KEEN ON THE MUD

River Keen (Ire) (Keen {GB}), a \$100,000 claim last December, recorded the second straight Grade I win of his career when he splashed home a 3 1/4-length victor of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup S. yesterday at Belmont Park. It was just three weeks ago that the seven-year-old chestnut nosed out G1 Dubai World Cup winner Almutawakel (GB) (Machiavellian) to win the Gl Woodward S., but the Belmont bettors gave him little respect against leading Horse of the Year candidate Behrens (Pleasant Colony) yesterday, sending him off at 12-1. Back Ring AI (Allen's Prospect), entered as a rabbit for sixth-place finisher Catienus (Storm Cat), was hustled to the lead while River Keen settled in second. River Keen inherited the lead leaving the backstretch, turned back the stretch challenge of Almutawakel and finished easily as Behrens closed gamely to be second. "My plan was to stay close to the lead," explained winning rider Chris Antley. "Speed has been a dominating factor all afternoon, so that being the case, we went into the game to press the pace and not to give the favorite an easy edge." H. James Bond, trainer of beaten favorite Behrens, said, "He showed me that he is courageous. He didn't like that surface at all, and he still got second. They won't beat him in the (Breeders') Cup."

FASTER THAN A SPEEDING BULLET

It wasn't a replay, but you can't blame anyone who saw Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin) splashing her way through the slop on a clear lead down the stretch in a Grade I race with an Eclipse Award winner in her wake for thinking they were seeing a replay of the filly's victory over Banshee Breeze in the GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga Aug. 27. It was a different racetrack vesterday, and a different Eclipse winner, but it was the same Beautiful Pleasure who set a strong pace, repelled a challenge from Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) at the top of the stretch and cruised to a 4 3/4-length tally in Belmont's GI Beldame. "I knew going in that she was going to love the slop," said rider Jorge Chavez. "I was never worried about Silverbulletday...She ran a great race." Trainer John Ward Jr. said, "We made Silverbulletday commit to our style rather than us committing to her style." Bob Baffert remained upbeat after his champ's defeat. "It wasn't her day and that is a nice filly that beat her," the trainer said. "I'm not worried. Horses beat horses." The first two finishers will head on to the Breeders' Cup Distaff, while trainer John Kimmel was uncertain of Catinca (Storm Cat)'s agenda.

*Barathea Guest finished first but was disqualified and

placed second. The winner of one of his two previous starts, a maiden event at Galway Sept. 7, Ciro came up against more experienced adversaries as he attempted group company for the first time. Continuing Aidan O'Brien's excellent run of juvenile success, he had the local stewards to thank for this Group 1 success when he was awarded the race, having been beaten a neck, at the expense of Barathea Guest who was judged to have caused interference just inside the quarter-mile marker, an incident which looked innocuous at worst. Jockey Philip Robinson received a four-day ban for his part in the incident. As the race got under way, Michael Kinane seized the initiative and sent Ciro straight into the lead which was dictated at a good pace. Ocean Of Wisdom followed three lengths behind in second with Barathea Guest restrained in last. Turning into the straight, Barathea Guest soon went into the lead, traveling best of the three runners, but drifted slightly to the right causing Michael Kinane to switch his mount while Ocean Of Wisdom began to toil. Barathea Guest surged three lengths clear at the furlong marker and looked to have the race in safe keeping, but Ciro didn't give up and finished well to be a close second. The proximity to which Ciro finished to Barathea Guest may have had some bearing on the stewards' decision, but the amendment of the placings came as a surprise to many. Connections of the demoted Barathea Guest are considering an appeal. Owner John Guest and trainer George Margarson lodged an appeal immediately after the stewards inquiry and have 48 hours to decide whether to proceed with the appeal or withdraw their application. Margarson said, "We had five days in which to appeal but lodged one straight away. It's all very well saying you are going to appeal in the heat of the moment but we'll sit down, have a look at the video and discuss it with the owner before deciding what to do. For the horse himself, he doesn't know he's been disqualified and as far as he is concerned he has won four out of five. He ran green for half a stride but ran a good race to get the job done. We'll put him away now for the winter and come back for a go at the (2000) Guineas." Winning owner Michael Tabor sympathized with Barathea Guest's connections and said, "It is hard luck on a small trainer, and I do feel sorry for him. Even so I thought we deserved to get the race in the end. That's it for Ciro this year but he should make up into a decent horse."

"He got right into the race and I thought we were going to be in for a ride," said winning rider Garrett Gomez. "But about midway around the first turn, he got out of the race and he really never did get back in it. He lollygagged around there the whole way. I bet he didn't put out but about 80 percent today what he is capable of. It was just sheer talent that carried us today. If he learns how to use that talent, he is going to be awesome."

Dixie Union raced his way directly to the top of the left coast juvenile division this summer, breaking his maiden by a length and a half at Hollywood Park June 13 before passing his first stakes test with flying colors, taking the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship July 18. Taking the show on the road, the dark bay was a very game 1/2-length winner of the GIII Best Pal S. at Del Mar, getting up late while pinned in along the rail, but had his winning streak snapped when dominated by 5 1/2 lengths by Forest Camp in the GII Del Mar Futurity Sept. 8. Forest Camp bumped lightly at the start with Anees, but went up to set a fast pace just off the wood, as Dixie Union, a bit wide into the clubhouse turn, chased from the outside and pulled within 1 1/2 lengths into the far turn. Forest Camp still maintained a one-length advantage at the eighth pole, but, under constant pressure from his more seasoned rival, gradually gave way as Dixie Union was up late for the victory. The final running time of 1:35.79 broke the stakes record set by the Bob Baffert-trained Souvenir Copy in 1997. "I never lost faith in this horse," said winning rider Alex Solis. "The last time, Forest Camp ran a freaky race. On the way back to the barn, I told Mr. Mandella that I loved him at a distance, because he is very steady and just keeps coming at you. My horse is such a warrior." Baffert, who trained the runner up, always finds a way to find a silver lining. "The rail didn't help our situation, but we just went too fast. Still, we got beat by a pretty good horse. Now I don't have to be the favorite (in the Breeders' Cup)."


