have to say." Trainer Todd Pletcher added, "He made a big middle move down the backstretch. He was head-and-head for the lead and then he flattened out. I don't know that the middle move is the reason that he did not run well. We'll see how he comes back and go from there." Champagne chart, p2

Perfect Sting lived up to her name as she fought her way home through a driving rain for her second straight Grade I score. With a half-length loss to sidelined Nani Rose in the Aug. 2 GIII Lake George H. keeping her from five straight wins, the bay filly was favored off an impressive win the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Sept. 12. The bay tracked pacesetter Smooth Player (Bertrando) while sixth through a half in :48 2/5, then began to advance, reaching contention at the top of the stretch. GI Del Mar Oaks victress Tout Charmant held a narrow advantage in midstretch, but was unable to hold off the Red Ransom filly, who won going away. "It was tremendous win," jockey Pat Day said. "This filly really didn't like the racetrack at all today. At no point did I think she was handling it. But she still won, and that is the mark of a very good horse."

In a scene more reminiscent of his native Britain than a Kentucky autumn afternoon, Kirkwall battled valiantly through the rain for his second straight graded-stakes triumph. Front-running winner of the GIII Bay Meadows H. last out Sept. 18, the chestnut was dismissed at long odds despite being one of only two runners in the field with a win over yielding ground. Rating just behind the leaders here, he edged closer through the turn, poked a head in front at the top of the stretch and outfought a courageous Delay of Game to the line. Favored Joe Who (Brz) (Jolly Quick) clipped heels with Garbu (Strawberry Road {Aus}) on the backstretch and fell, but he and jockey Chris Antley were uninjured.

After she won five straight sprints including the Aug. 29 GI Del Mar Debutante in her most recent start, the only speculation surrounding Chilukki's greatness revolved around her ability to navigate a route of ground. After yesterday's Oak Leaf, no more speculation is necessary. The bay filly sat outside off the moderate fractions set by second-choice Abby Girl and Crown of Crimson, challenged the leaders on the second turn, gained command at the top of the stretch and, despite drifting in late, got the victory. "She's just so gifted," said trainer Bob Baffert. "I love the way she relaxed today. She does not need the lead. Maybe (the rider) needs to wait even longer to get her up there. When she made the lead, she wanted to put the brakes on." Only the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies stands between Chilukki and a perfect season and Baffert compared her to last year's Juvenile Fillies winner. "She's like Silverbulletday in that she's great, and those kind take their racetrack with them," he said.

Morning-line favorite Behrens is three-for-four over the racetrack, proven at the distance and, although he didn't win his last start against Victory Gallop in the GI Whitney at Saratoga Aug. 1, he turned in one of the most impressive performances of the year in defeat. In that race, the five-year-old accelerated into a fast pace while racing five wide on the far turn, was seemingly put away by Victory Gallop in midstretch, yet managed to come back on the inside only to lose the head bob. Should Behrens not be ready after being away for nearly 2 1/2 months, Godolphin's Almutawakel, who missed by a nose in the Sept. 18 Gl Woodward, could capitalize. The winner of the G1 Dubai World Cup has acclimated well to life in the states, according to Godolphin's Rachel Doré. "He's been very full of himself and he seems to have taken to the American way of training," said Doré. Of the three-year-olds, Lemon Drop Kid has the most impressive resume. He looks to become the first horse since Easy Goer in 1989 to win the Belmont, Travers and Gold Cup.

Beautiful Pleasure finds herself in position to upset a champion for the second straight time, as she most recently defeated Banshee Breeze in the GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga Aug. 27. There is no question that she will be going straight to the front from the rail. "I think this race plays to speed more than a two-turn race would," said trainer John Ward Jr. Catinca, fresh off a score in the GI Ruffian H. Sept. 18, will come from off the pace and could pick up the pieces should the two favorites wear each other out early.

For the second time in 10 years, this Group 1 juvenile contest has attracted only four runners, but at least there are two previous group winners in Jokerman and Ocean Of Wisdom and a Listed winner in sole English challenger Barathea Guest. Michael Tabor and Aidan O'Brien, who won with Second Empire (Ire) in 1997, are represented by the highly rated Ciro. Beautifully bred Ocean Wisdom looks set to start favourite after an impressive pillar-to-post win in the G3 Prix La Rochette on his second start at Chantilly Sept. 21, while Jokerman has won three of his four starts, including the G3 Prix des Chenes here Sept 12. Barathea Guest has also won three of his four starts, including most recently the Listed Criterium du Fonds Europeen de l'Elevage at Deauville Aug. 21. Ciro is an unknown quantity by comparison, but won a Galway maiden on his second start Sept. 7 by an impressive seven lengths.

German-trained runners have a good record in this event in recent years and El Divino comes into the race off a deserved success in the G2 Europear-Meile at Cologne Sept. 25. He will start one of the favourites, along with Godolphin's Muhtahir, who had a long break after travelling to Tokyo in May to finish fifth in the G3 Yasuda-Kinen, returning to finish fourth in the G3 GNER Park S. at Doncaster Sept. 5 on his only subsequent start. Ultra-consistent Midyan Call won the Listed Premio Signorino in Rome in April and the Listed Premio FIA European Breeders Fund in Rome Sept. 25, with Crisos II Monaco fifth.

The combination of Raise a Native through the very similarly bred Mr. Prospector and Alydar is beginning to appear in stakes winners, the latest of which is Forty One Carats (c, 3, Tactical Advantage-Aly's July, by Alysheba), winner of the Indiana Derby. Forty One Carats is by a grandson of Mr. Prospector out of a mare by a son of Alydar.

Spanish Fern (f, 4, El Gran Senor--Chain Fern, by Blushing Groom {Fr}), winner of the Gl Yellow Ribbon S., is another stakes winner to combine the three-parts relatives Tom Fool and Spring Run. Tom Fool appears as sire of El Gran Senor's own broodmare sire Buckpasser, and Spring Run is dam of Blushing Groom's sire, Red God. Lord Flasheart (c, 2, Blush Rambler--Miss Henderson Co., by Silver Hawk), who showed himself to be among the best of the French two-year-olds with a win in the G3 Prix de Conde, also has Spring Run and Tom Fool.

An unusual version of the very successful inbreeding to Lalun struck the big time when Lady In Waiting (f, 3, Kylian--High Savannah, by Rousillon) won the G2 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket last Saturday. Lady In Waiting--who might well go for the GI E. P. Taylor S.--is by an unraced son of Sadler's Wells who stands in Ireland for \$4,000. Her dam is by Rousillon, a son of Riverman who was an excellent runner, but a disappointing sire. Lady In Waiting has Lalun 5x5 through Bold Reason, the broodmare sire of Sadler's Wells, and through Never Bend, the sire of Riverman.
