DOYLE GOES TO 400,000 GUINEAS TO OUTBID COOLMORE

A Sadler's Wells filly offered from Raffin Stud looks virtually certain to top the 1999 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale after making 400,000 guineas last night when bought by an undisclosed client of agent Peter Doyle. The half-sister to high-class Japanese performer Tsukuba Symphony (GB) (Danehill) will be trained in England, but Doyle, who eventually got the better of Coolmore's Paul Shanahan, having earlier shaken off trainer John Gosden, was not able to divulge the identity of his client. "Although I thought she was the pick of the sale," Doyle said, "I didn't think she would make anywhere near that amount." Agent John Ferguson had earlier paid 140,000 guineas for a good-looking son of Bluebird (Storm Bird) sold by Bob Lanigan's Tullamaine Castle Stud in Ireland. He will carry the colors of Mollers Racing and be trained by Geoffrey Wragg. A Royal Academycolt out of Kharimata (Ire) (Kahyasi), bought for 120,000 guineas by agent Charlie Gordon-Watson with Doyle as underbidder, will race for a new owner of Michael Jarvis's Newmarket stable. The final six-figure sale, which like its three predecessors was during the evening session, came about when Sheikh Mohammed's former racing manager Anthony Stroud, now a bloodstock agent, paid 110,000 guineas for a Night Shift colt who will carry the colors of Swiss owners with an as-yet undecided trainer. The median of 23,000 guineas was a record for the session, up 15 percent on 1998, while the average of 29,579 guineas was only bettered last year.

HAPPYANUNOIT CLAPS HER HANDS

Happyanunoit (NZ) (Yachtie {Aus}), a champion in her native New Zealand, has now strung together three outstanding efforts, culminating in this course-recordsetting triumph over a strong field. Blinkers were added after winning only one of four stateside starts earlier this year, and she then won the GIII Palomar at Del Mar over Tuzla (Fr) and Isle de France and was a head back of Tuzla in the GI Ramona H. Sept. 4. The Ramona third, Spanish Fern (also a Bobby Frankel trainee), went on to take the GI Yellow Ribbon at Santa Anita Oct. 2 in fine style. Happyanunoit, the second choice, broke alertly from her outside post, rating seven wide, just two lengths behind the pacesetting duo of Pleasant Temper (Storm Cat) and Witchful Thinking (Lord Avie). Jockey Brice Blanc angled her slightly in for the drive, and with a tap of the whip Happyanunoit sailed past Pleasant Temper and came home all alone, shading the course record by two-fifths of a second. Pleasant Temper held off favored Fiji (GB) (Rainbow Quest) for second. "This filly has a ton of talent and she just seems to get better and better," said Blanc. "Whenever you want her to go, all you have to do is ask her and she will go. She's awfully, awfully good right now." There will be no trip to the Breeders' Cup, but rather a trip back to California for Hollwood Park's GI \$500,000 Matriarch at 1 1/8 miles on the turf Nov. 28. "She's not eligible and would have to be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup, and that's a lot of money," said Frankel.

Perugina was a creditable third in the G3 Prix du Bois at Chantilly July 2, and was then given a confidenceboosting run when breaking her maiden at the provincial Saint Malo July 25. She benefitted from that experience with a good third in the Listed Prix Herod at Maisons-Laffitte Sept. 28, and showed she had made continued progress to record her first group win here with a strong late run to capture the prize. Touch Of The Blues was sent straight to the lead from Radhwa (Shining Steel {GB}) and Guthrun (Beaudelaire) as Perugina was settled in fifth with Contexte based at the rear. The race proper got underway entering the straight, where Touch Of The Blues was ridden to go clear of the pack, and he still held a two-length lead at the furlong marker. Both Perugina and Contexte made progress from behind and Perugina benefitted after being presented with a split between Yazmin (Green Desert) and Radhwa. She readily accepted the invitation and finished with a strong run to grab the lead inside the last half-furlong, a lead she was not to relinquish. Contexte also finished to good effect and managed to get up in the last strides to deny the game Touch Of The Blues second place. Assistant trainer Rupert Pritchard-Gordon said, "The race set up well for her today and the waiting tactics worked out ideally. She was nicely covered up and quickened well when it opened up. She could go for the G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte [Nov. 5] but she's a small filly who has gone a bit in her coat so we'll have to see how she comes out of this race."

Champion Banshee Breeze was perfect through her first four starts this year, winning graded stakes at Gulfstream, Oaklawn and Churchill before toting 124 pounds to take the Aug. 7 Gl Go For Wand H. at Saratoga by a half-length. She ran into a sloppy Saratoga strip and mudlark Beautiful Pleasure in her latest effort and finished second in the Aug. 27 Gl Personal Ensign H. while giving the winner 11 pounds, but looks much the best at equal weights here. Silent Eskimo finished second, beaten a half-length by Banshee Breeze while in receipt of 10 pounds, in the June 5 GIII Fleur de Lis H. The four-year-old makes her first appearance since tiring to be fourth in the July 5 GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. at Monmouth. Keeper Hill has not been to the winner's circle since taking the GI Kentucky Oaks in May of 1998, but she has been on the board in her last four starts, most recently a third in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park Sept. 18.

This fascinating wide-open contest features two of the stars of 1998, last year's heroine Alborada and Epsom Derby winner High-Rise, both of whom have had just one race this season and are looking for last-gasp glory. Alborada was an unlucky fifth in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood July 31, while High-Rise was runnerup in the Listed Dubai Arc Trial at Newbury Sept. 19. Shiva, too, has had a light season, winning the G3 Earl Of Sefton S. here in April and the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 23, before finishing seventh behind Lear Spear in the G2 Prince Of Wales's S. at Ascot on her last start June 15. Greek Dance ran well to finish runner-up in the G1 Juddmonte International at York Aug. 17, even if outclassed by the winner Royal Anthem, and then finished sixth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 3. Golden Snake is the only G1 winner amongst the four three-year-old colts in the field, having landed the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly in early June. On his only subsequent start, he finished sixth in the G1 Juddmonte International.

Unbeaten Distant Music will start a warm favorite for this contest in the absence of Fasliyev, whose stable is represented by both Brahms and Zentsov Street, but he may face his stiffest opposition from the also unbeaten King's Best. Both of Distant Music's wins have come at Doncaster, including a ready defeat of the Ballydoyle representative Rossini in the G2 Champagne S. Sept. 10. King's Best won a Newmarket maiden in July and followed up with an emphatic win in the Listed Acomb S. at York Aug. 17. Zentsov Street, who has been preferred to Brahms by stable jockey Michael Kinane, will need to improve to trouble the two principals, having won a Newmarket maiden Sept. 30 by only a head. Brahms, the mount of Olivier Peslier, has been placed in both the G3 Futurity at The Curragh Aug. 29 and the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket Sept. 30.

Old Trieste was never headed while winning his last three starts of 1998, all graded stakes, and came back after nearly nine months off to wire the field by seven lengths in the May 29 GII Californian S. He disappointed as the 2-5 favorite in his only other outing this year, running third to Hollycombe in the Sept. 5 GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H., but trainer Mike Puype did not have the colt completely cranked up. The four-year-old indicated his fitness for this test when he worked five furlongs in a bullet :58 1/5 Monday. Hollycombe was making only his fifth start and his stakes debut in the one-mile Del Mar Breeders' Cup. Beaten only once, the speedy five-year-old stretches out to nine furlongs for the first time. General Challenge, who hasn't handled trips that take him outside his home state, is a perfect three-for-three at Santa Anita. The Cal-bred failed to fire when fifth in the GII Louisiana Derby and 11th in the GI Kentucky Derby, but has rebounded with wins in the GIII Affirmed H. in June and against older horses in the GI Pacific Classic last time out Aug. 29.

With the Flow, three-for-four while winning a Group 3 at this distance in France, tries a mile for the first time since shipping to the States. The four-year-old has two wins from his two U.S. outings, taking a Belmont allowance going a mile and a quarter in June and adding the GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. at a mile and an eighth last time out Sept. 25. Sweetsothernsaint, a graded-stakes winner on the dirt at two, started only once last year and was never in the hunt in his first start after a 20-month absence, running eighth over a sloppy Calder strip in the Sept. 6 Spend A Buck H. But the four-year-old bounced back in his turf debut, winning a Belmont allowance test at a mile Oct. 3. Red hot Jorge Chavez gets the return call. Centre Stalls, who was Group 1-placed at a mile in England last year, made his U.S. debut after an eight-month vacation. Off the board in a Garden State allowance in May, he was given another 3 1/2-month break before returning to be second after a rough start in the Bob Harding S. at Monmouth Sept. 4. He broke on top and never looked back in his latest, winning a Philadelphia Park allowance at 1 1/8 miles Sept. 27.

The winner of the GI Carter H. in May, Artax suffered through a string of six losses, the first coming after he nearly ran down a fan on Preakness Day and finished fifth in the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. But the fouryear-old found his best stride last time out, cruising to a 3 1/2-length score in the GI Vosburgh S. Sept. 25. While his best races have come at seven furlongs, he has been second in four of his five tries at six and will try to pick up his first at the distance here. Stormin Fever returned after a nine-month layoff to take a Saratoga allowance test Sept. 5, then was second in the Vosburgh despite steadying at the half-mile pole. Undefeated Bet Me Best gets the blinkers off in his first start since a gallant head victory in the GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream Jan. 31. The three-year-old, who started his career at Evangeline Downs, faces a tough test for his return.


Cool Ashlee was two-for-two with a win in a Philly Park stakes before she ran into Hello Seattle in the GI Mazarine Breeders' Cup S. at Woodbine Sept. 26 and finished an overmatched second. NYRA RACING SCHEDULE SET FOR 2000 The New York Racing Association's Board of Trustees has approved the 2000 racing schedule for Aqueduct, Belmont Park and Saratoga. If the schedule, which totals 264 racing days, is approved by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board, Aqueduct's Winter Meet will be held Jan. 1-Mar. 26 and its Spring Meet will run Mar. 29-May 7. The Belmont Spring Meet is set for May 10-July 23, with twilight racing every Friday offering a 3 p.m. first post. Saratoga will race July 26-Sept. 4, the Belmont Fall Meet will be held Sept. 8-Oct. 22 and the Aqueduct Fall Meet is slated for Oct. 25-Dec. 31. Aqueduct's Winter/Spring stakes program will include 36 races, 20 of them graded, worth a total of \$4,225,000. The GII Wood Memorial, set for Apr. 15, has received a purse increase from \$600,000 to \$750,000. The purse for the GIII Gotham S., to be run Mar. 19, has been raised from \$150,000 to \$200,000. "Since 1994, purses have risen from \$79 million to approximately \$108 million this year," NYRA Racing Secretary Mike Lakow said. "Our overnight purses will be the highest ever this winter and spring. We will continue to make every effort to upgrade our program."

INCURABLE OPTIMIST RETIRED According to Daily Racing Form, MGSW Incurable Optimist (Cure the Blues--Miss Turlington, by Seattle Slew), who has not raced since winning the GIII Generous S. at Hollywood by nine lengths last November, has been retired after a recurrence of the tendon injury which originally put him on the sidelines last winter. "We noticed a slight inflammation after he returned from a recent routine gallop which would have required more time off," trainer Dave Donk told the Form. "If he were a gelding, we'd probably give him all the time he needed, but since he does have some value at stud, we felt the best decision was to retire him." Undefeated in four starts on the grass, the three-year-old also picked up a second and a third in two starts on the main track and earned \$271,309. Stud plans for the New York-bred have not yet been decided.

HURRICANE IRENE CANCELS CALDER

RACING Hurricane Irene blew into South Florida and caused the cancellation of live racing at Calder yesterday and today. The track was, however, open for simulcasting yesterday and will be again this afternoon and this evening. The Festival of the Sun, including five stakes races and all activities which were scheduled to take place today, will be postponed until next Saturday. The In Reality, My Dear Girl, Princess Rooney and Calder Breeders' Cup will be run with the fields which were entered for today. The Flying Pidgeon, which had already been rescheduled before racing was called off, will be drawn Thursday.

MORE THAN READY OUT FOR SEASON Daily

Racing Form reports that two-year-old More Than Ready (Southern Halo), who was sent to Rood and Riddle Equine Clinic in Lexington for tests after a lackluster fifth-place finish as the favorite in the GI Champagne S. at Belmont Park, will not race again this year. "Basically, there's nothing physically wrong with the horse," trainer Todd Pletcher told the Form. "They went over him pretty much with a fine-tooth comb. What we came up with is the horse was maybe just a little bit tired after a season that started in April. What we've decided to do is give the horse 30 days off in Ocala, keep him in light training, turn him out in the afternoons and freshen him up a little bit." More Than Ready won his first five starts, including the GII Sanford S. and GIII Tremont S., before running third in the GI Futurity in his penultimate start of the season. He has earned \$310,229.

CODES OF PRACTICE FOR STUD FARMS ISSUED

The Levy Board has issued codes of practice for 2000 which lay down recommendations for the prevention and control of venereal diseases on stud farms. John Parker FRCVS, chairman of the Levy Board's expert group responsible for the codes, said, "The increasing use of artificial insemination in the non-Thoroughbred sector and the increasing practice of walking mares into stallion studs, with mares visiting from ever-wider catchment areas, create more openings than before for the spread of disease. Standards of prevention must be maintained to the highest level."
